Miami-Dade County COVID-19 Testing Synopsis

- The total number of PCR confirmed cases has decreased to 6,385 in week 37 from 7,131 in the previous week
- On the average, there was a decrease of approximately 107 new cases every day. Additionally, there were 1,655 probable cases with a positive antigen test.
- From the PCR confirmed cases, median age was 37 years (previous week was also 37 years old). The age among the reported cases ranged from 0 to 100 years old. Breakdown of reported cases showed that 18.9% were children aged 5-17 (18.2% in the previous week), 22.9% are young adults aged 18-34 years (23.2% % in the previous week).

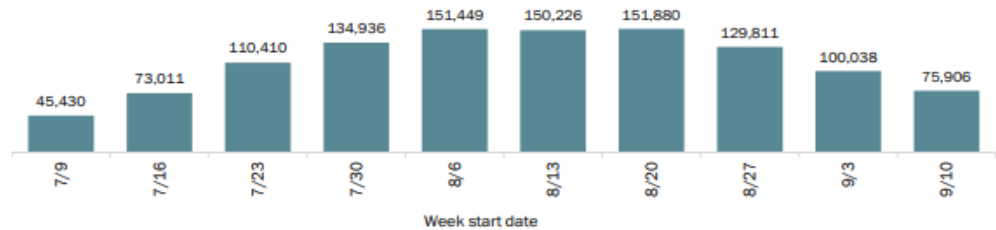

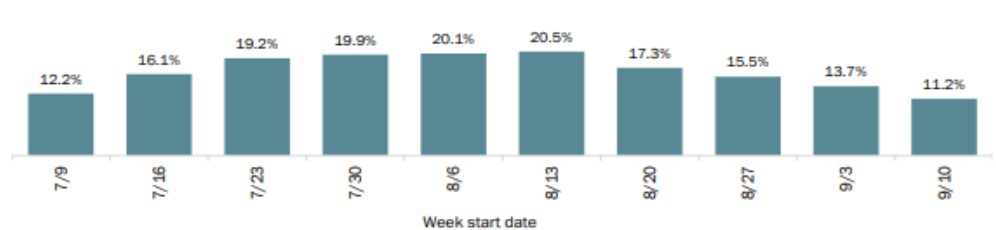

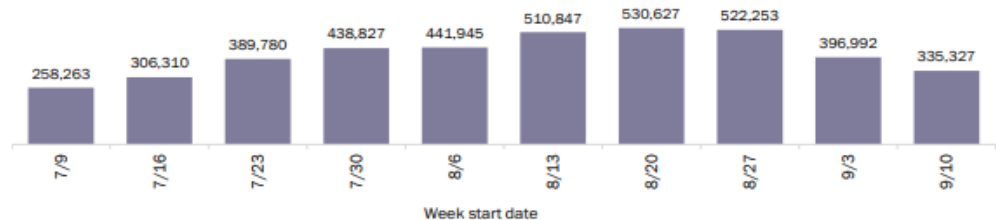
New cases for the past 10 weeks

Number of doses administered in the past 10 weeks



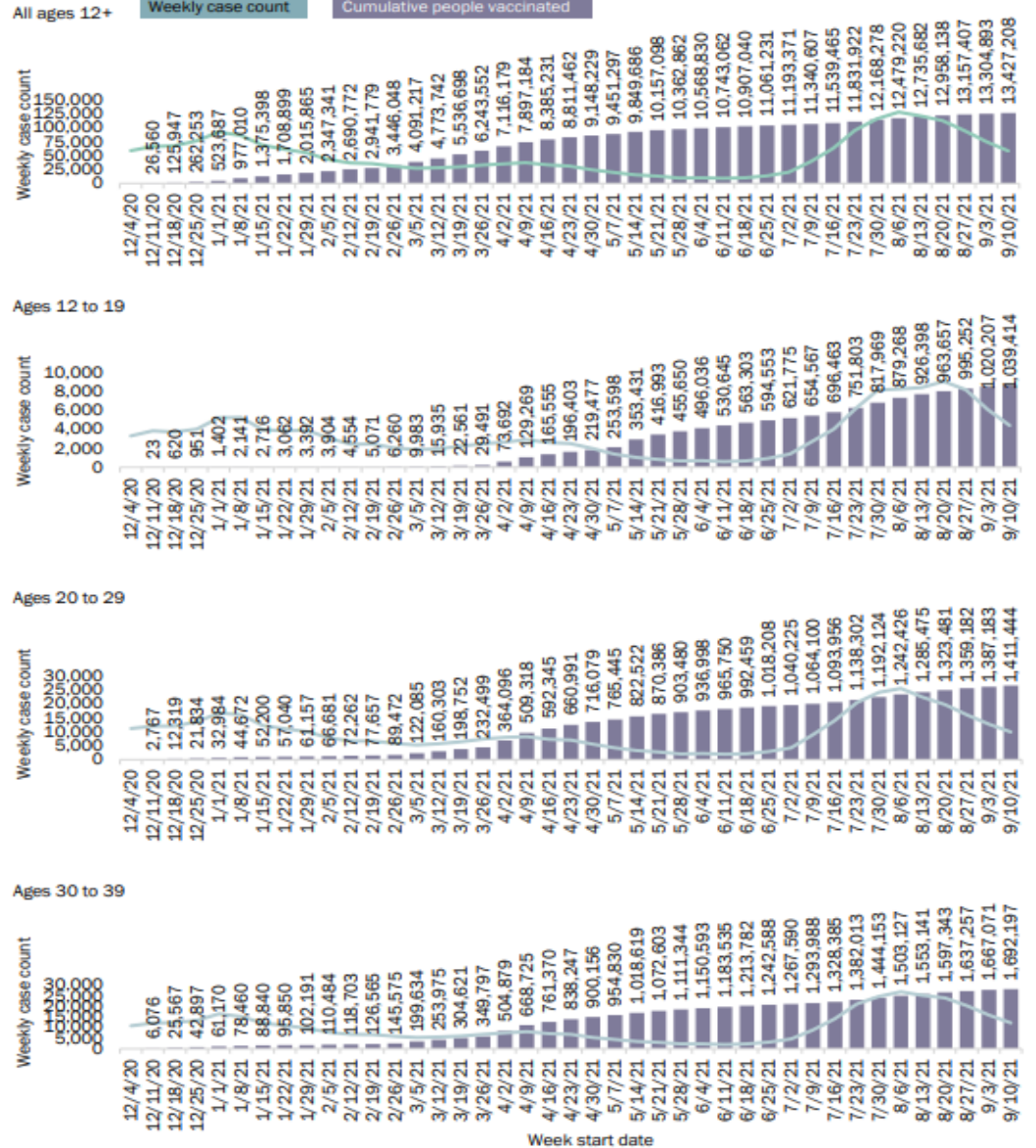
Cumulative and Weekly COVID-19 Case Count for Florida

Cases and cumulative people vaccinated



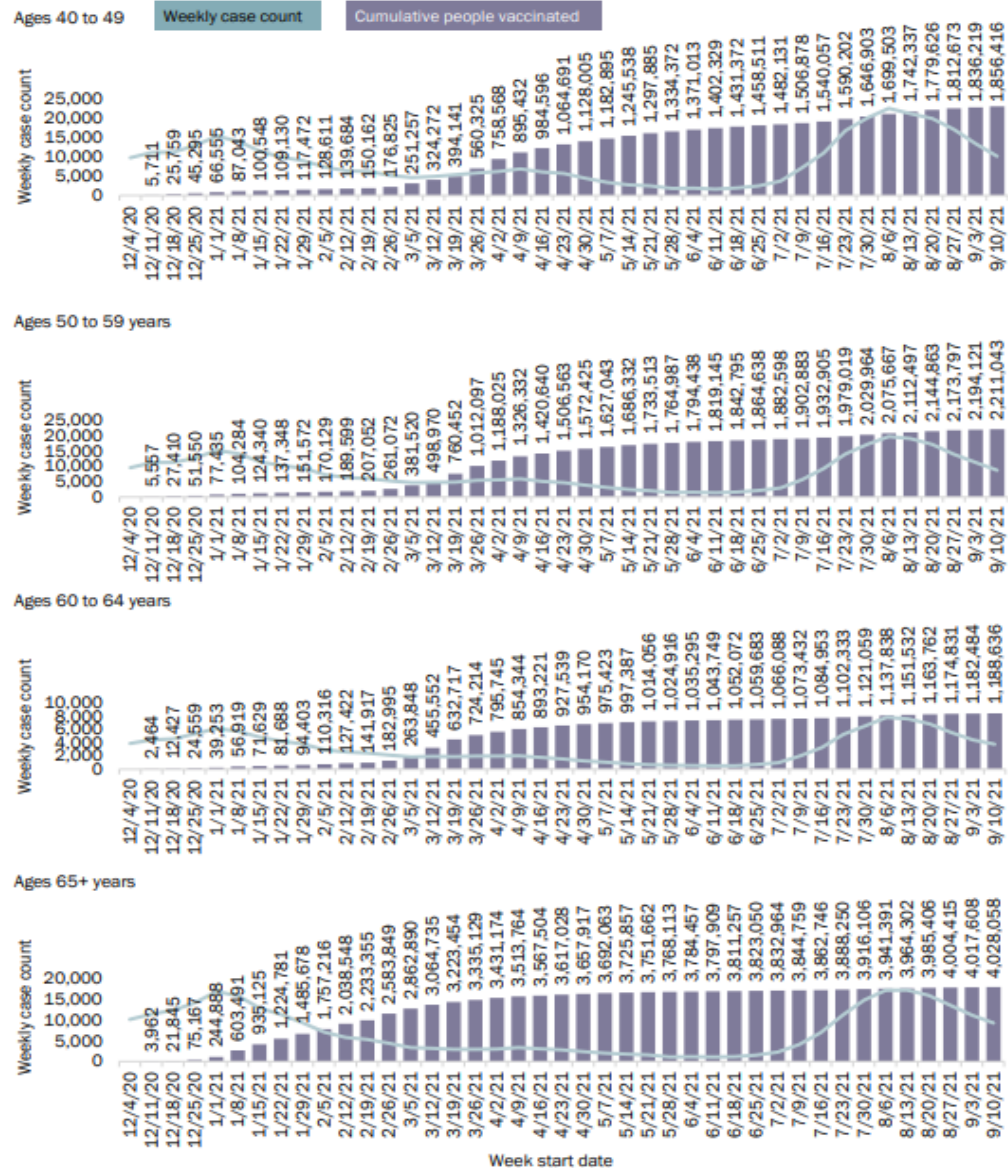

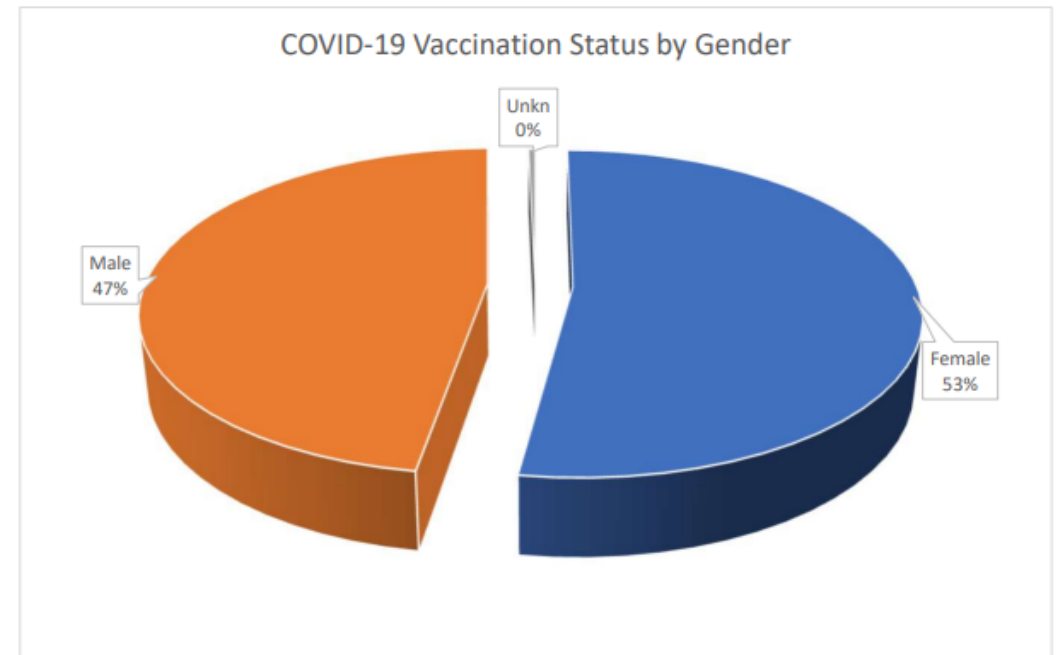

COVID-19 Vaccination Status by Gender



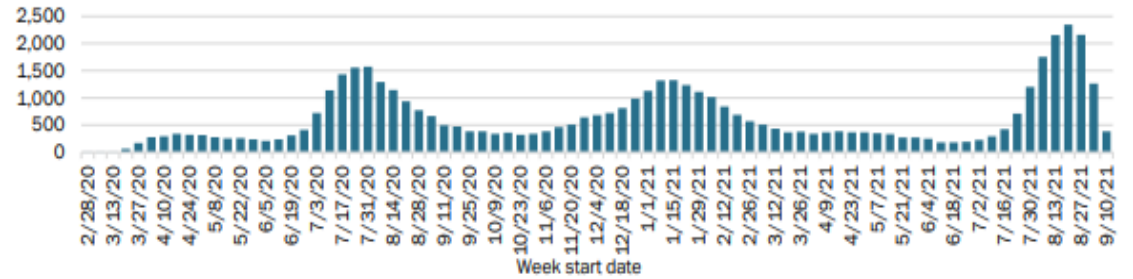

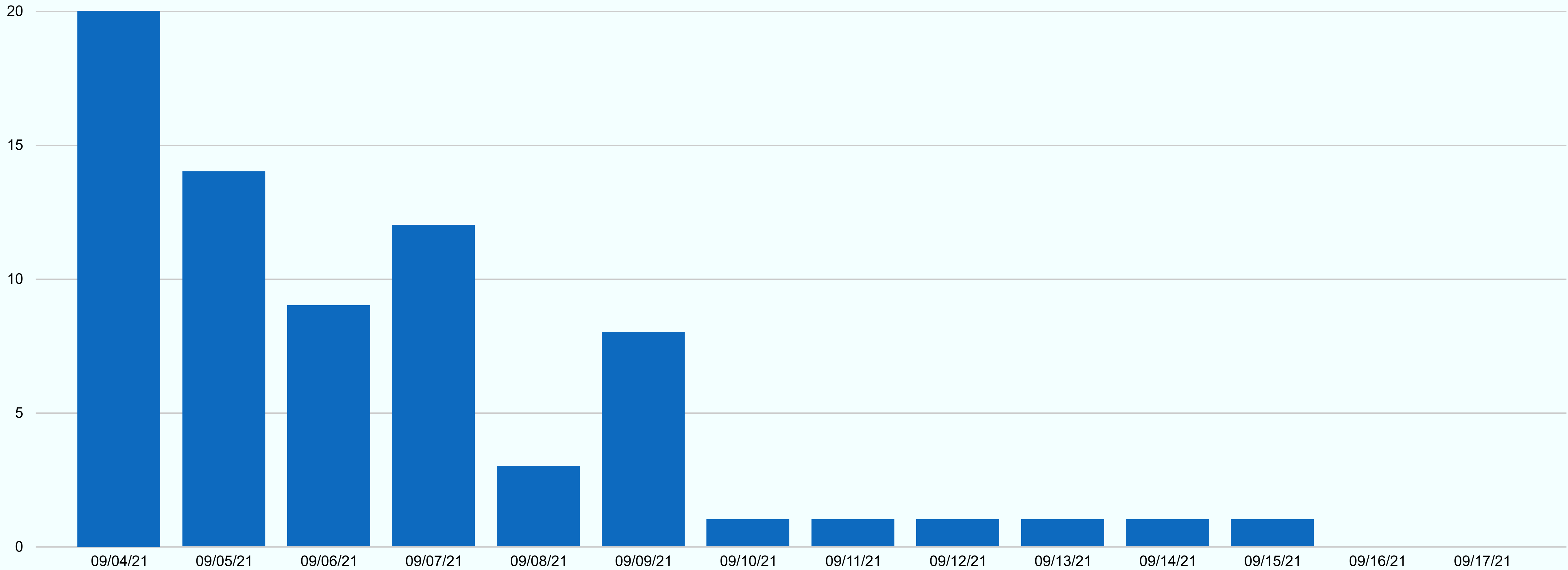

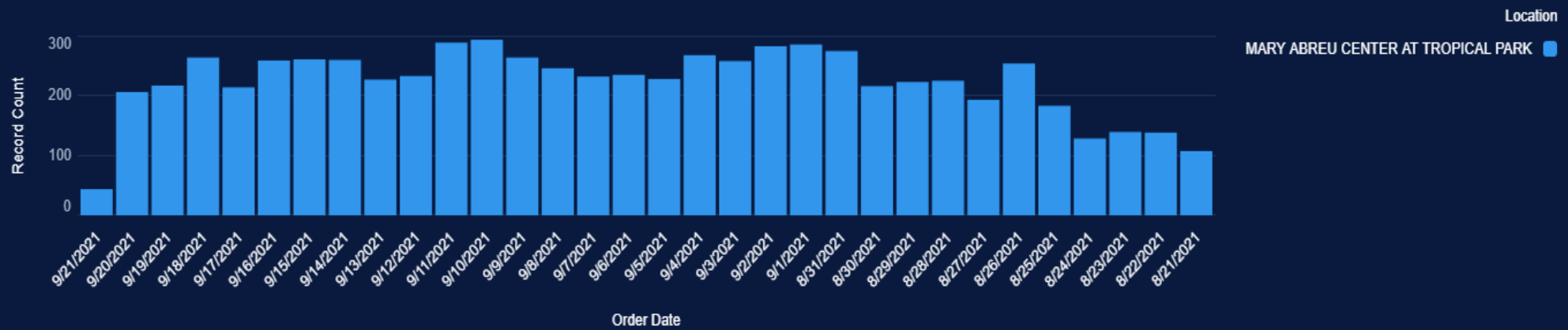

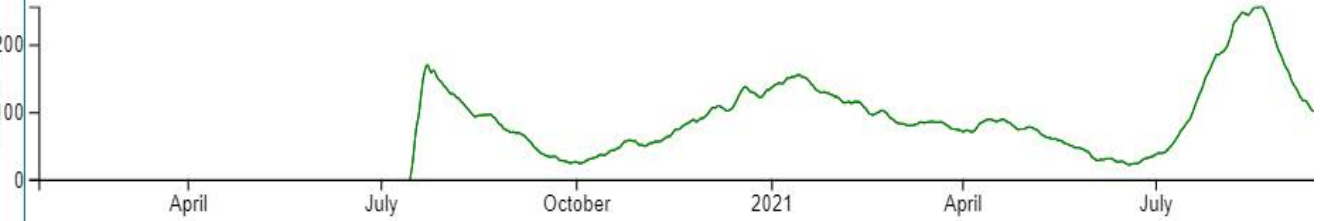

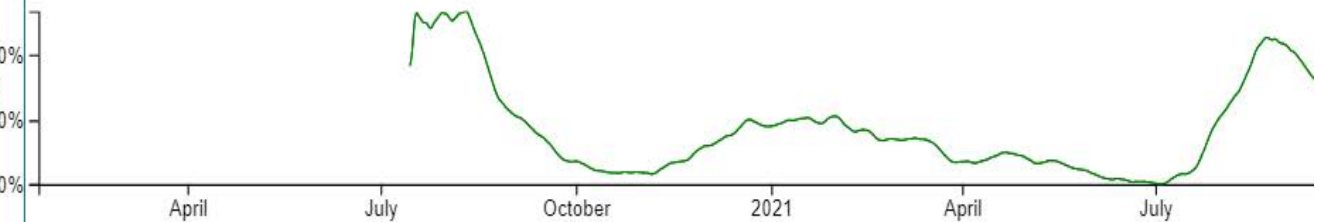

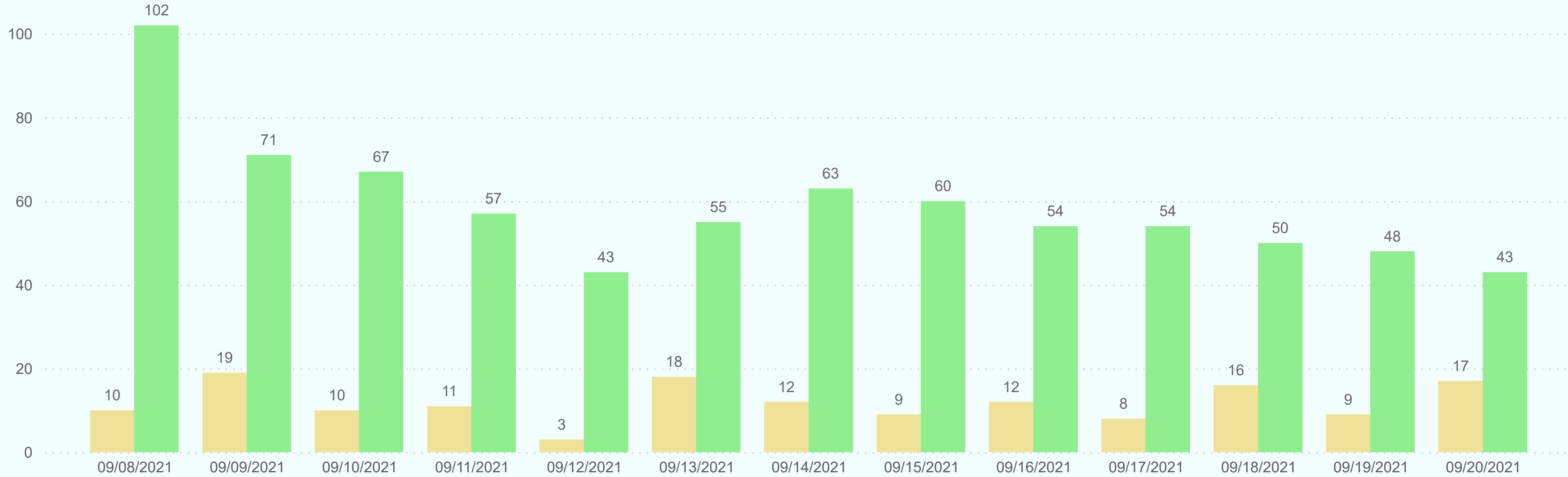

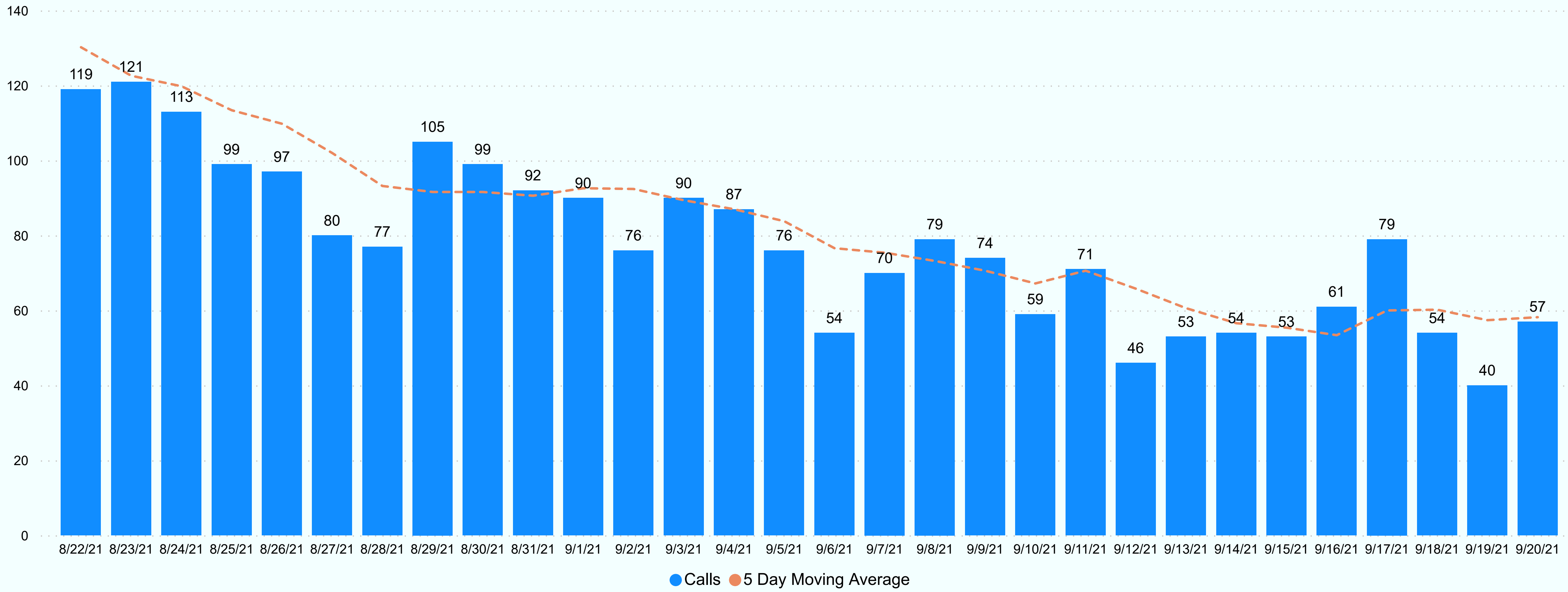

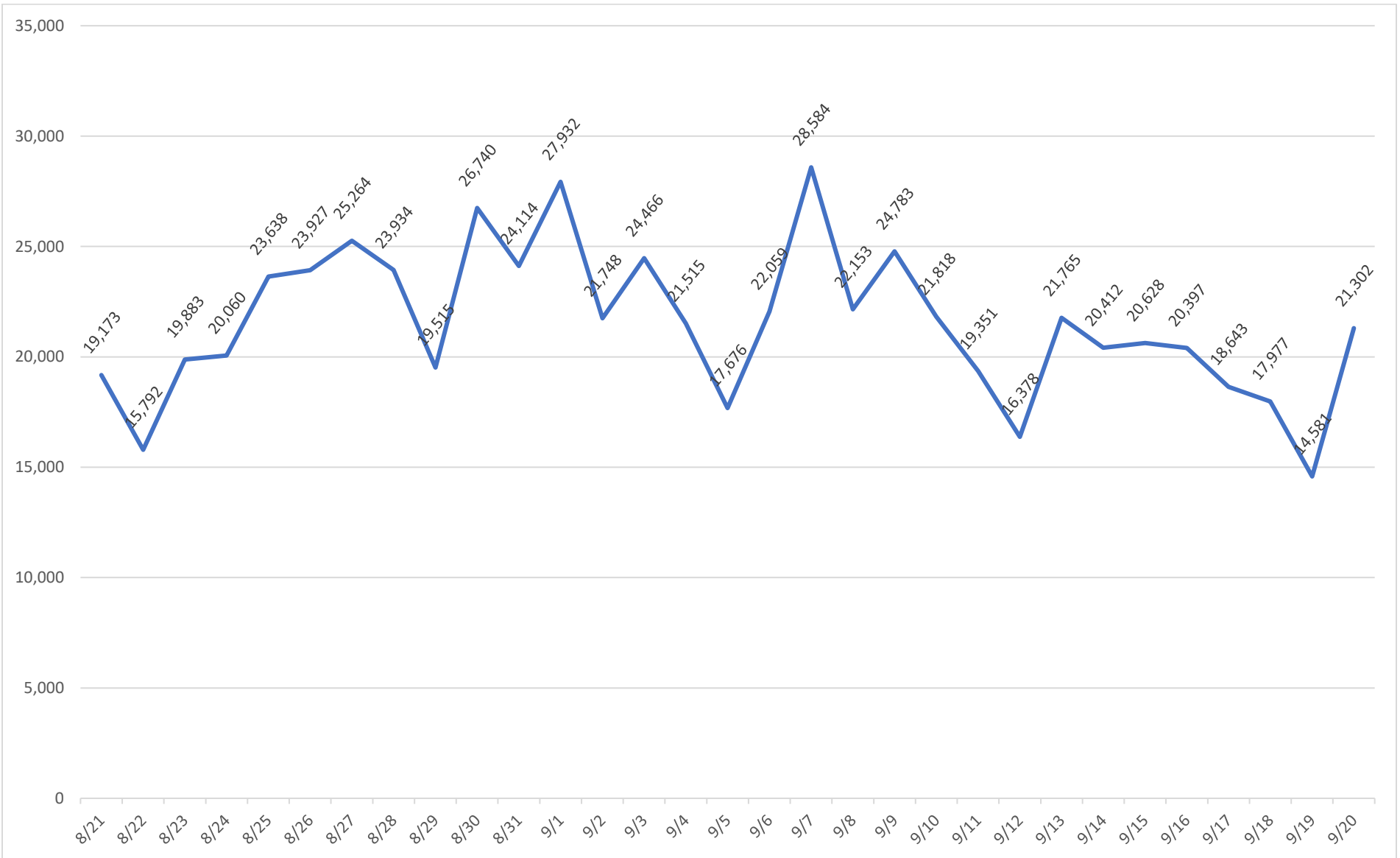
Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Calls
