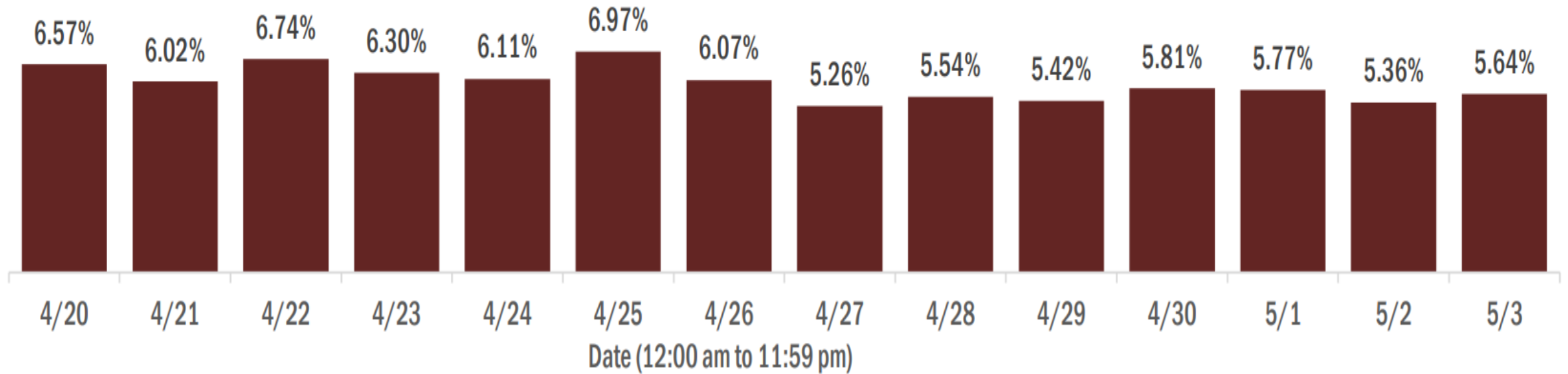

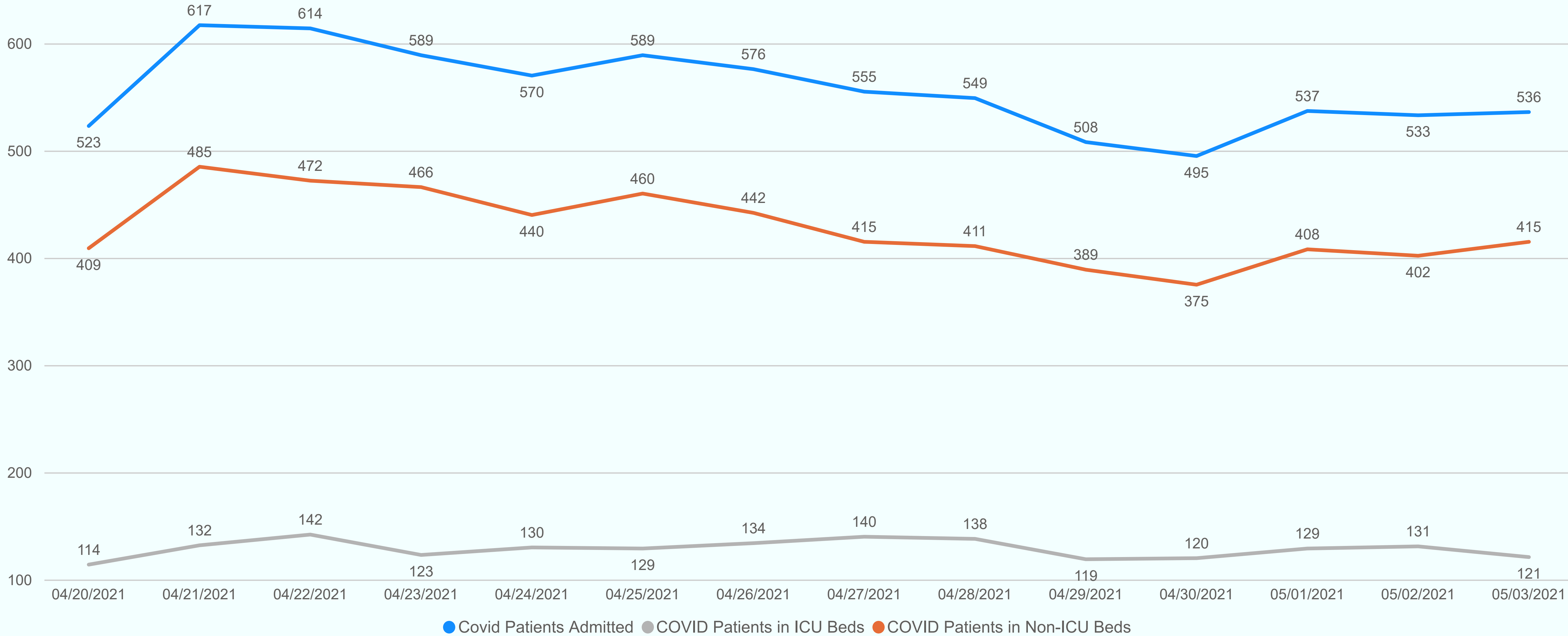

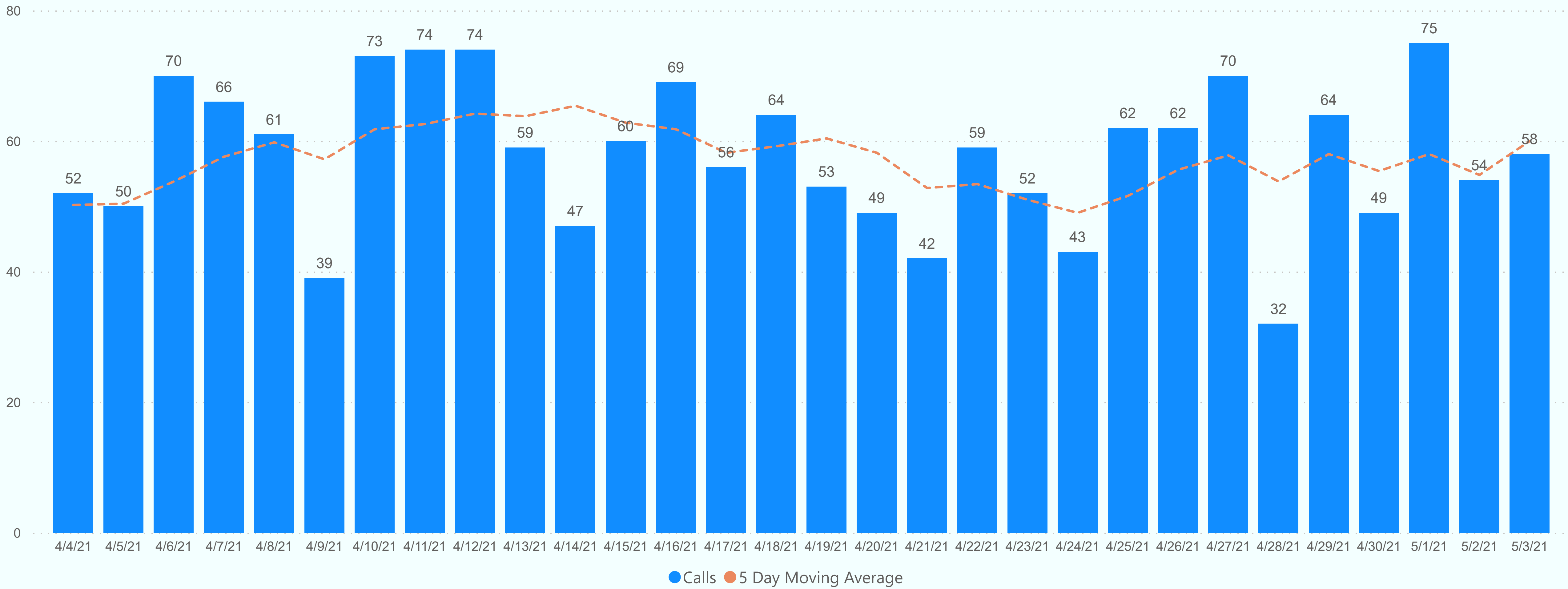

# Cumulative FDOH Deaths - 14 Days

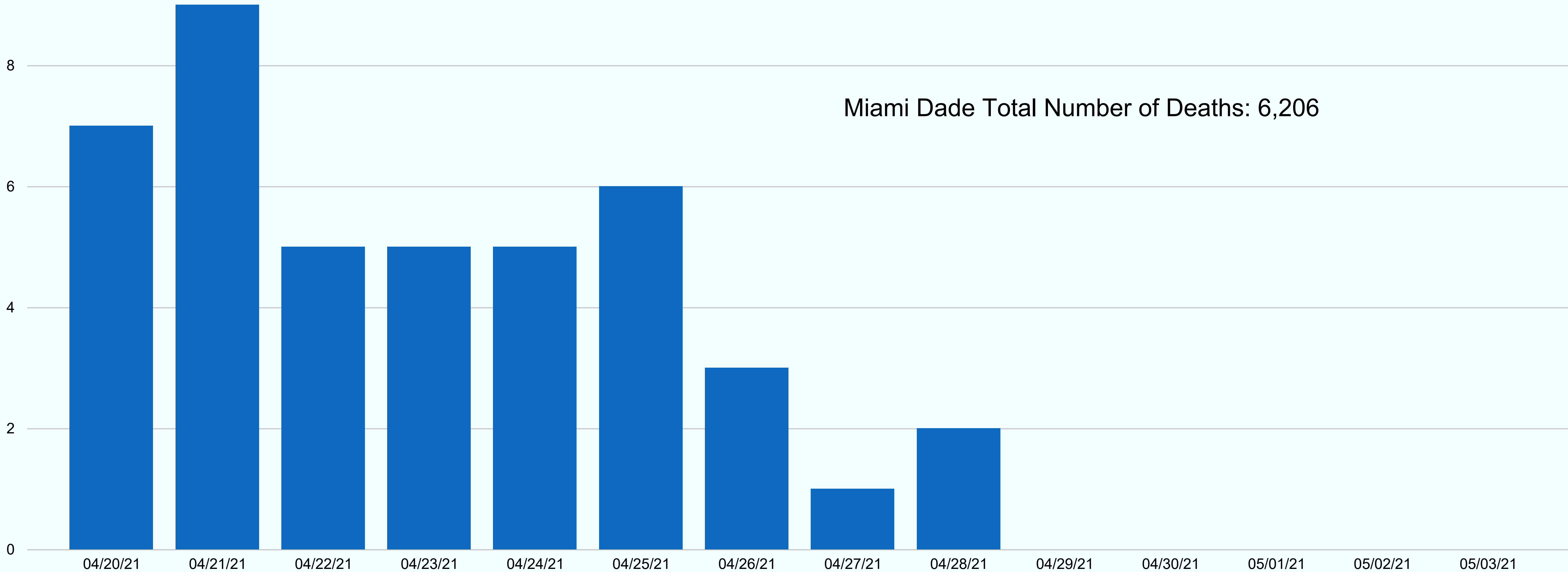

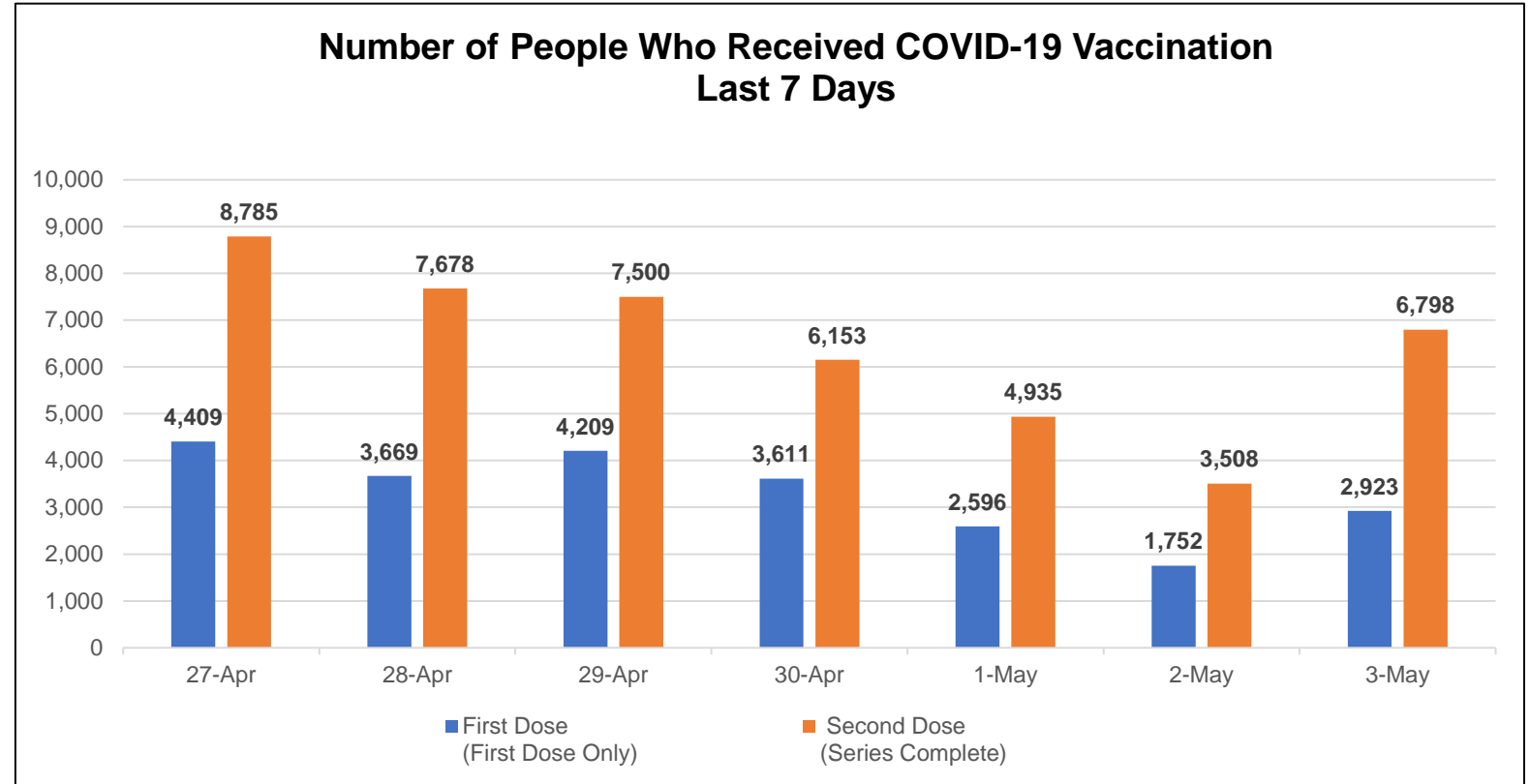

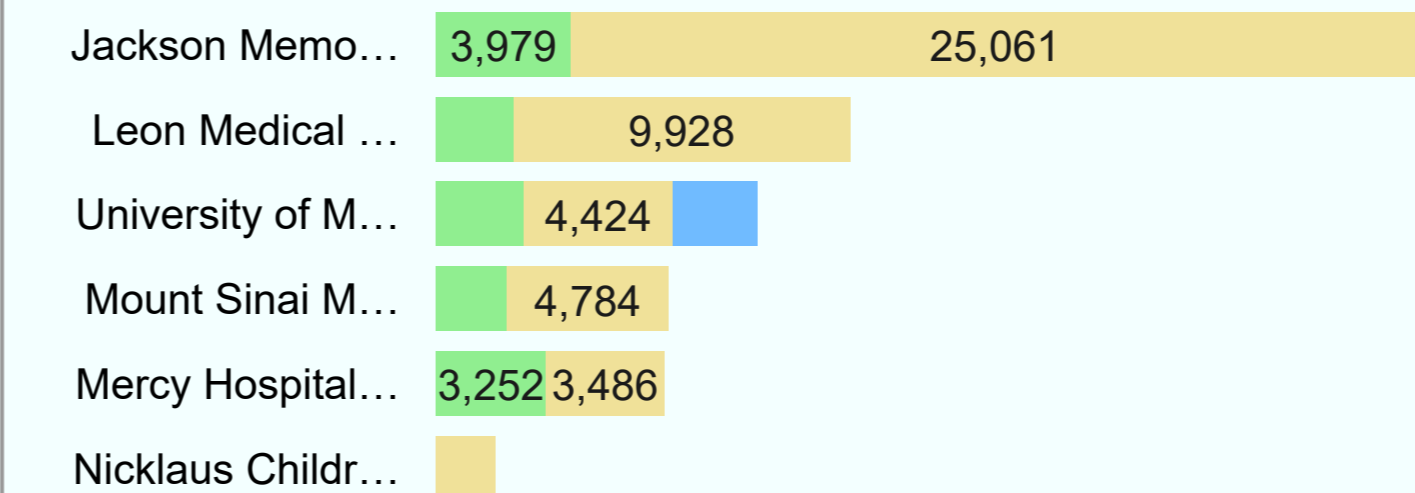

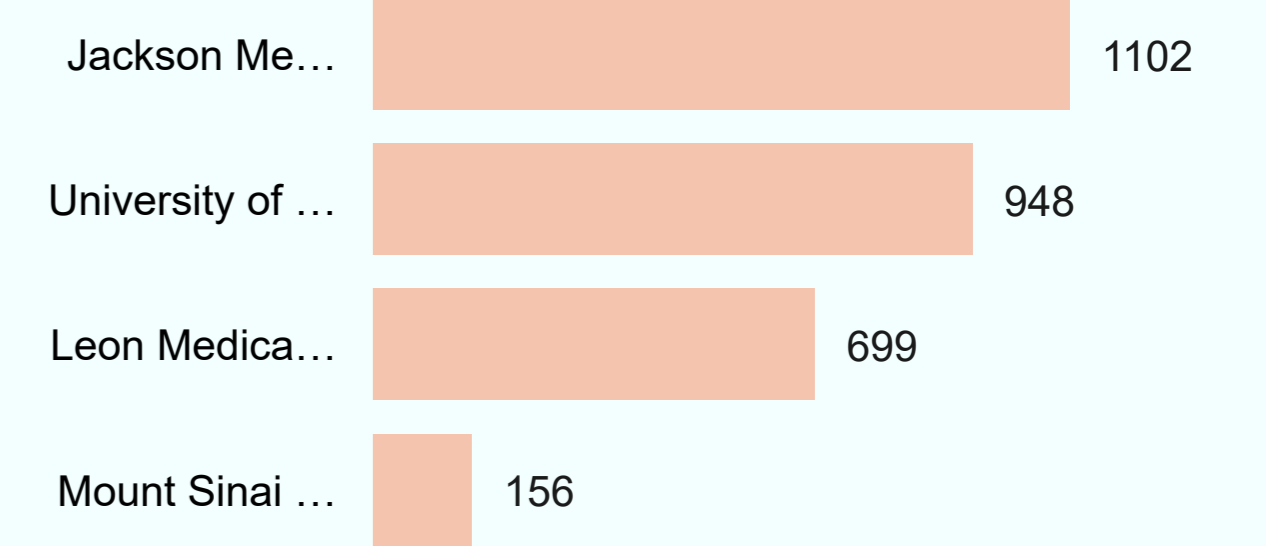


### Vaccines On Hand by Hospital

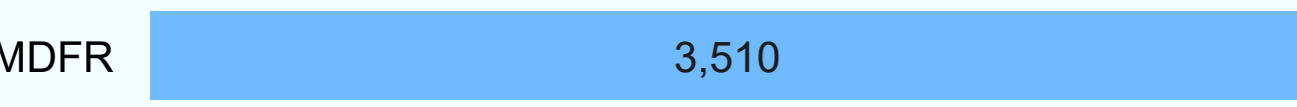

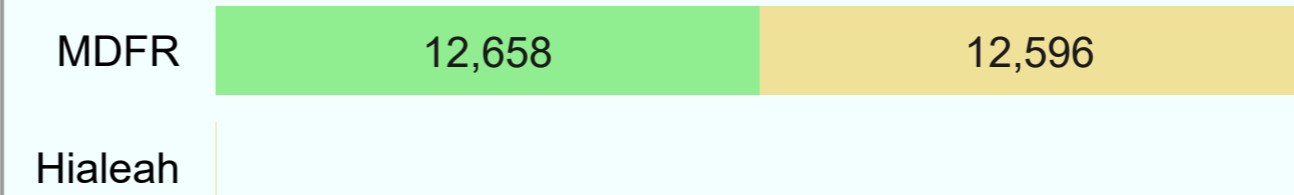

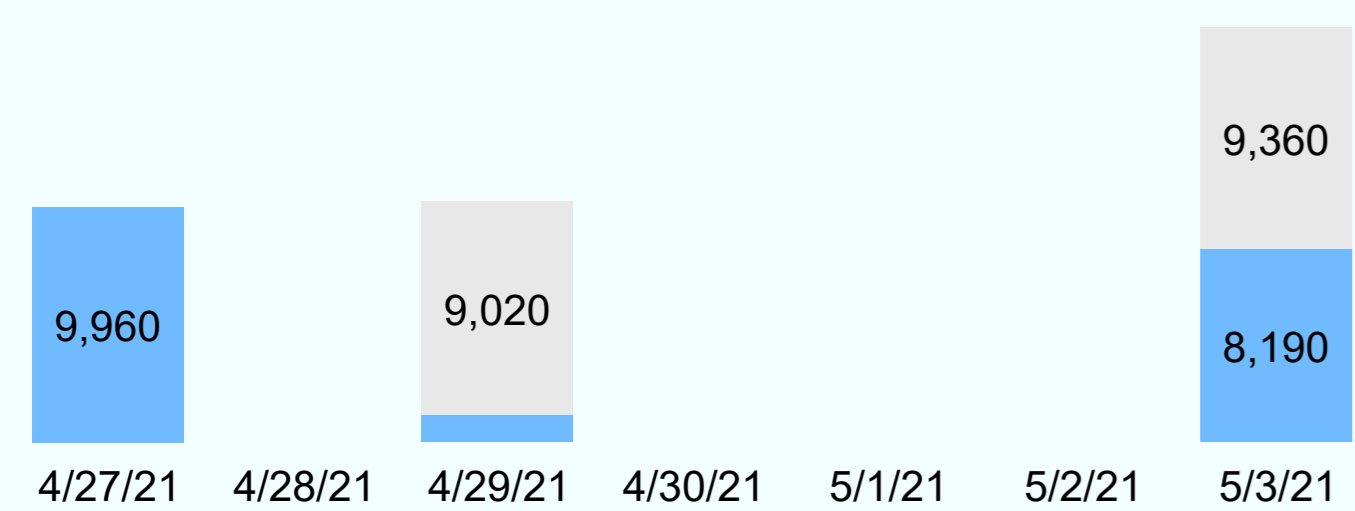

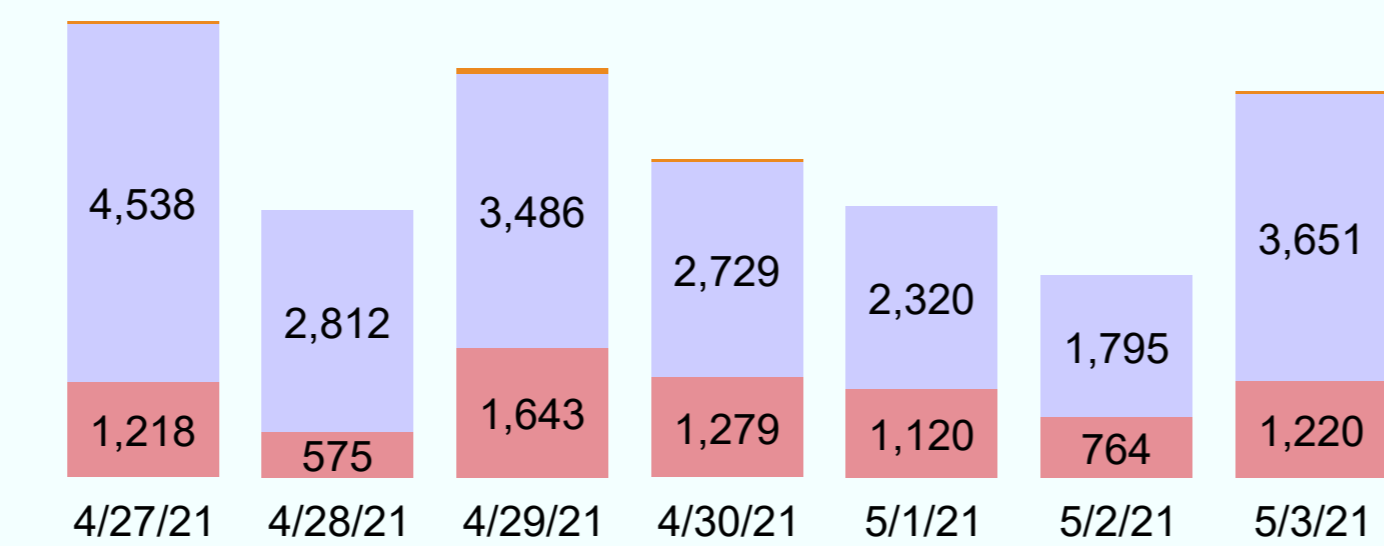

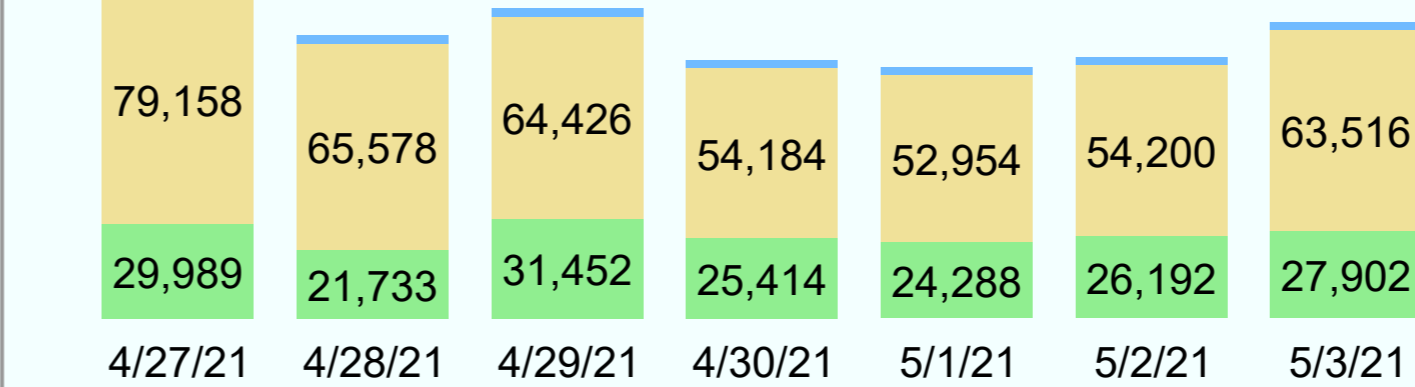
### Vaccines Administered by Date

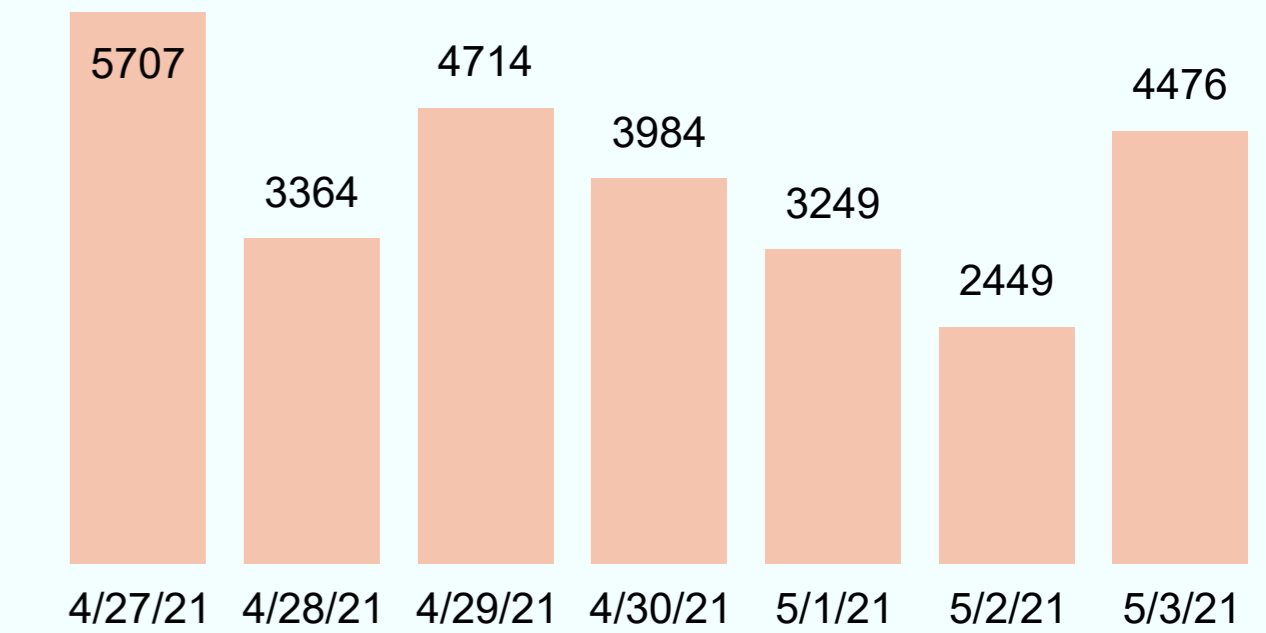


### Vaccines On Hand by Date
