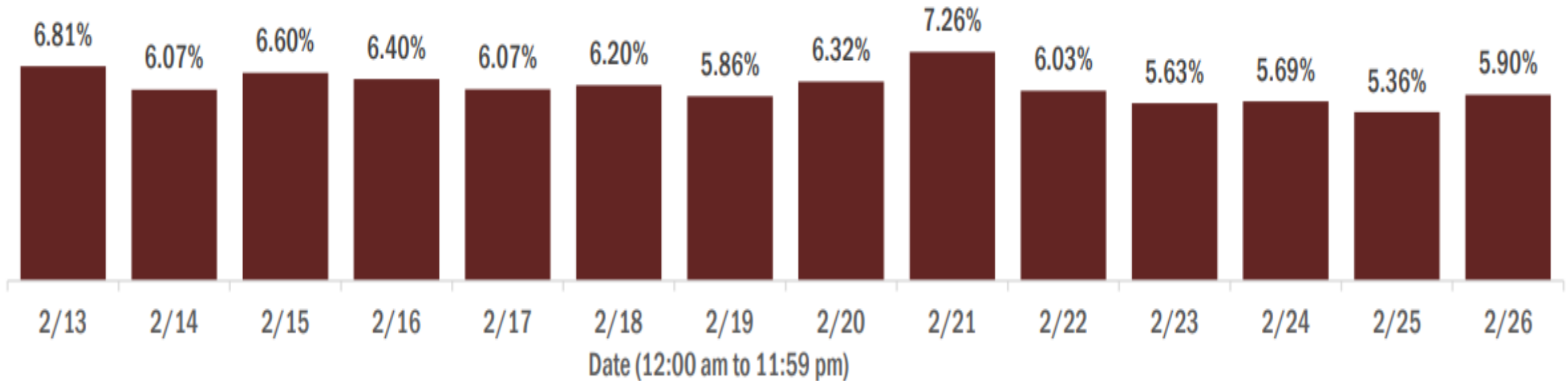

## Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

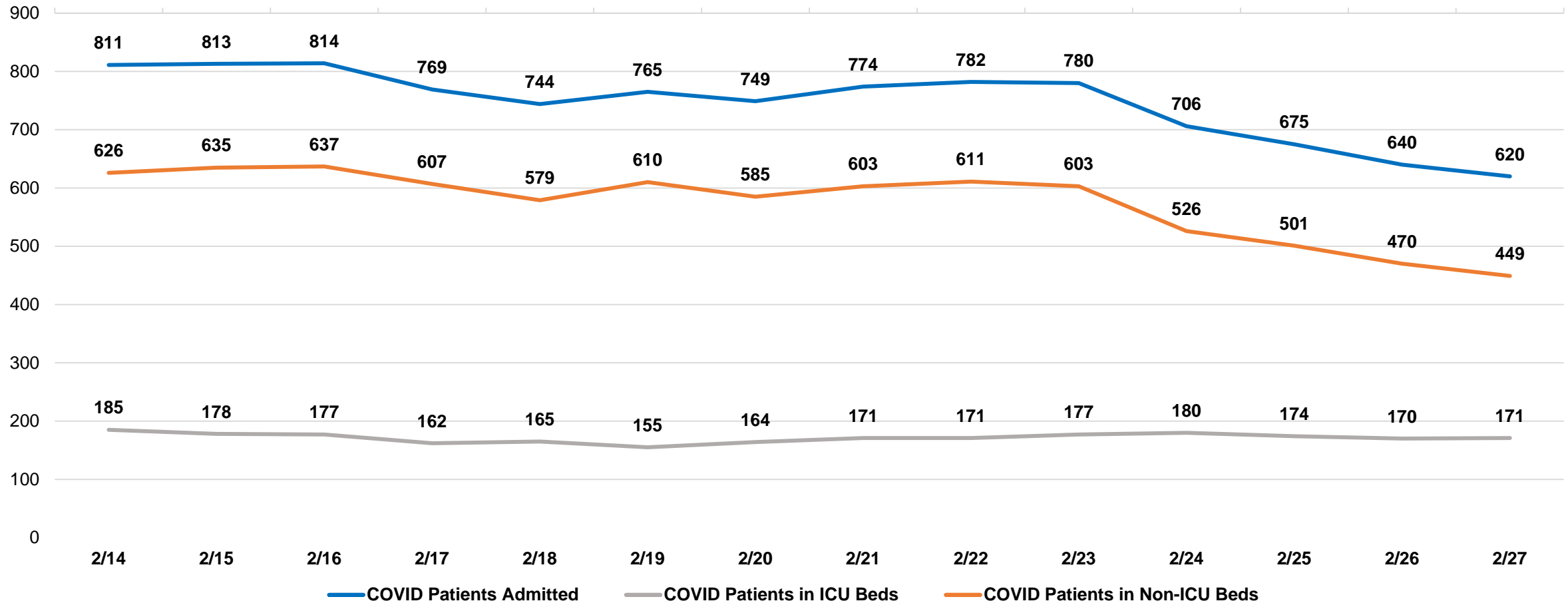

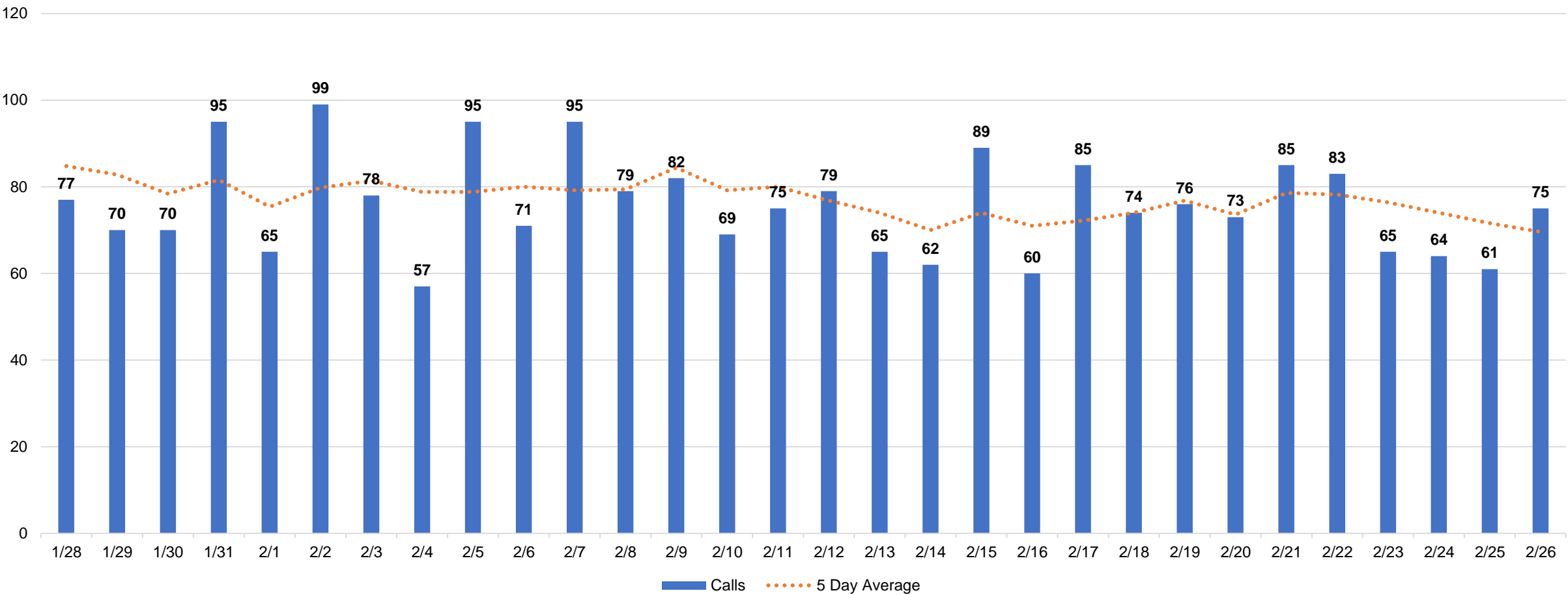

# Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Calls

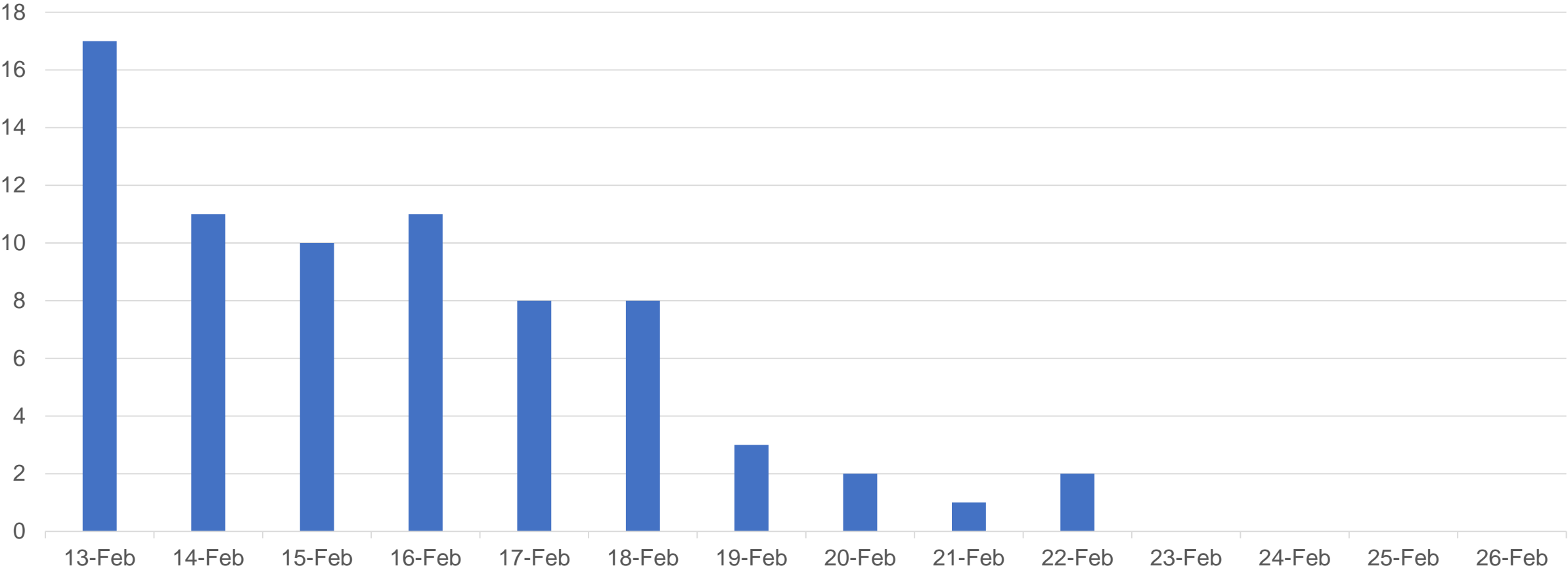
MDFR Suspected COVID-19 Calls

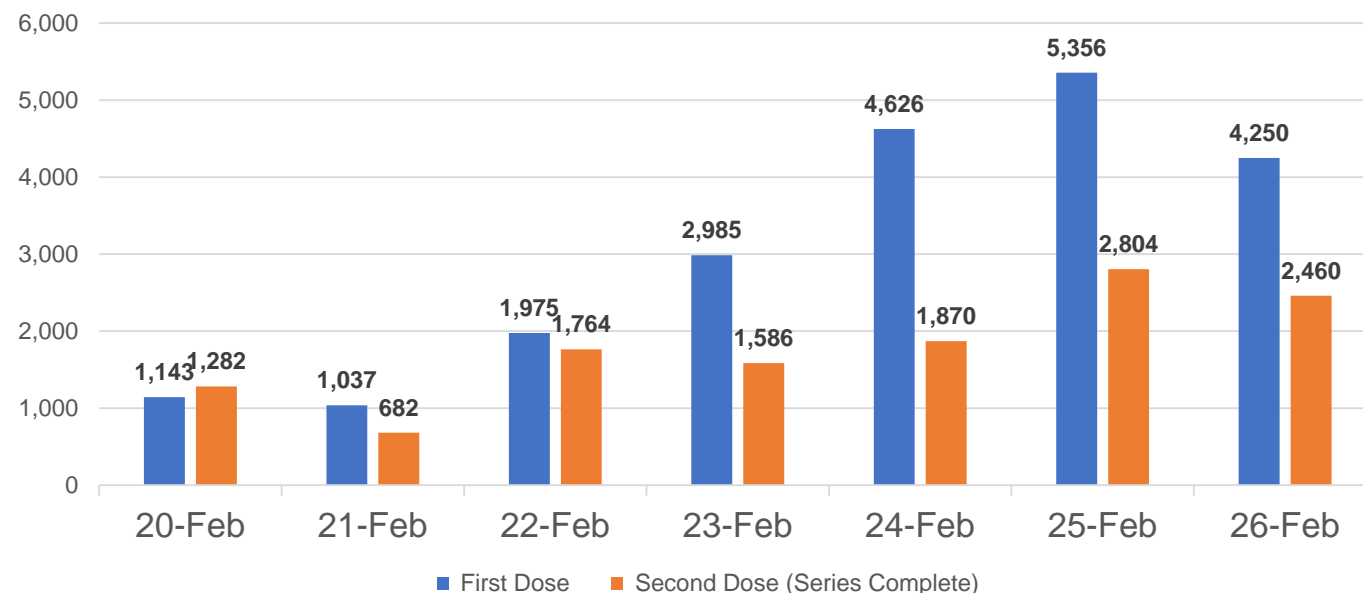
