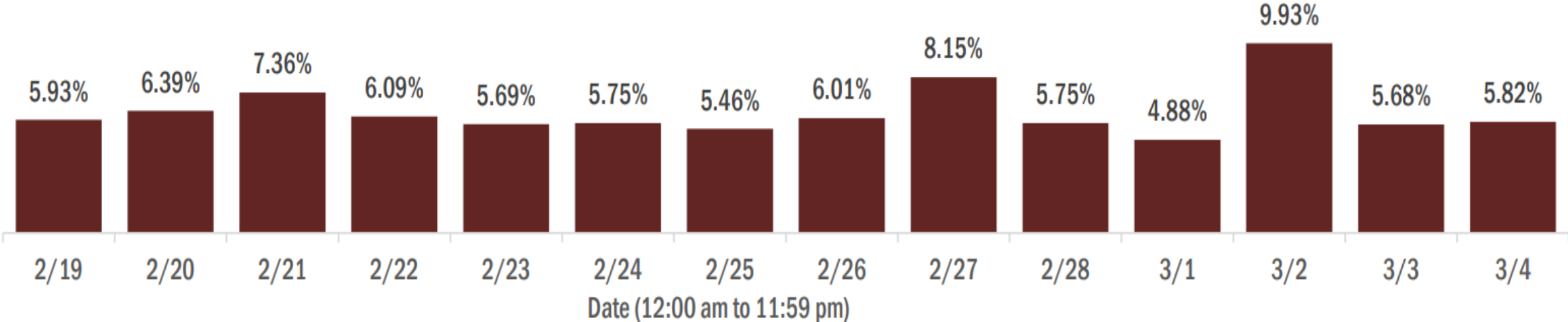

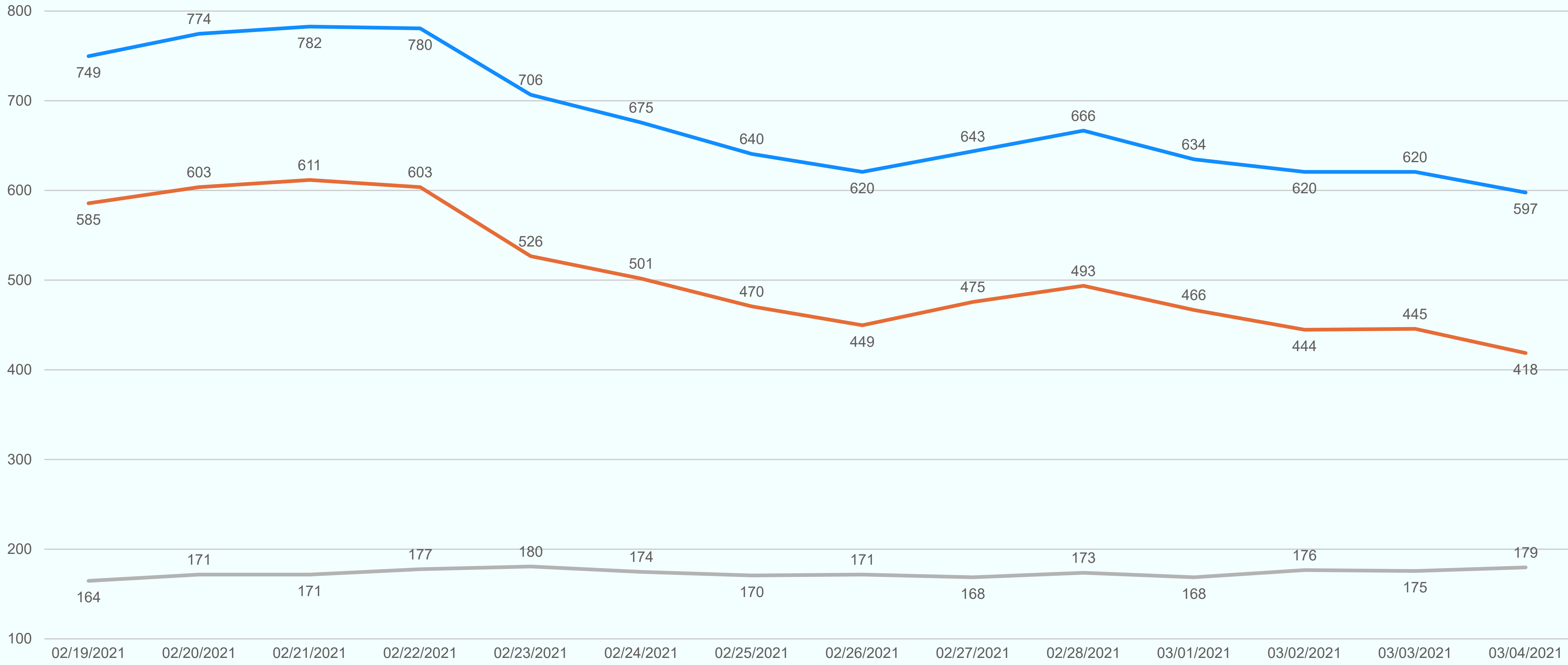

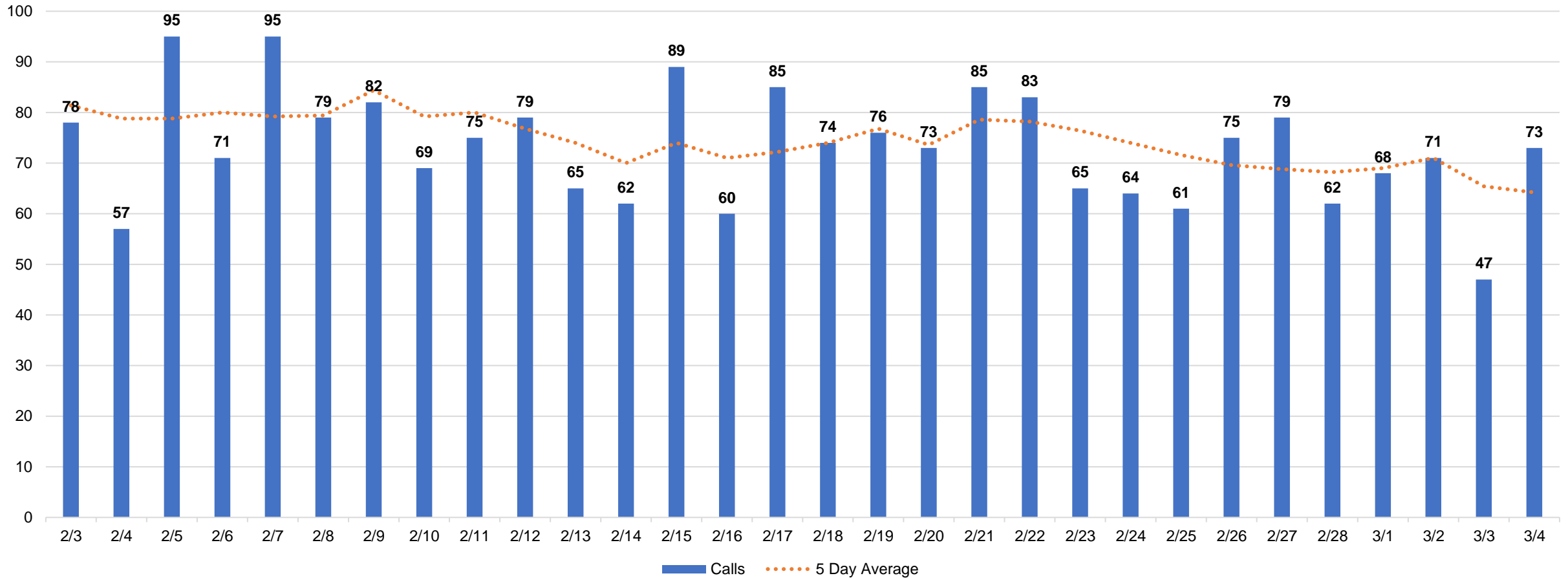

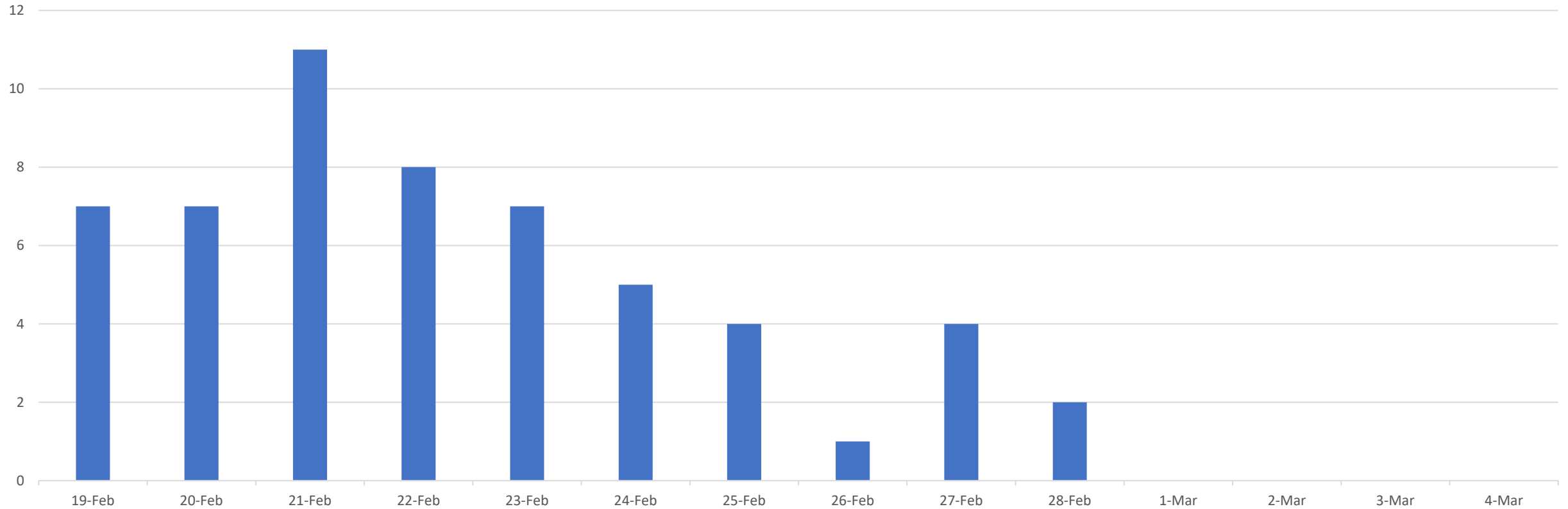
Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Calls

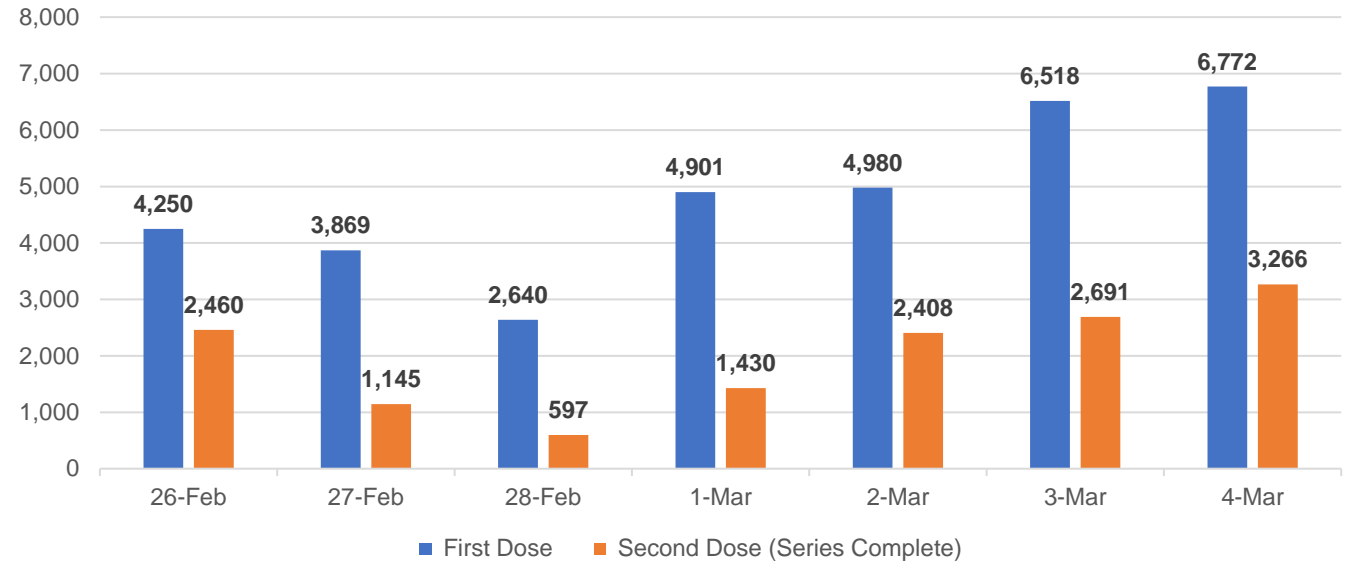
