### Miami-Dade County COVID-19 Testing Synopsis


- The total number of PCR confirmed cases has increased to 15,786 in week 31 from 13,268 in the previous week.
- On the average, there was an increase of approximately 360 every day. Additionally, there are 5,536 probable cases with antigen test positive.
- For PCR confirmed cases, the median age is 37 years (range is 0 to 111 years old), 14.9% are children aged 5-17 (15.5% in the previous week), 28.6% are young adults aged 18-34 years (29.0% % in the previous week).



Cumulative Number of Individuals Vaccinated and New Cases of COVID-19 in Florida




Cumulative and Weekly Number of Individuals vaccinated for COVID-19 by Groups for Florida






# Miami-Dade County Daily Deaths (Last 14 Days)










