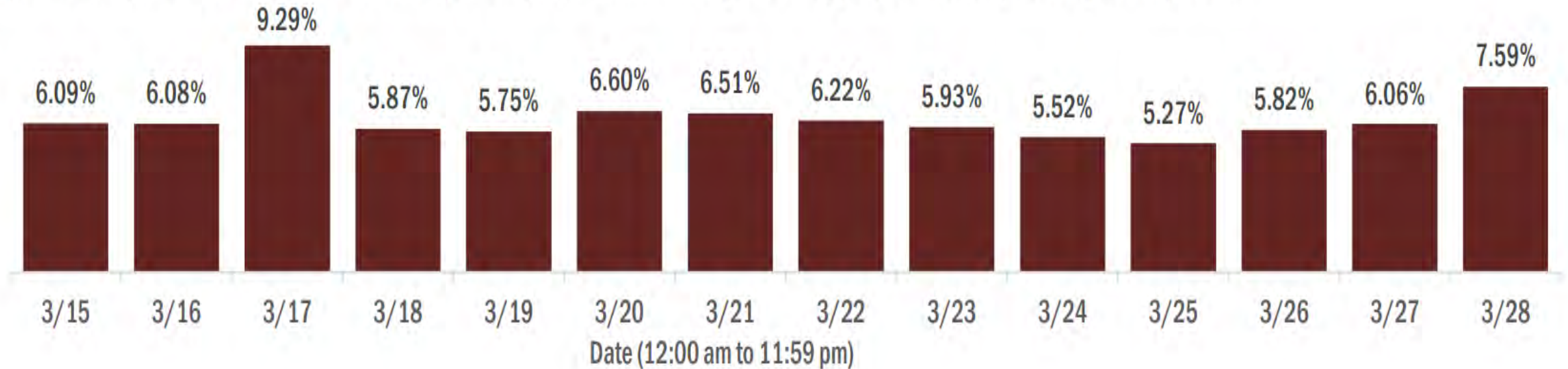

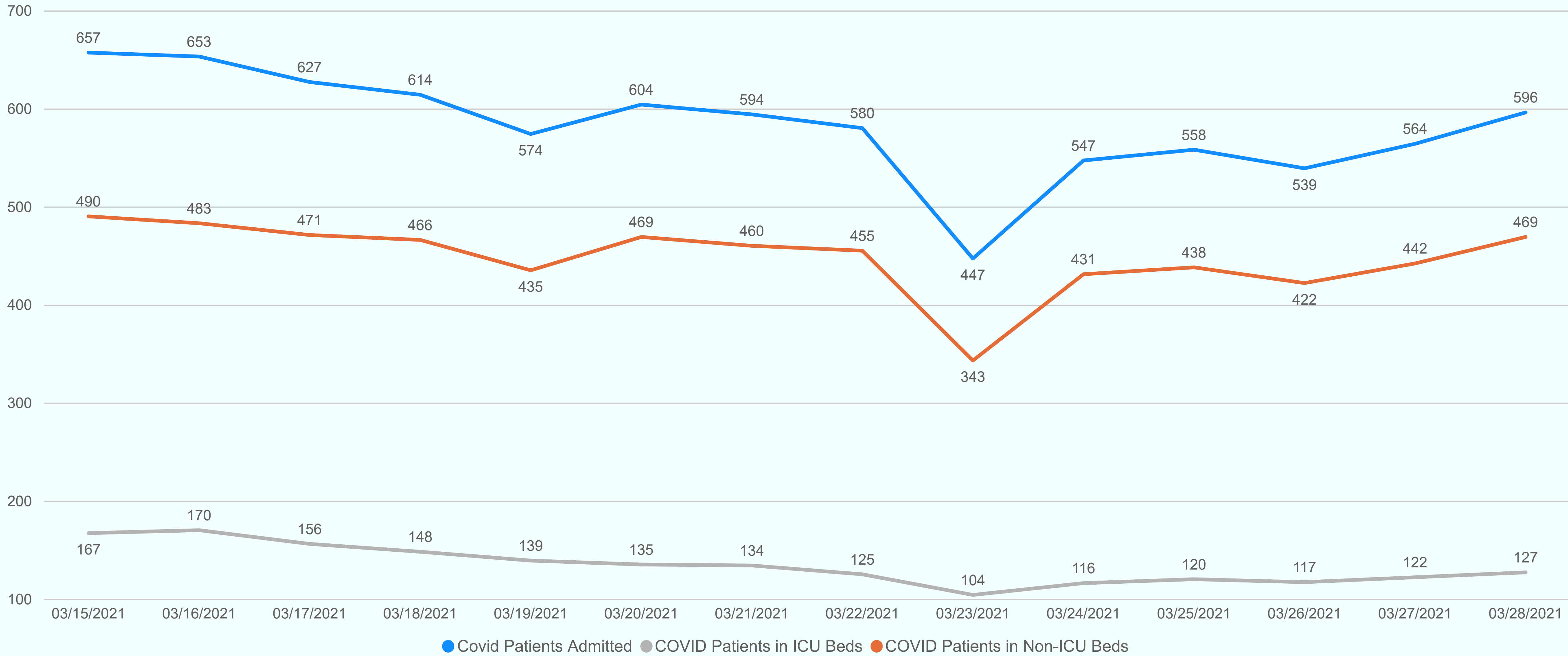

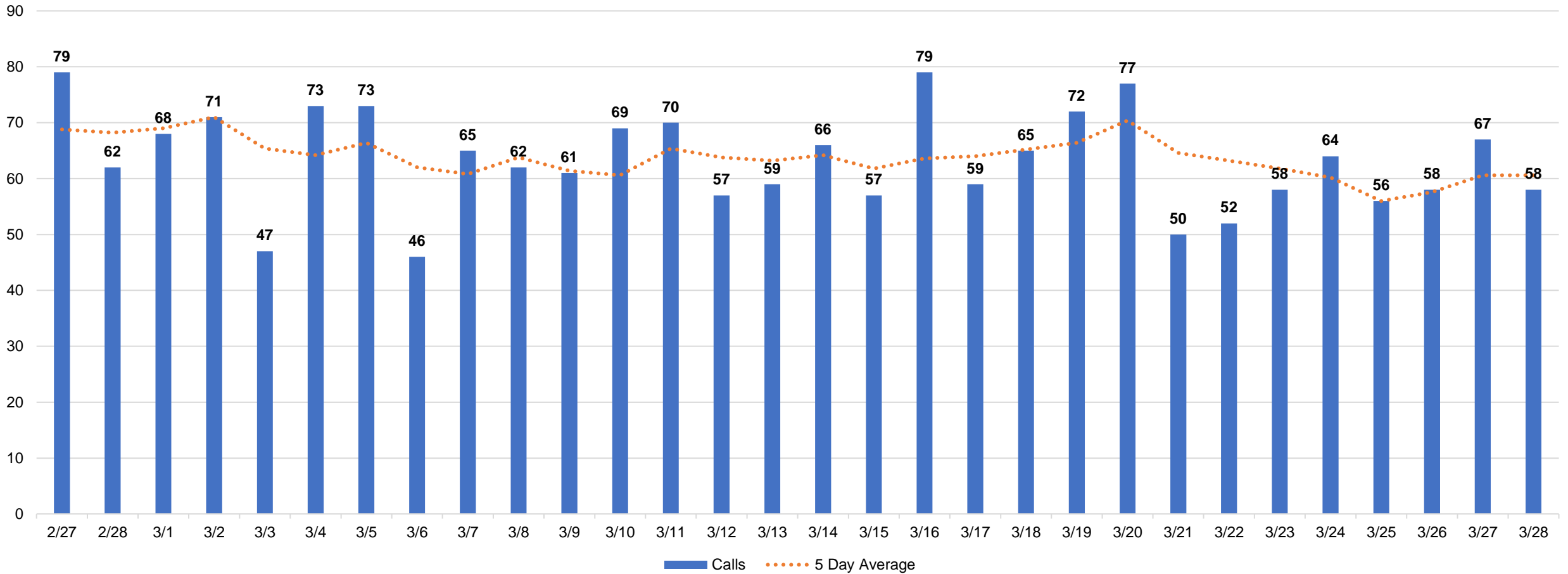

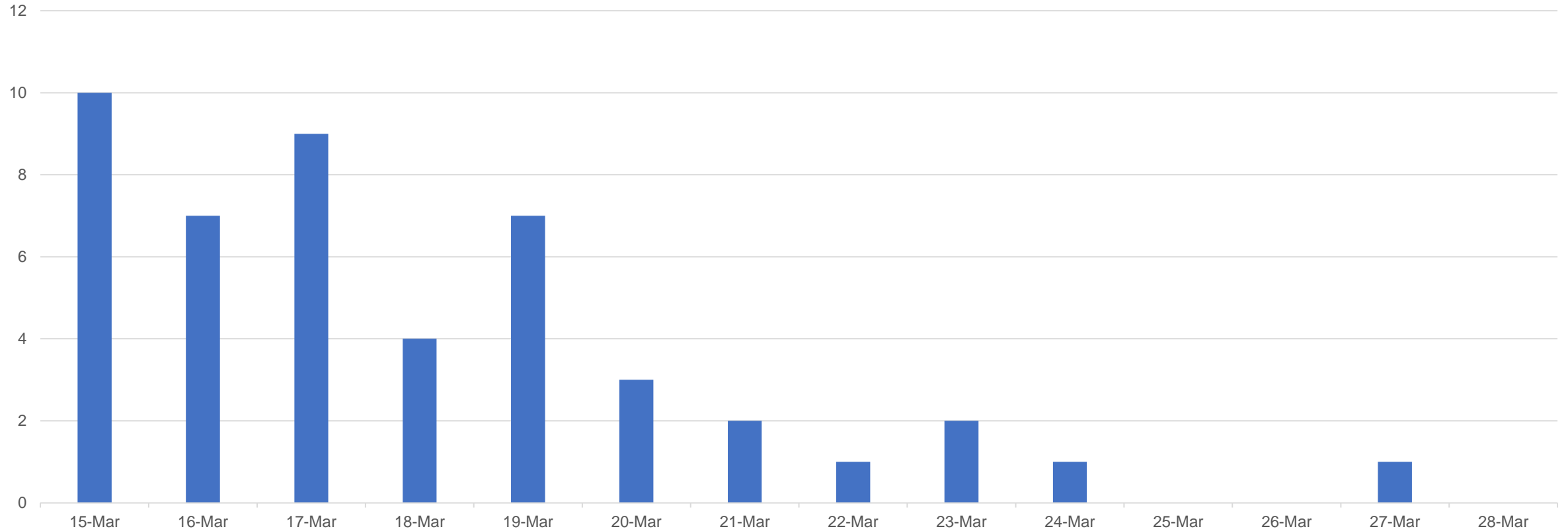
# Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Calls

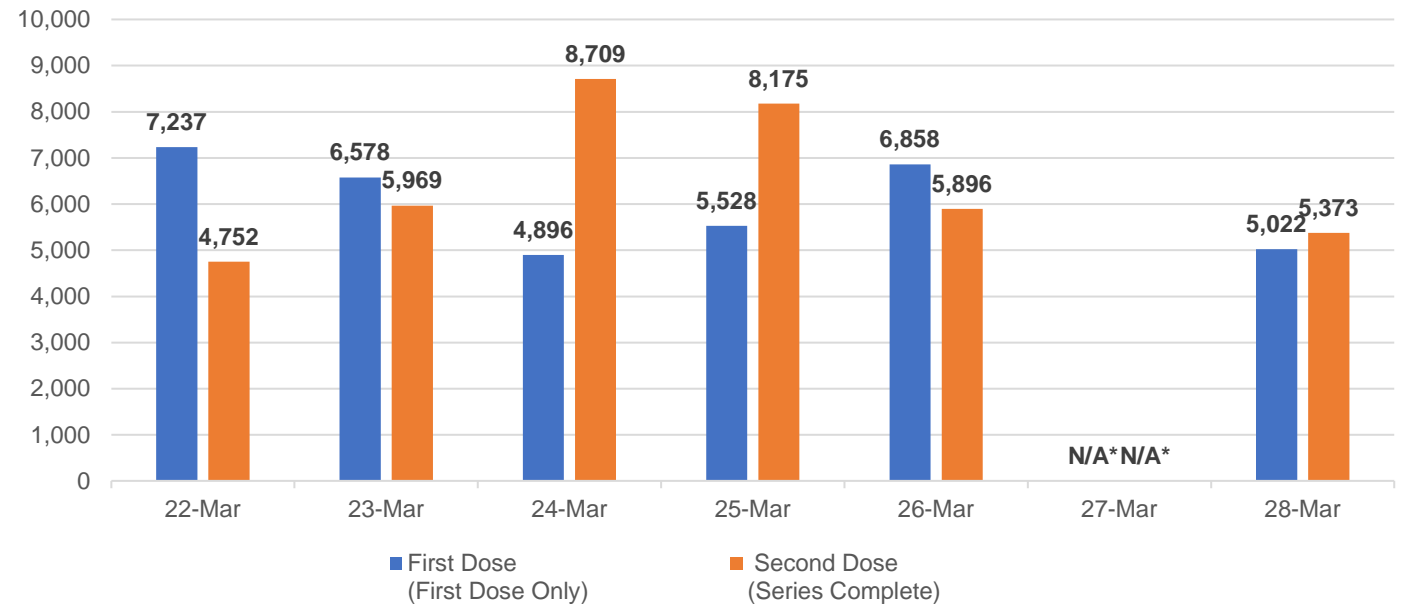

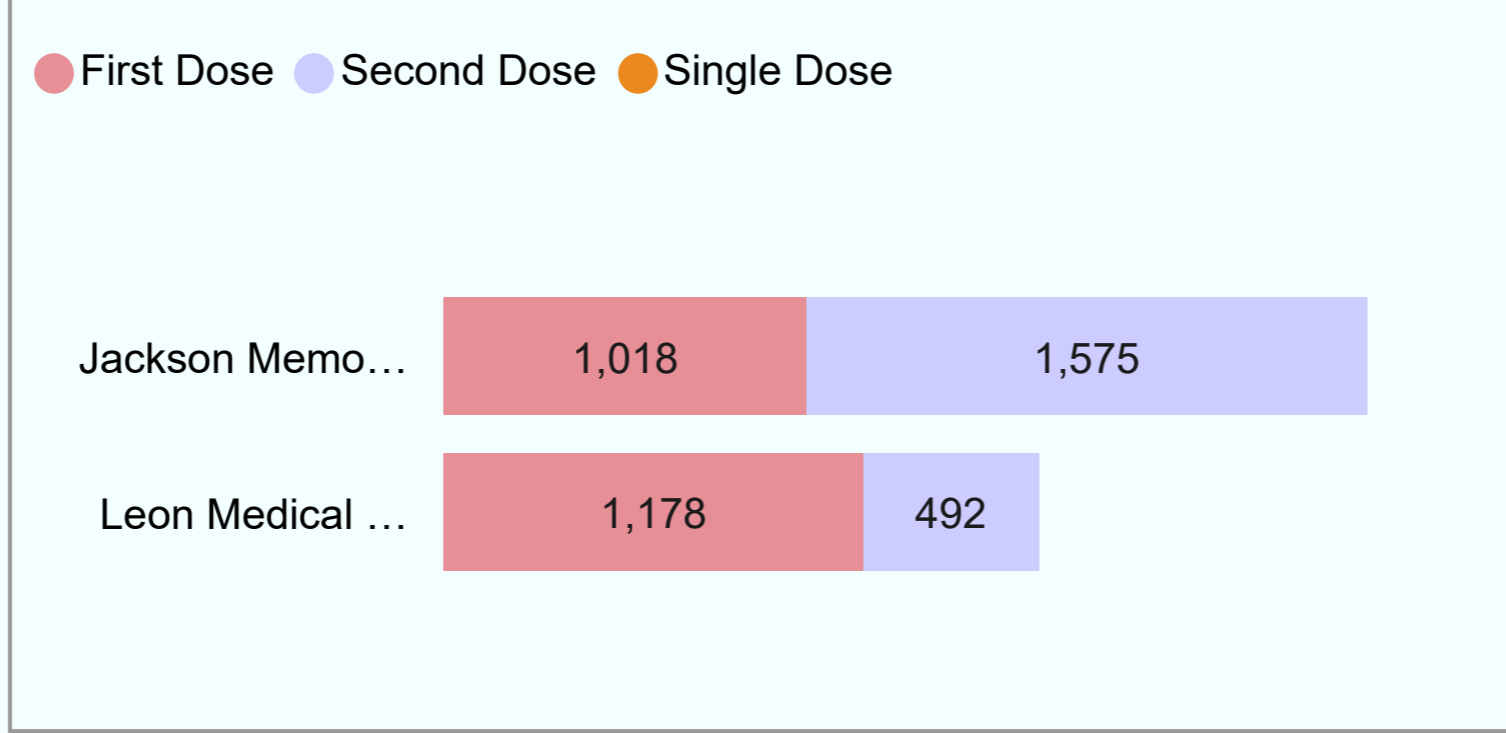

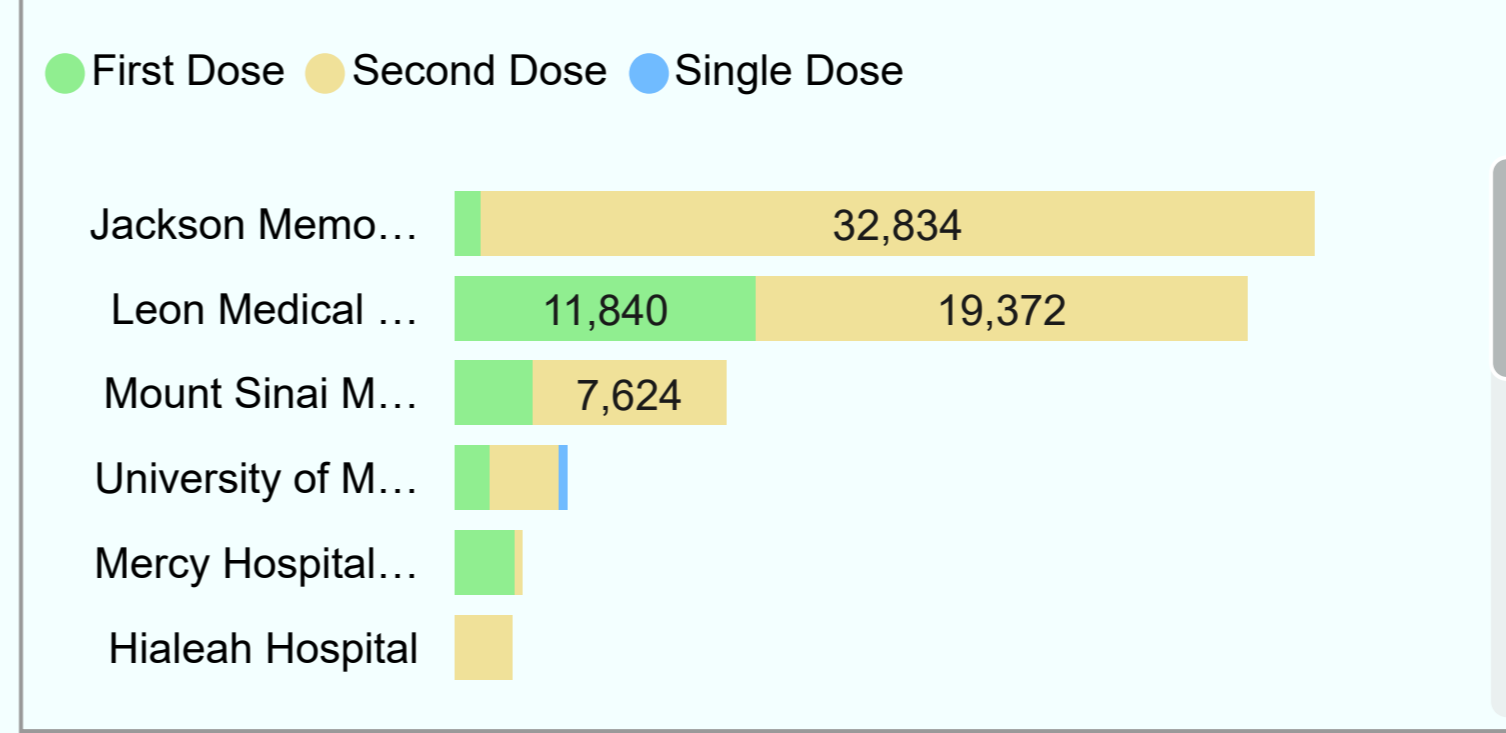

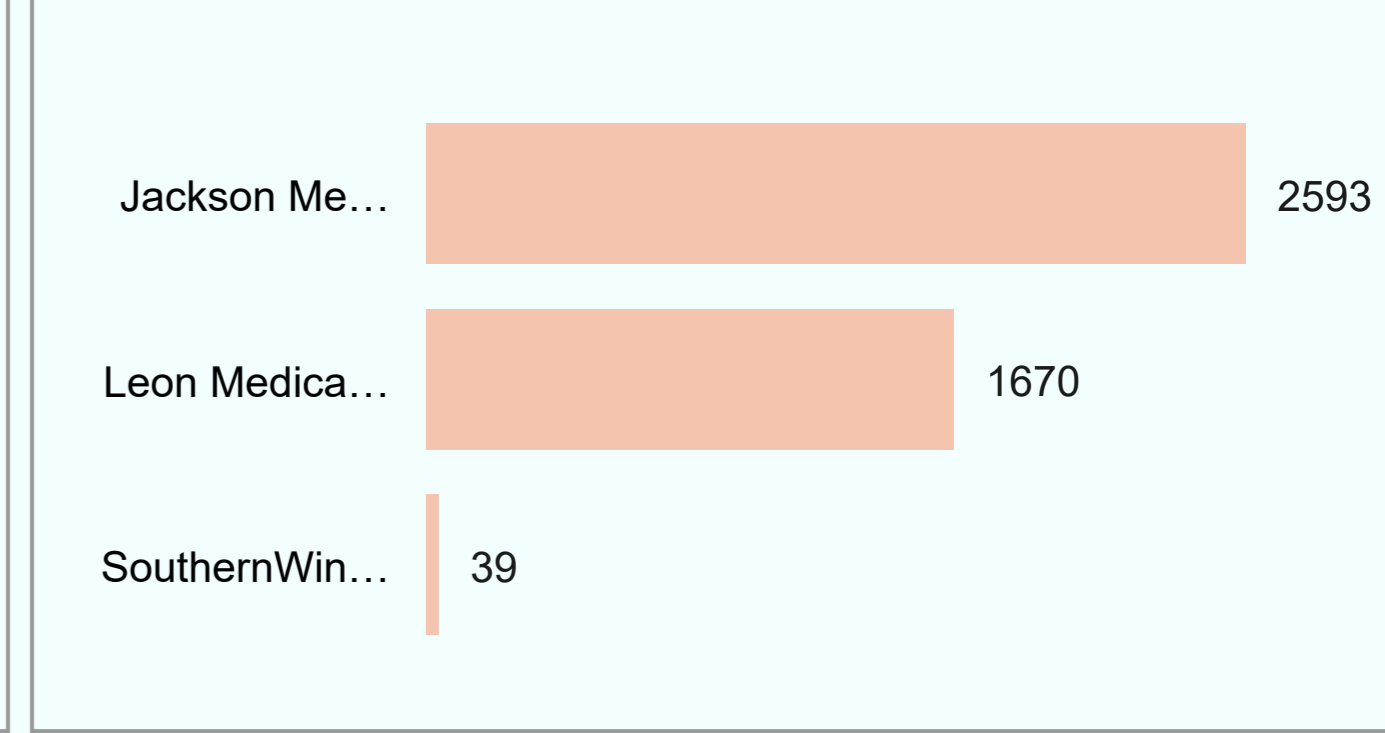
Vaccines Administered by Hospital



Vaccines On Hand by Hospital



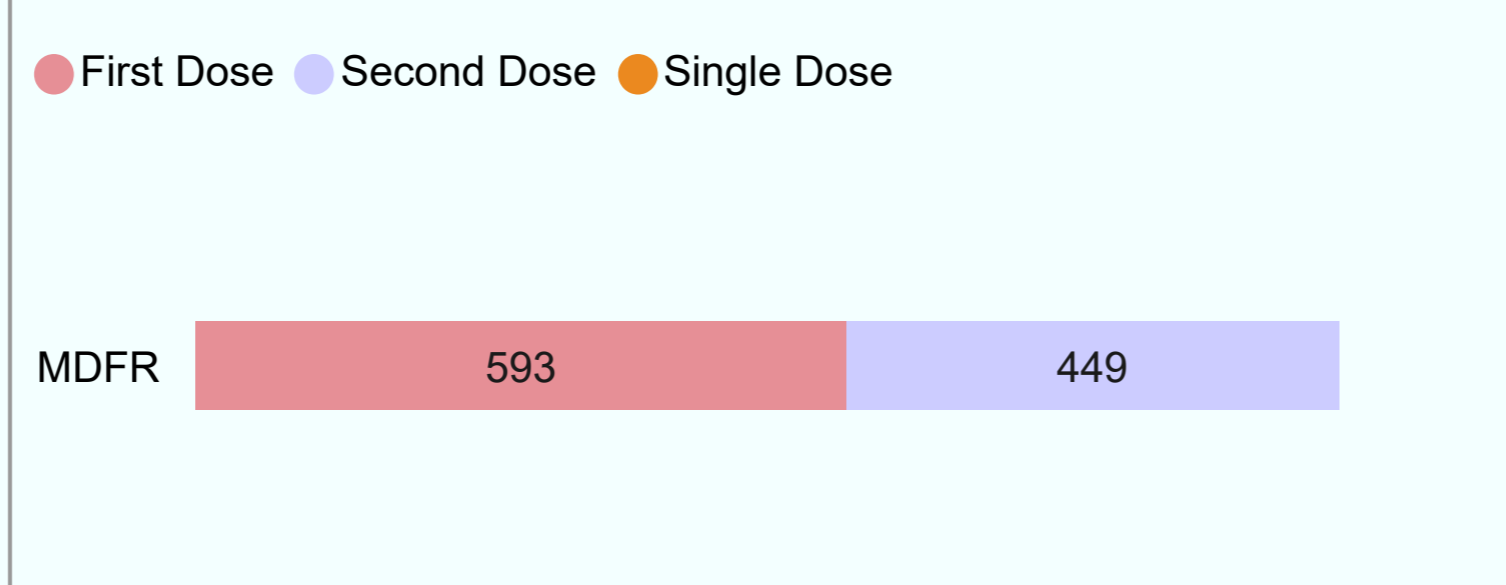

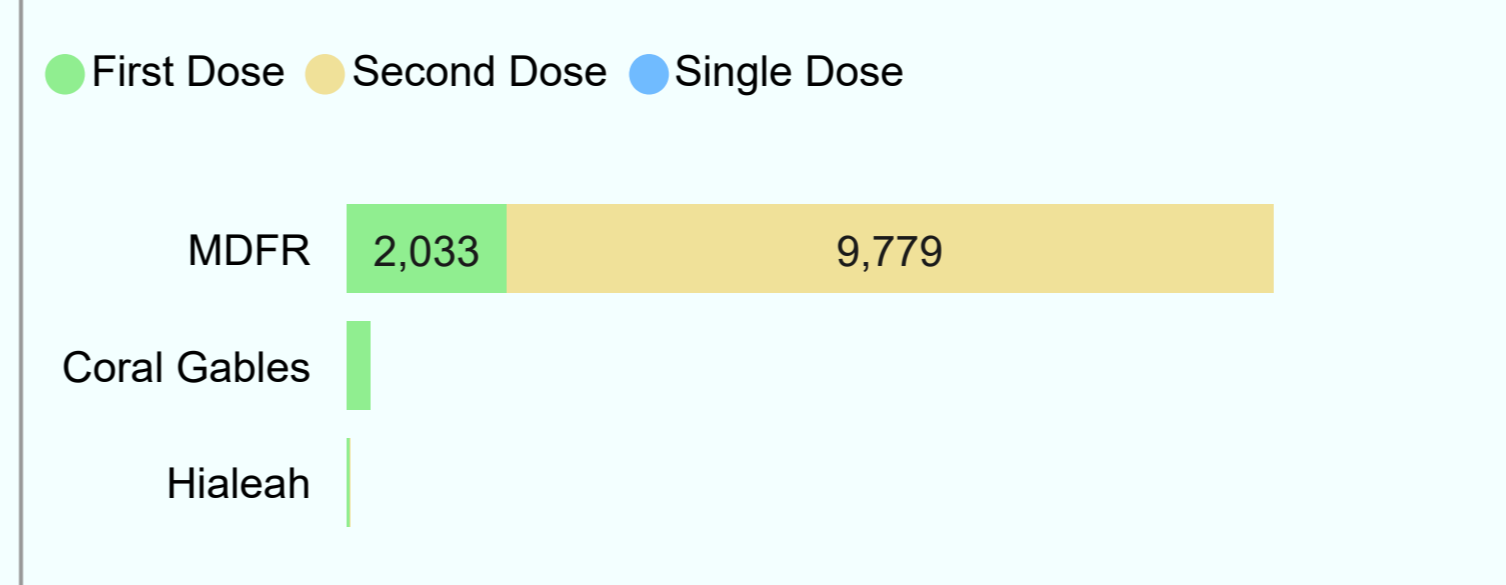

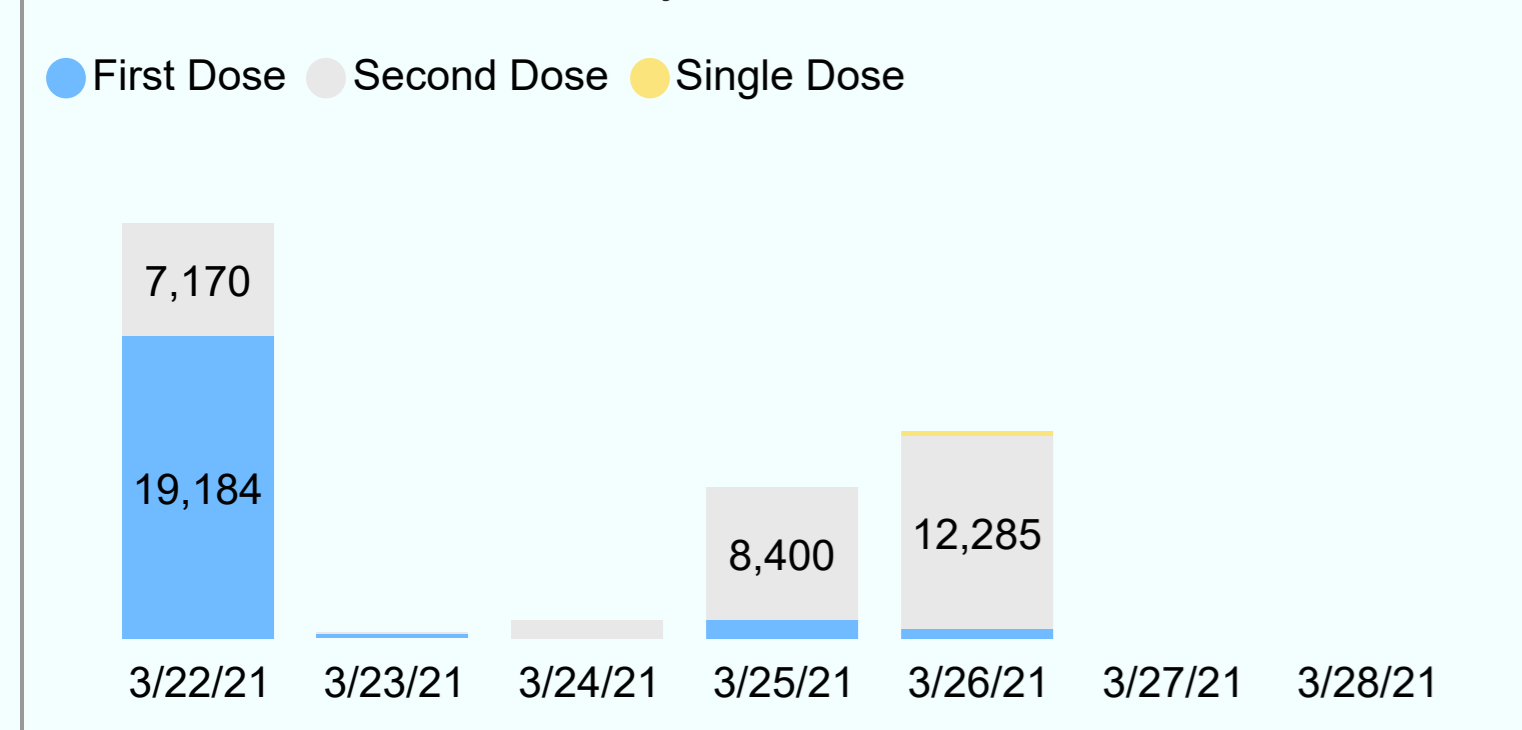

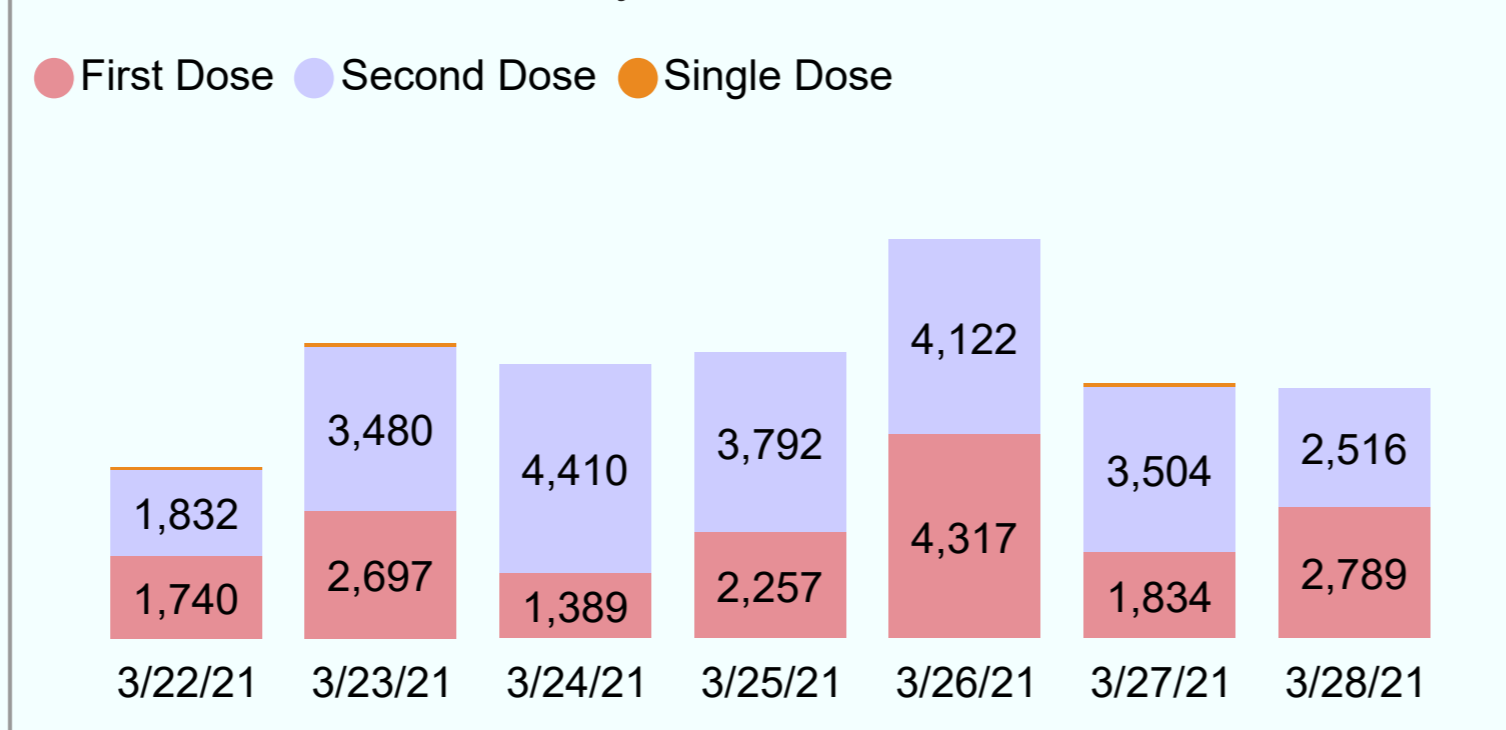

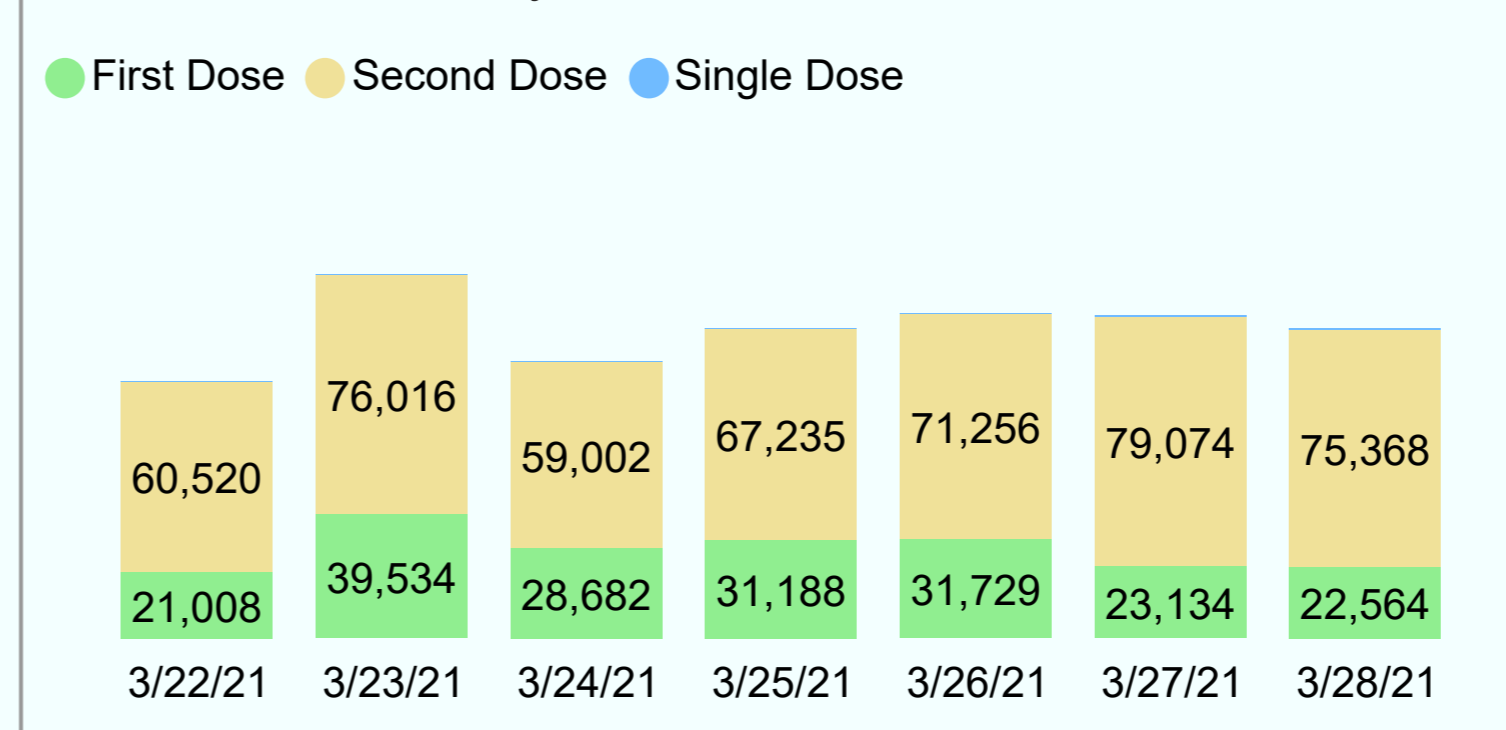

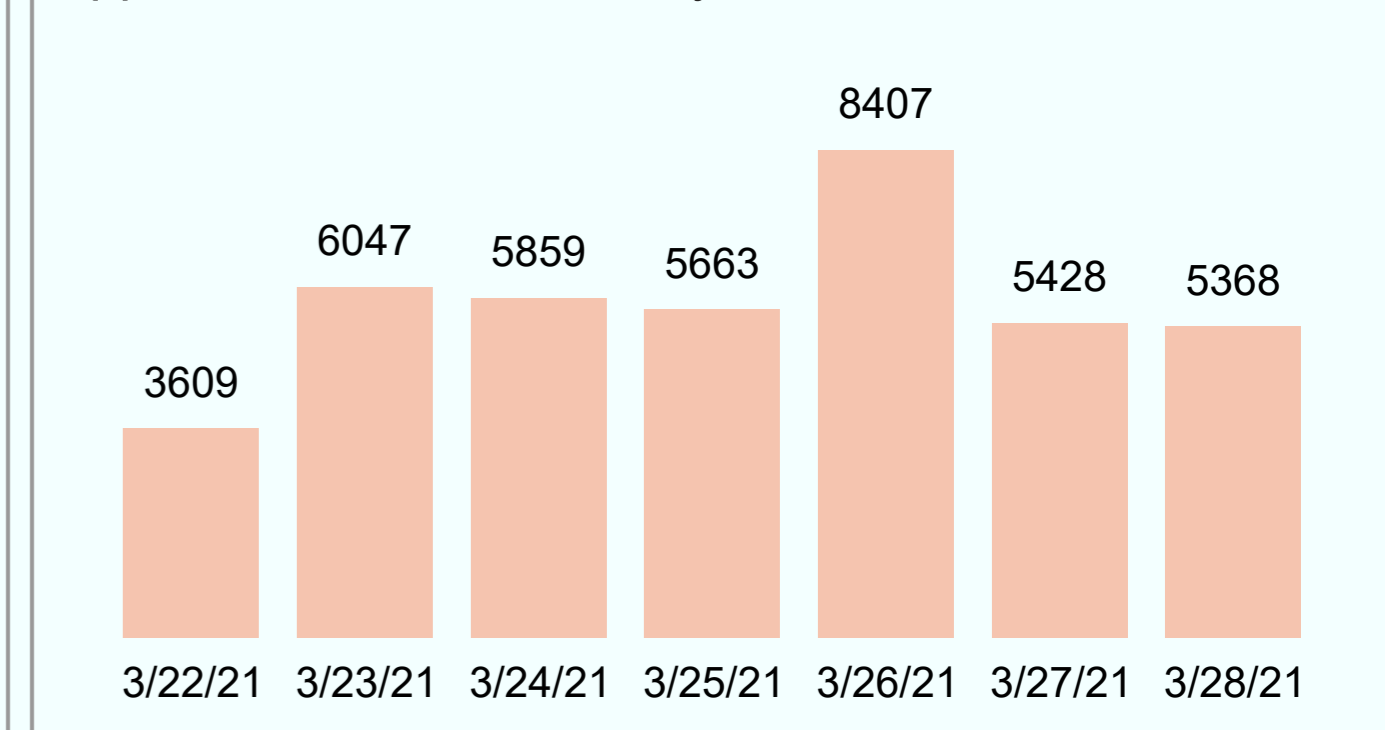

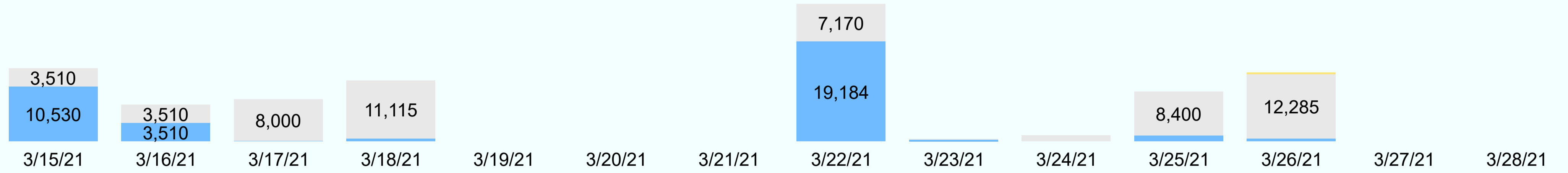

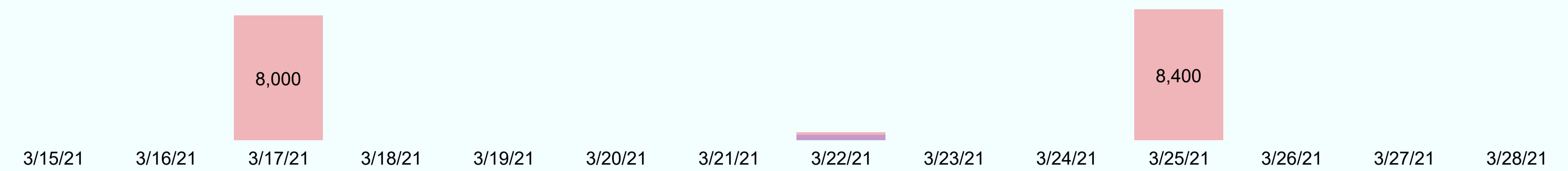

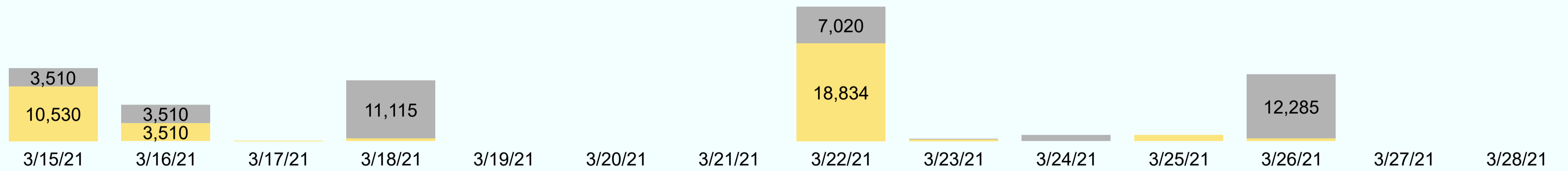

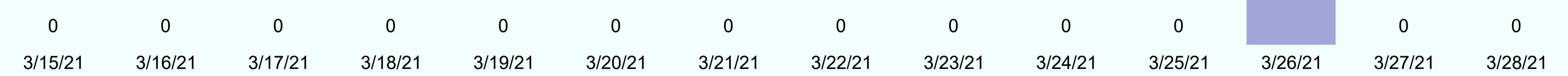

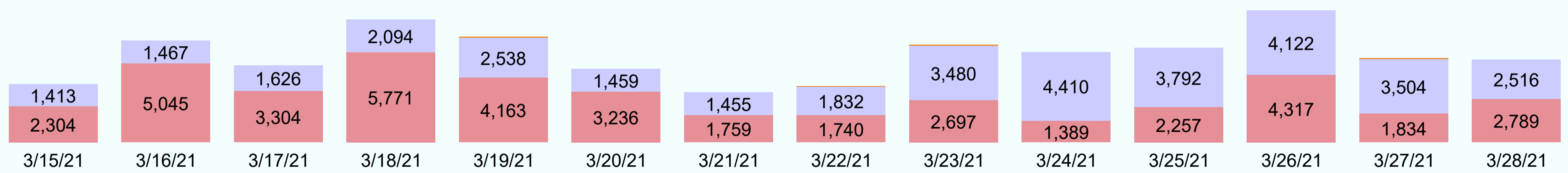

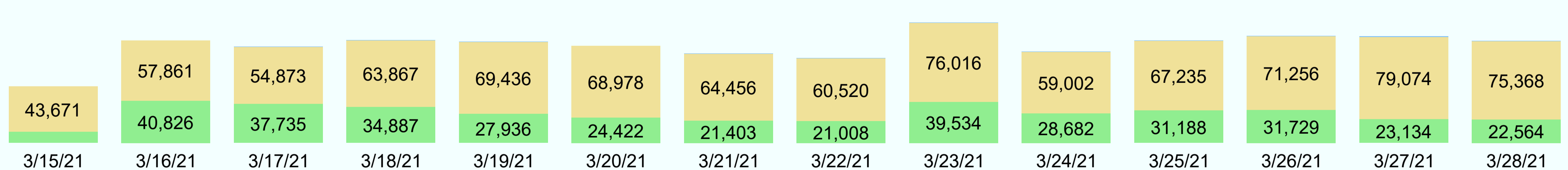
