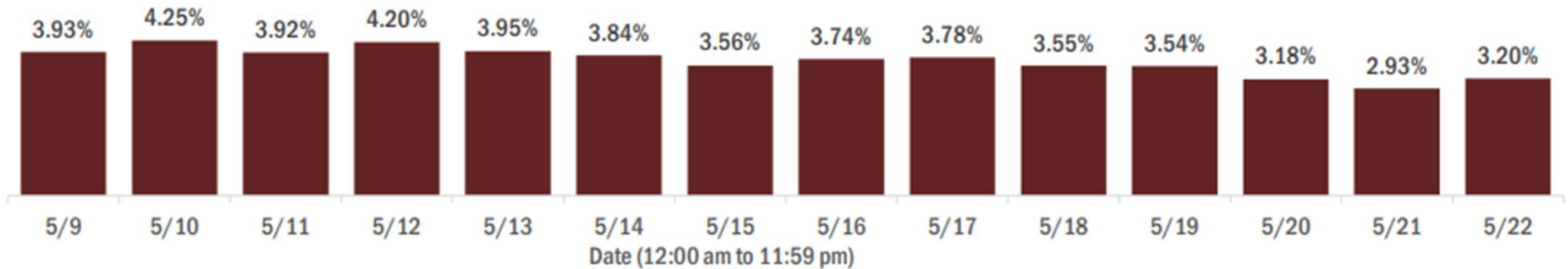

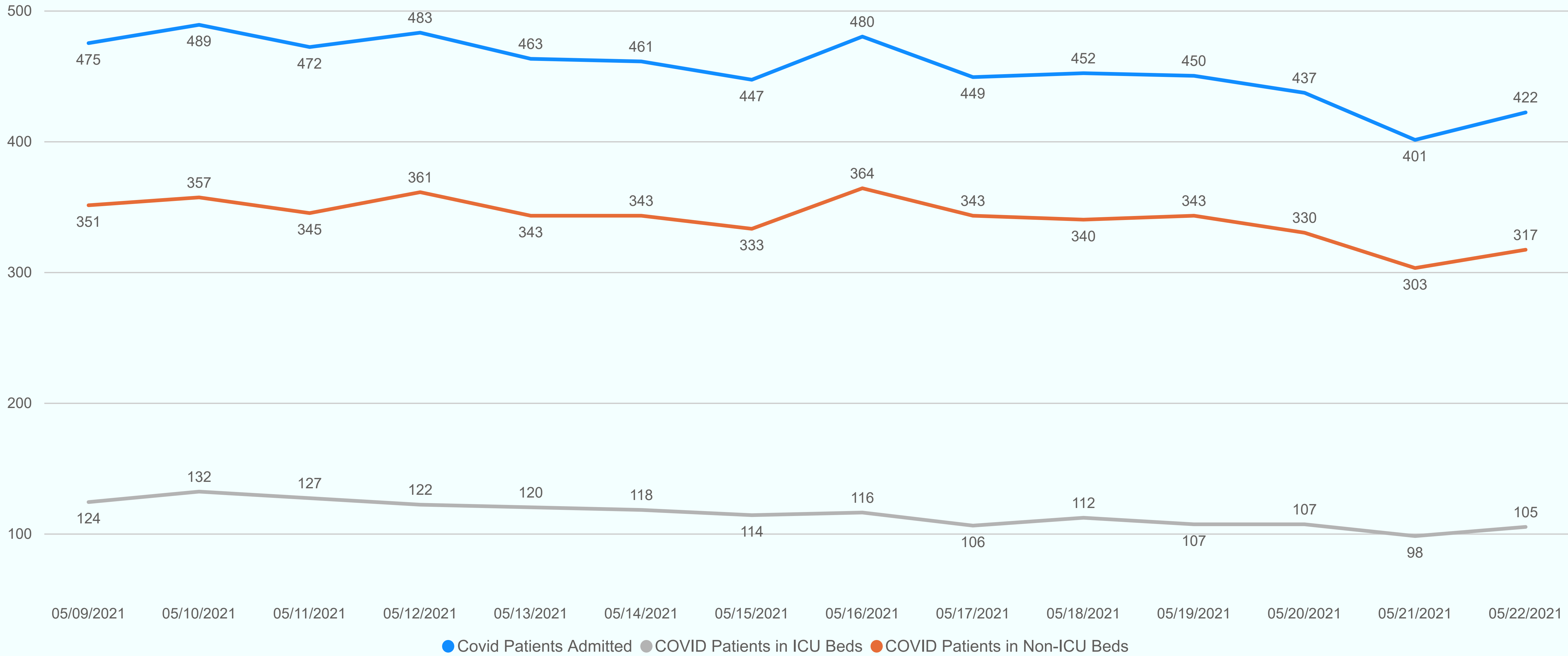

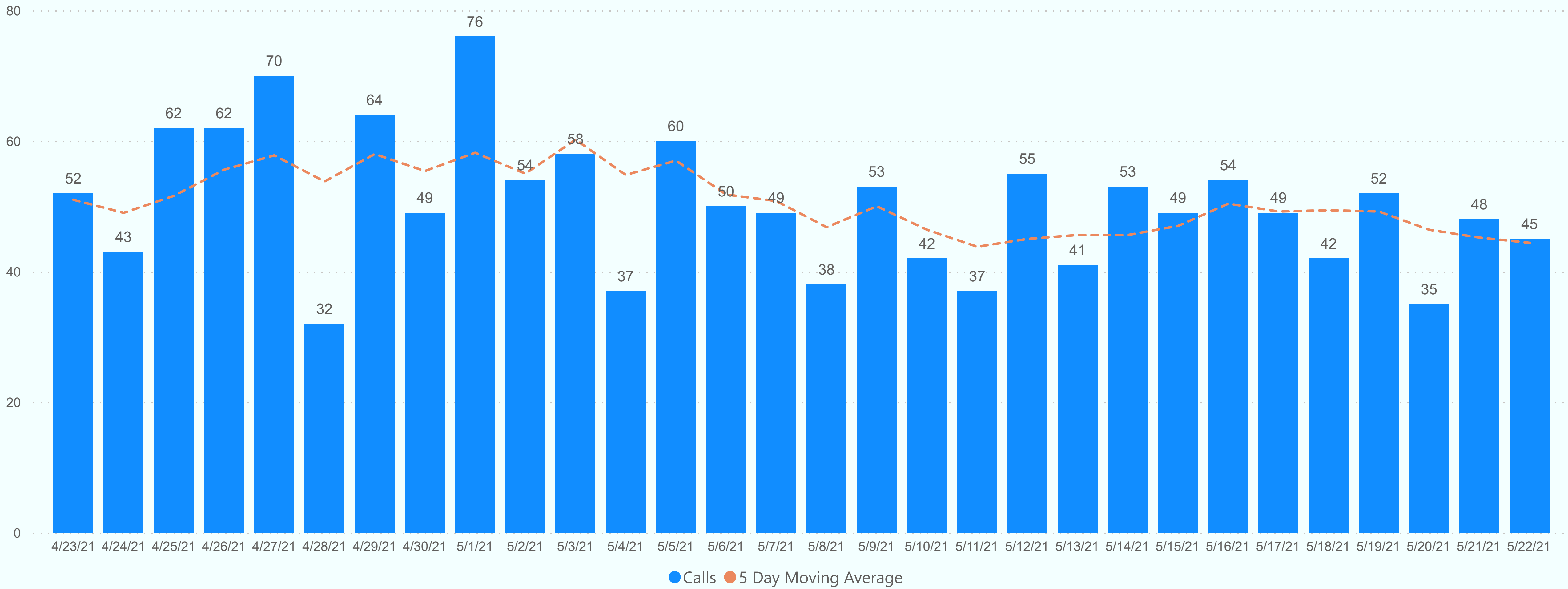

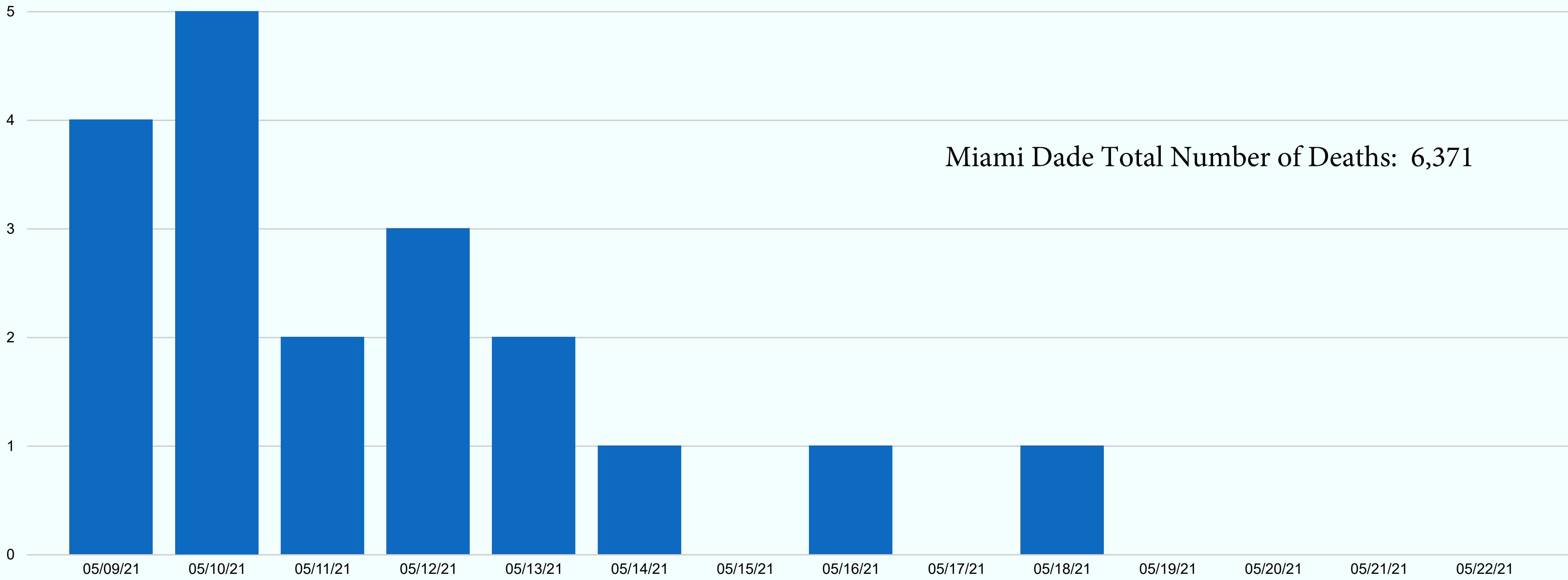
# Cumulative FDOH Deaths - 14 Days

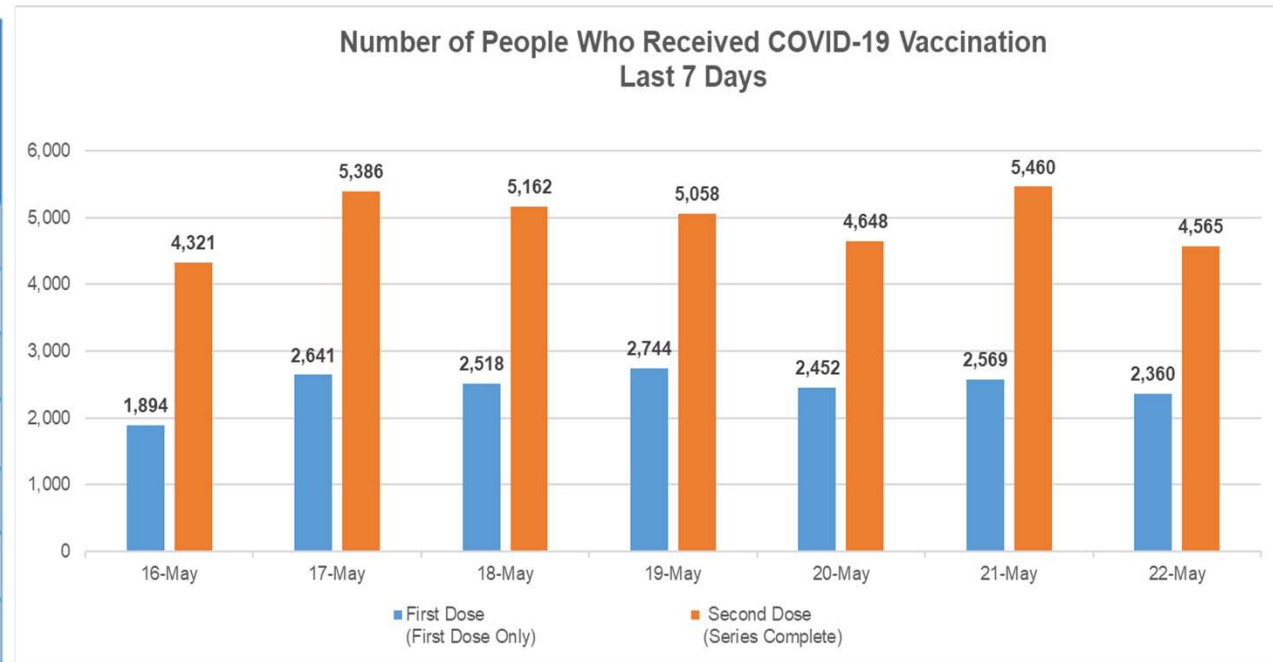
