# Miami-Dade County COVID-19 Testing Synopsis

- The total number of new PCR confirmed cases has increased slightly to 16,662 in week 33 from 16,641 in the previous week.
- Additionally, there are 4,709 probable cases with antigen test positive.
- Among the PCR confirmed cases, the median age was 38 years old (previous week was 37 years old), 14.3% were children aged 5-17 (14.1% in the previous week), 25.4% are young adults aged 18-34 years (27.5% % in the previous week ), 47.6% are male and Hispanics account for 71.7% of all new cases.

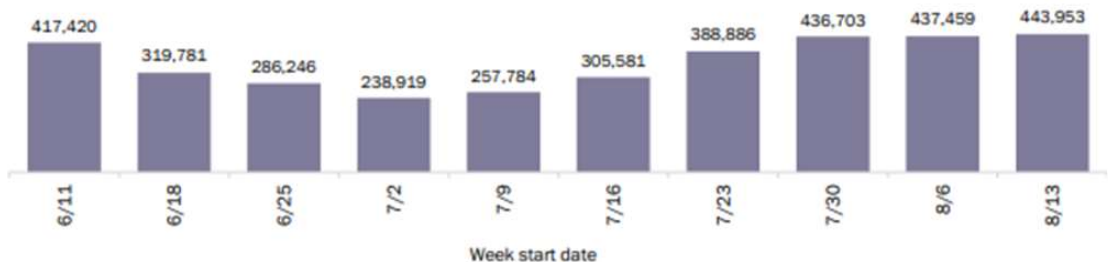

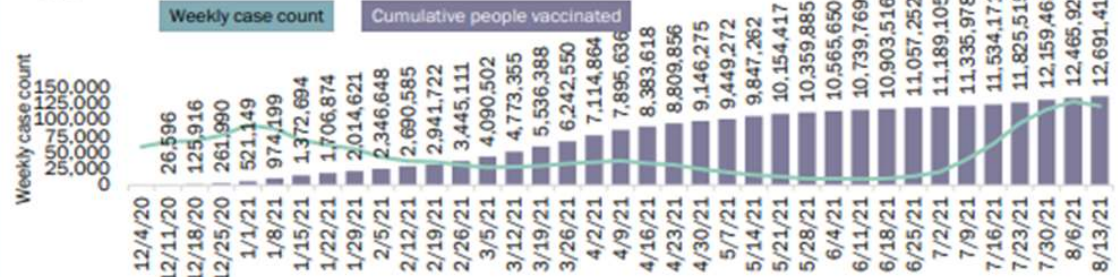

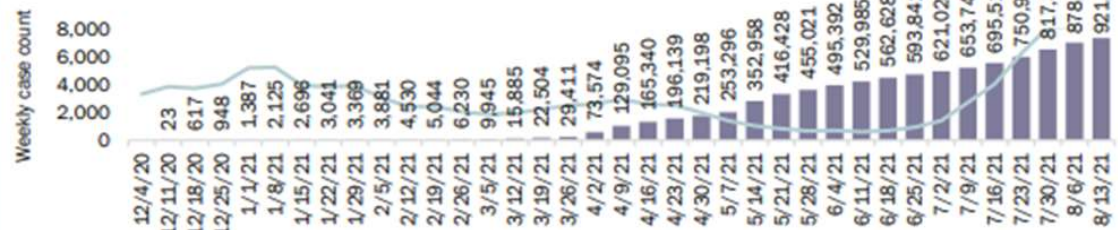

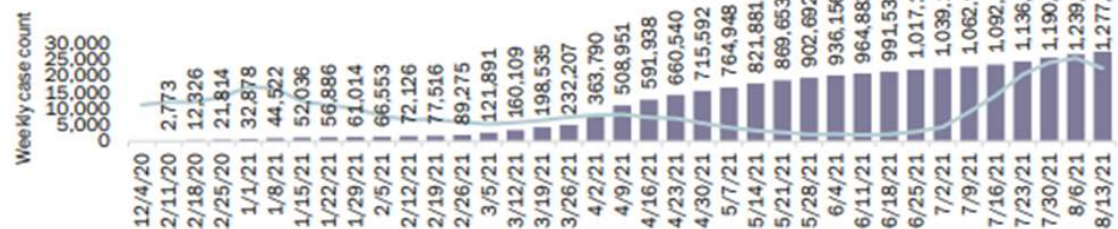

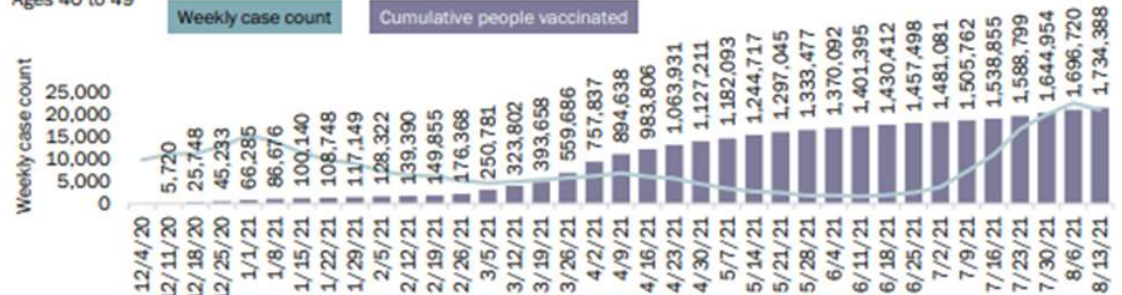

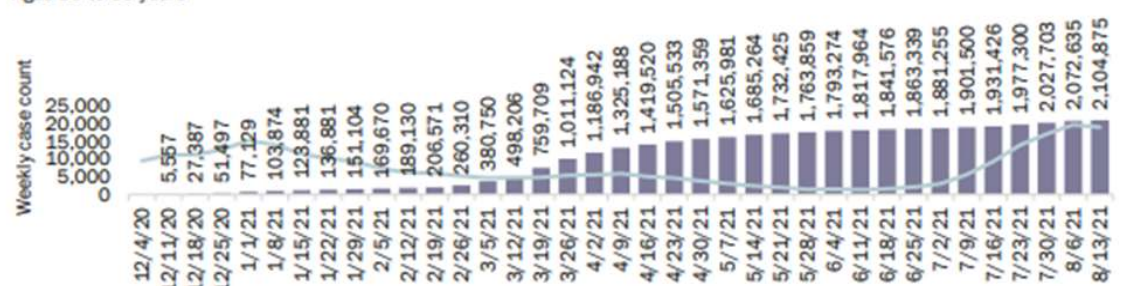

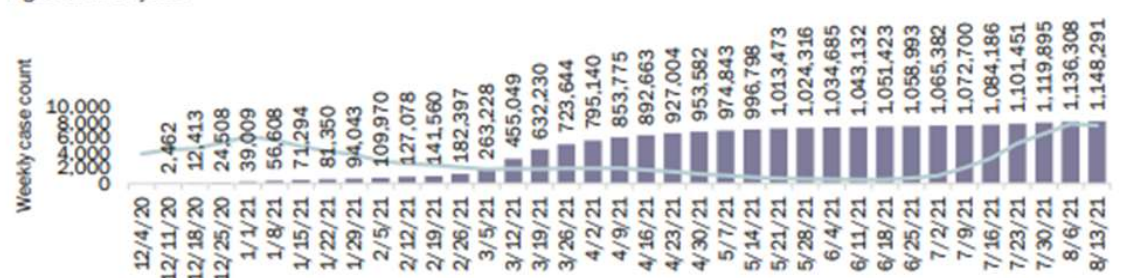

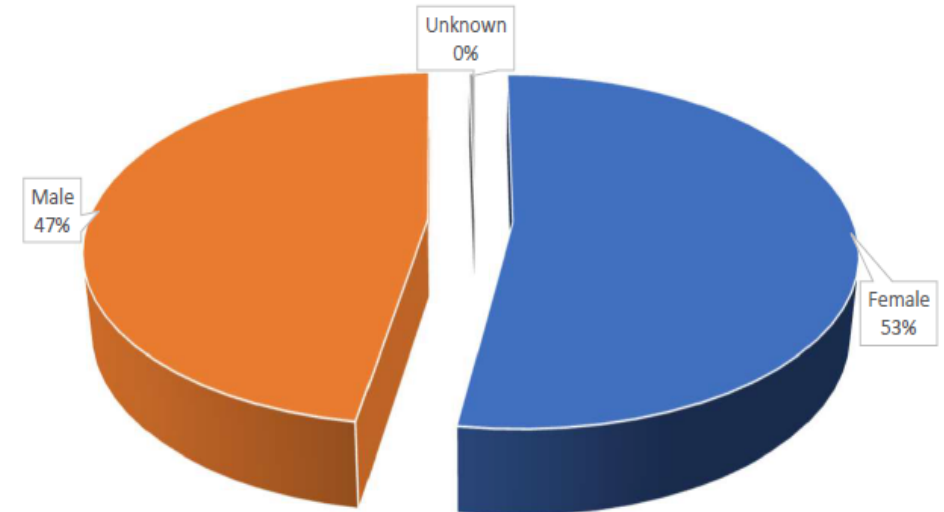

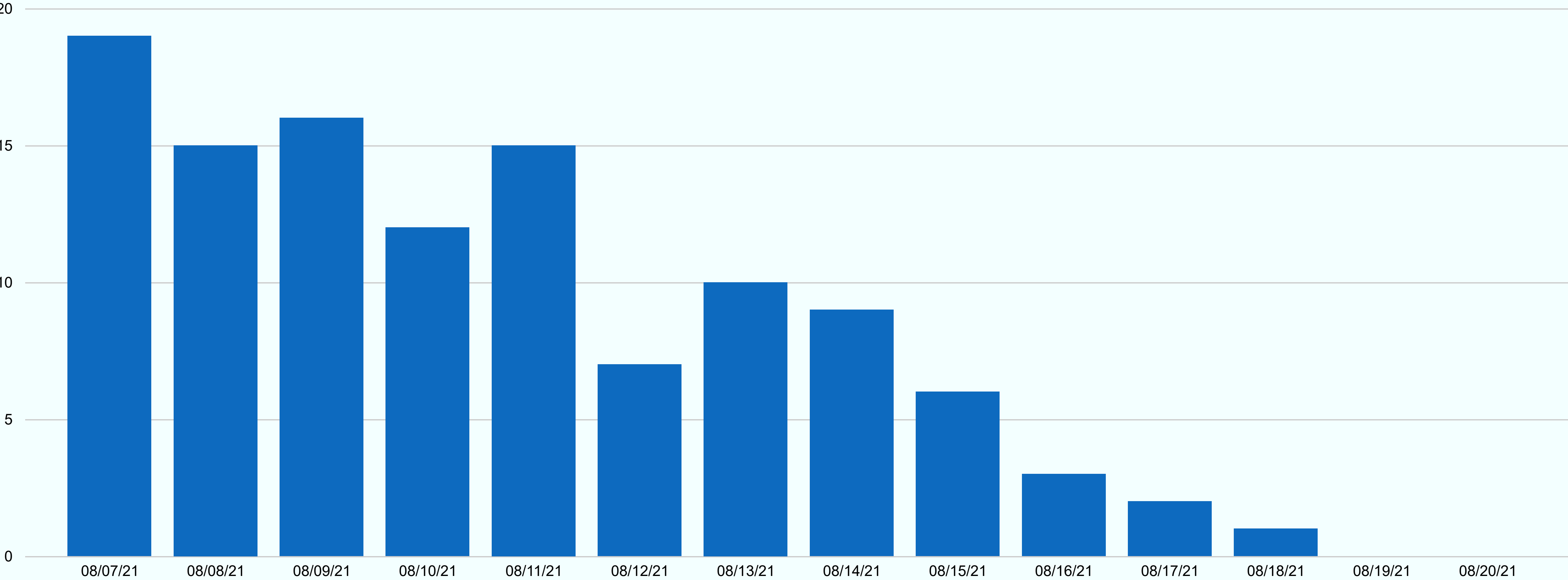

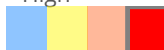

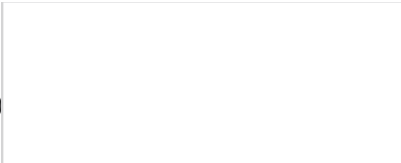

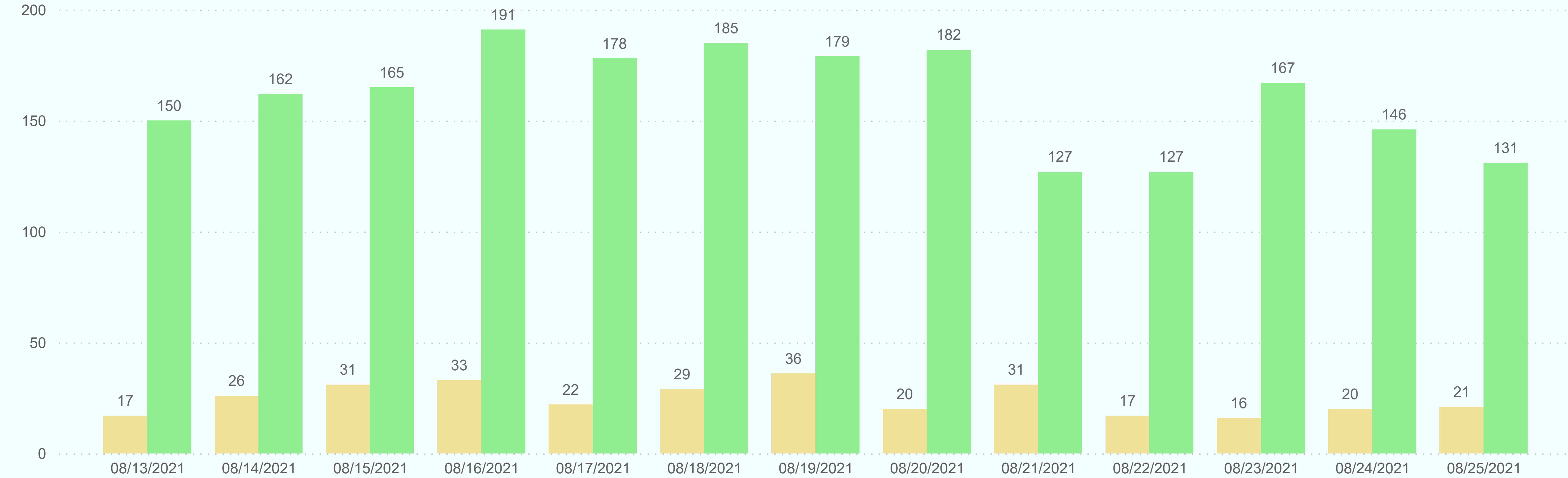

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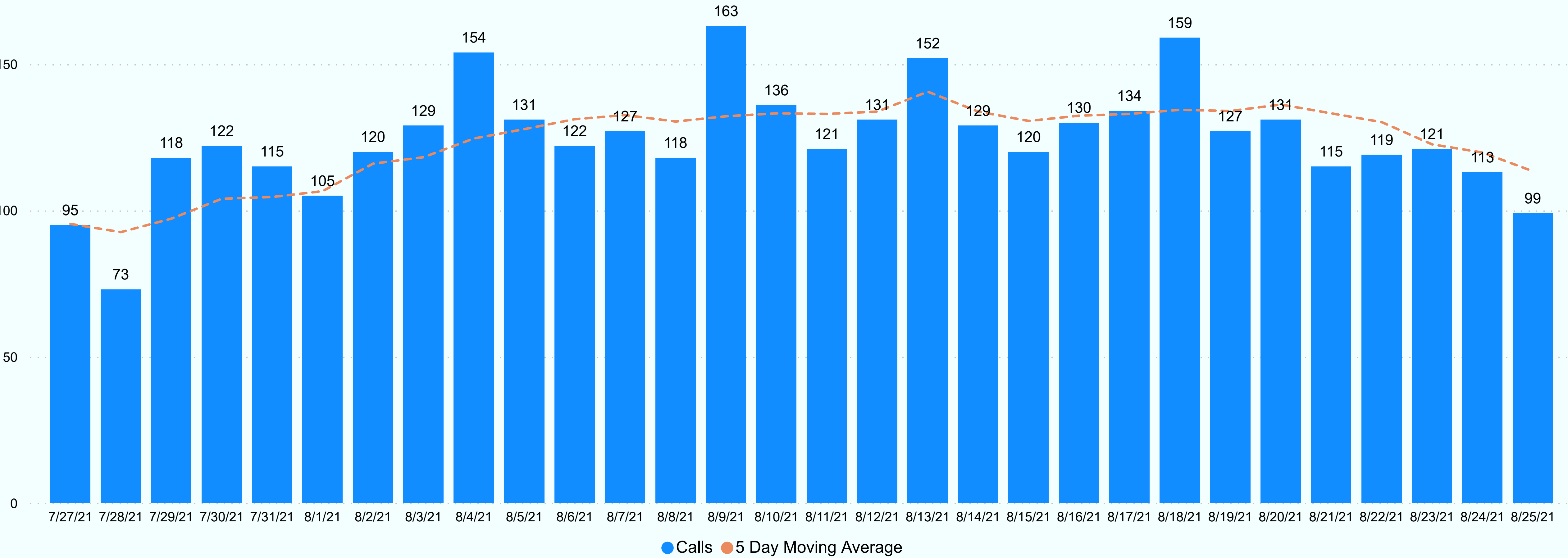

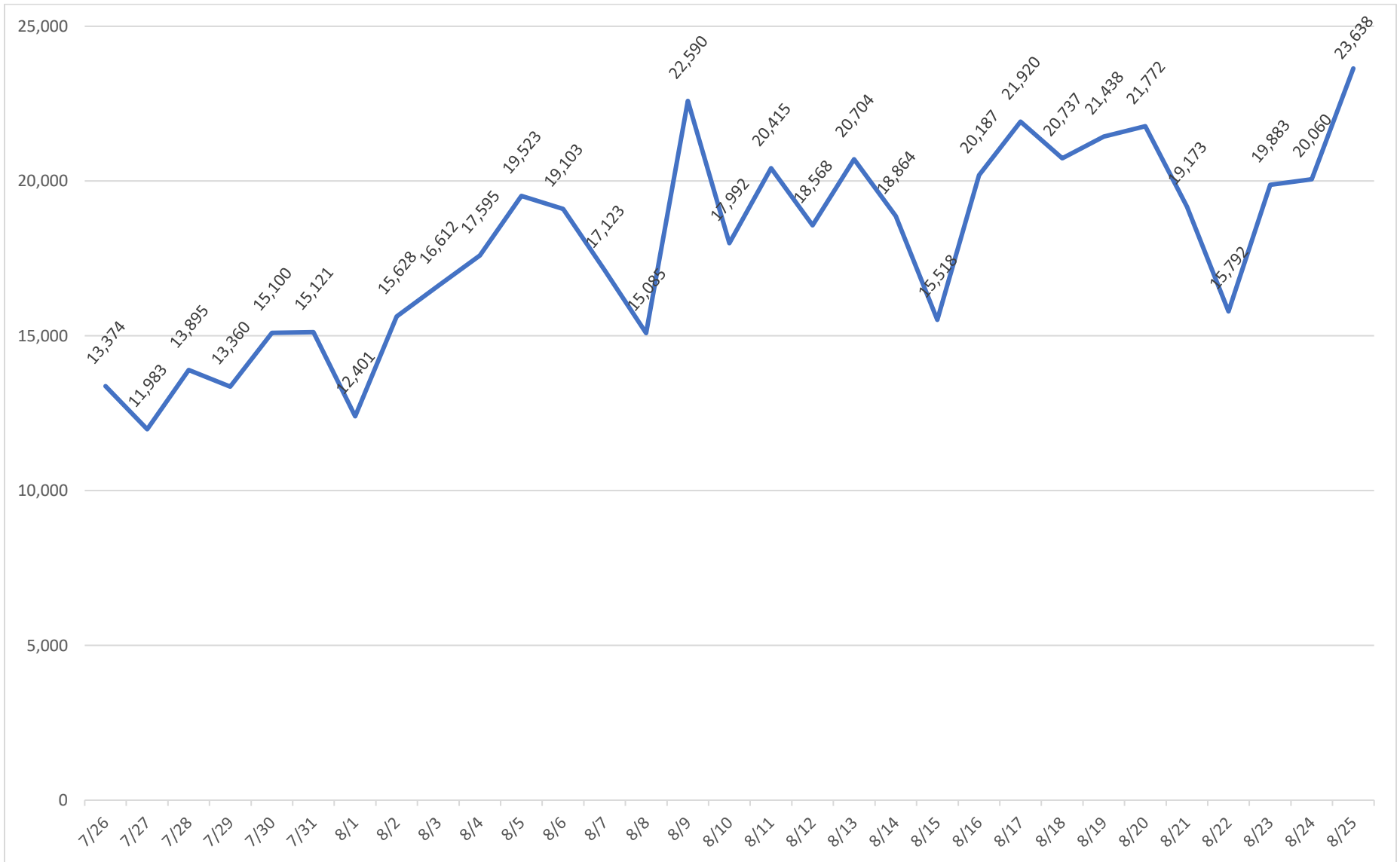
