Miami-Dade County COVID-19 Testing Synopsis

- The total number of PCR confirmed cases has increased to 7,785 in week 38 from 6,385 in the previous week.
- On the average, there was an increase of approximately 200 new cases every day. Additionally, there were 701 probable cases with a positive antigen test
- From the PCR confirmed cases, the median age was 36 years (previous week was 37 years old). The age among the reported cases ranged from 0 to 101 years old. Breakdown of the reported cases showed that 21.0% were children aged 5-17 (18.9% in the previous week), 22.8% are young adults aged 18-34 years (22.9% in the previous week).

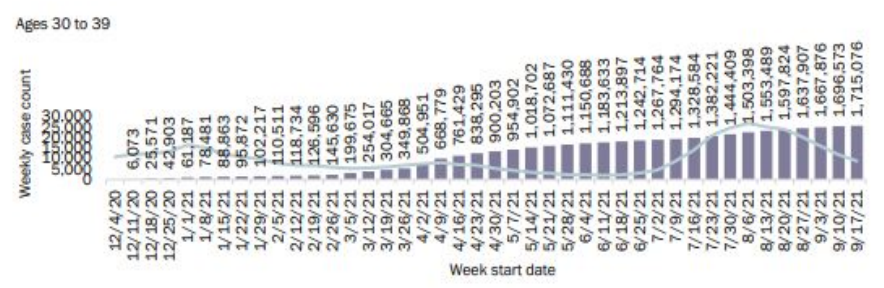

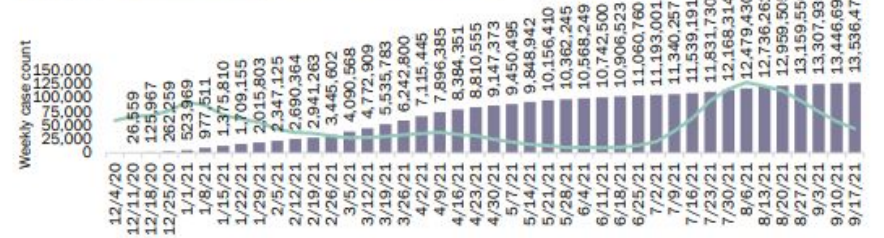

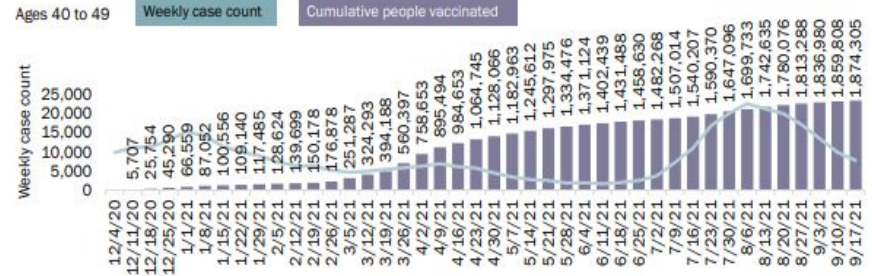

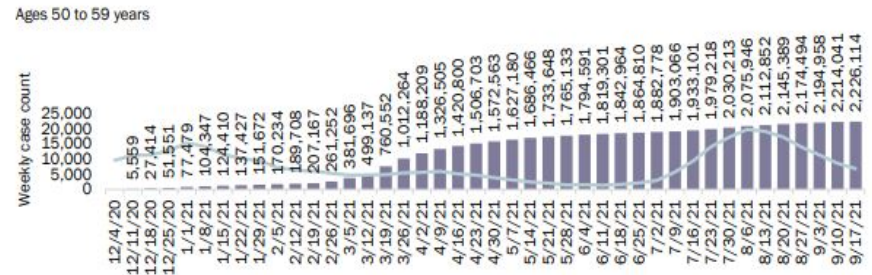

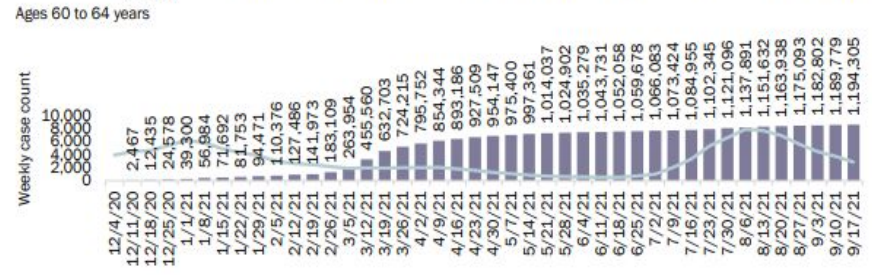

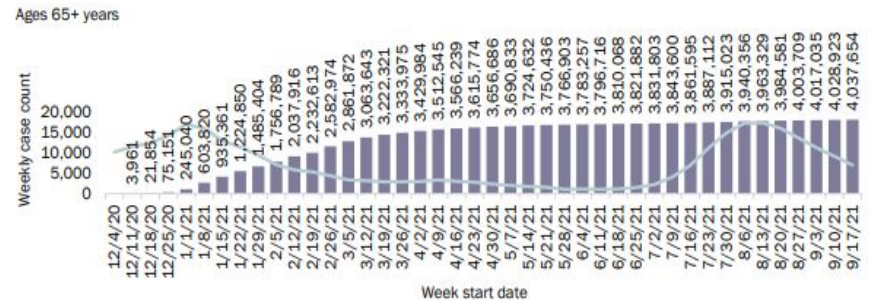

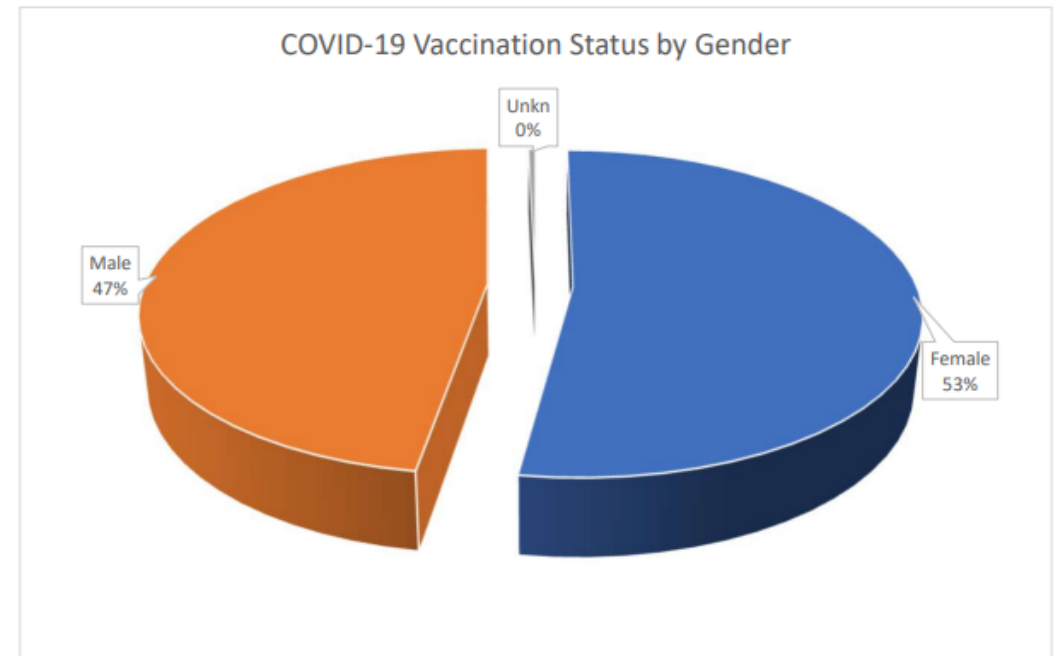

COVID-19 Vaccination Status by Gender



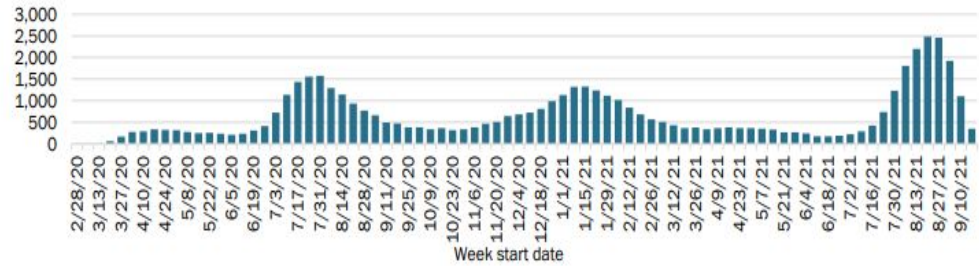

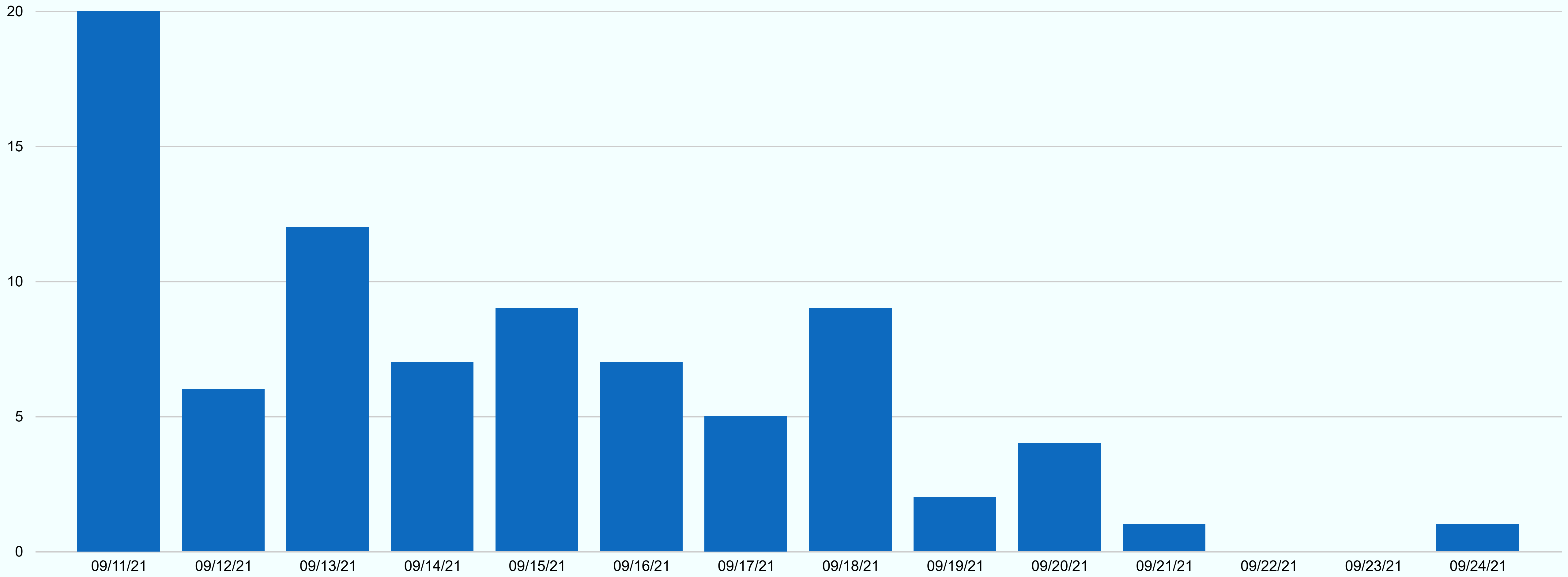

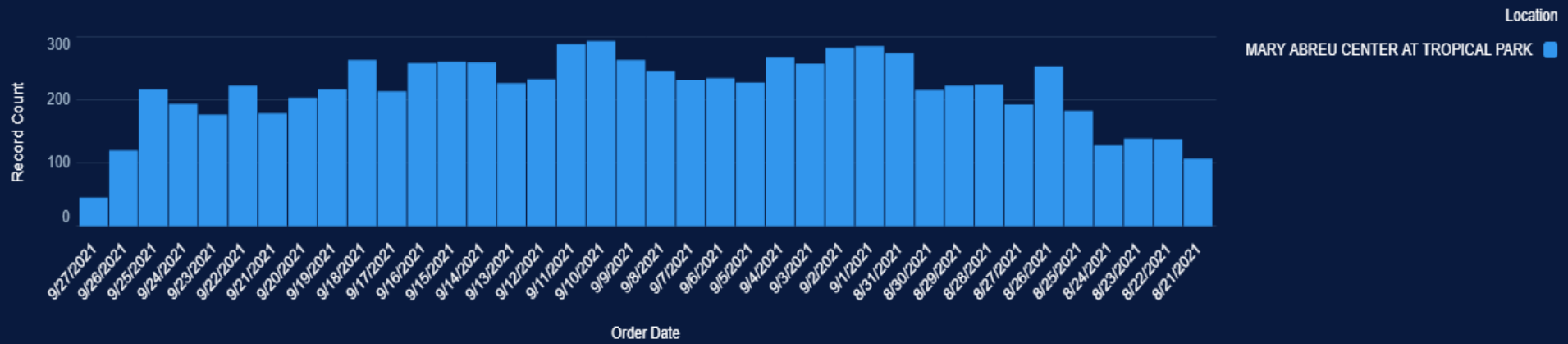

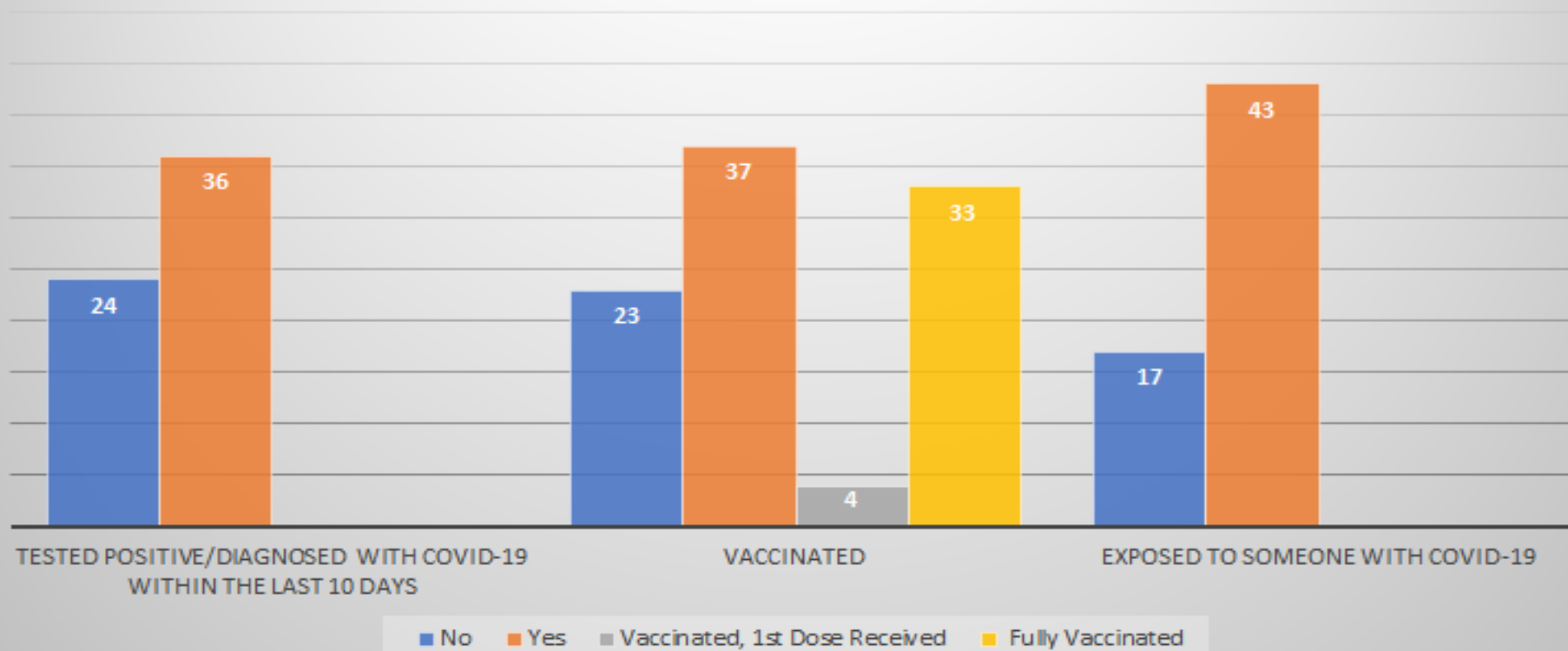

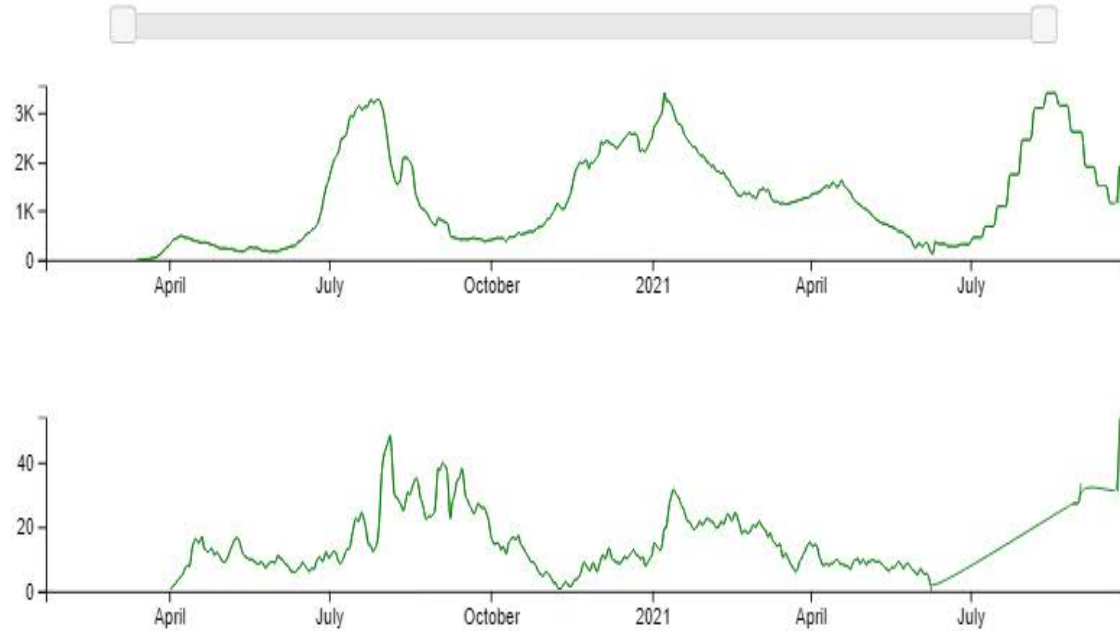

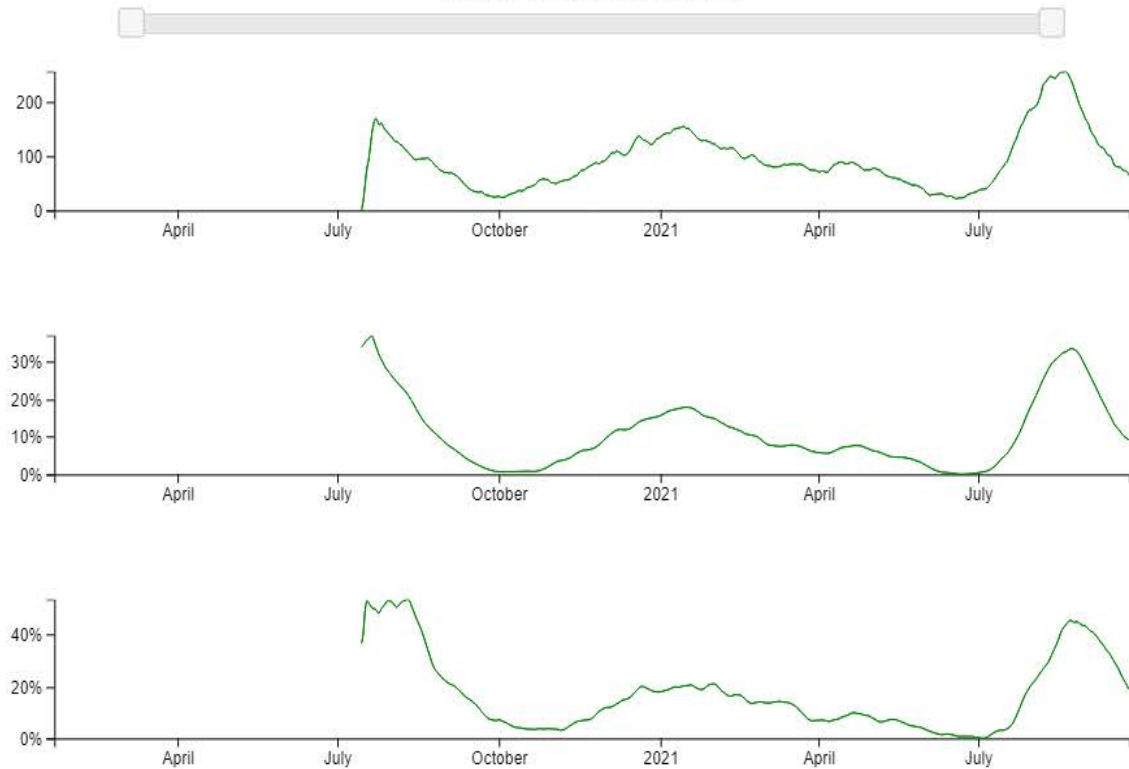

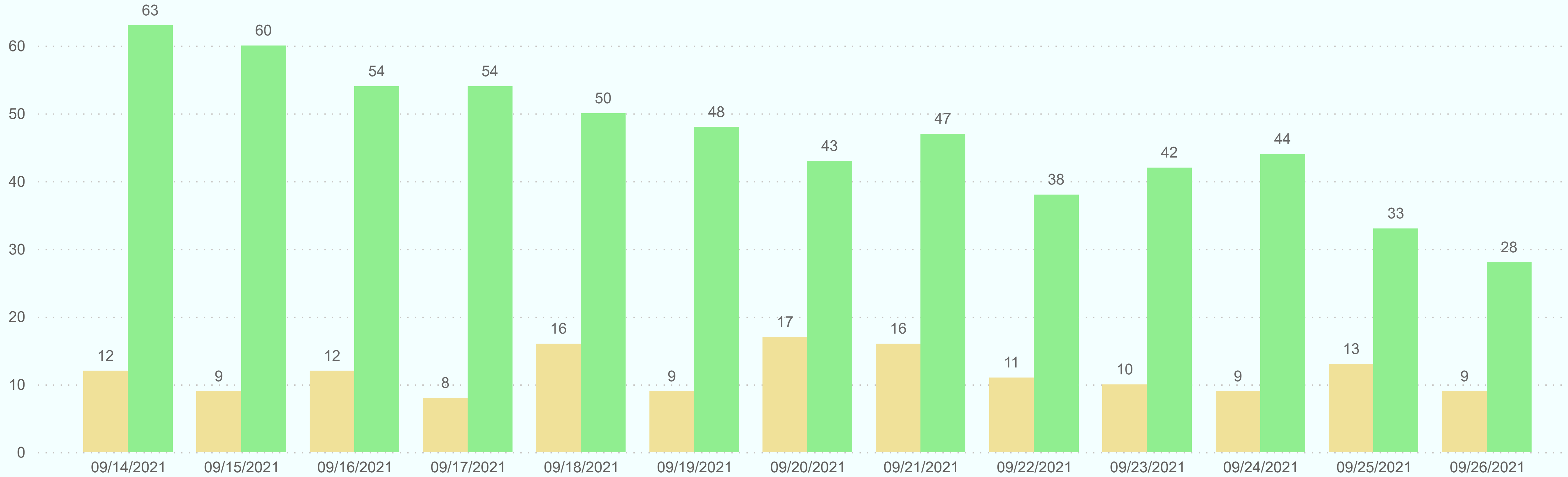

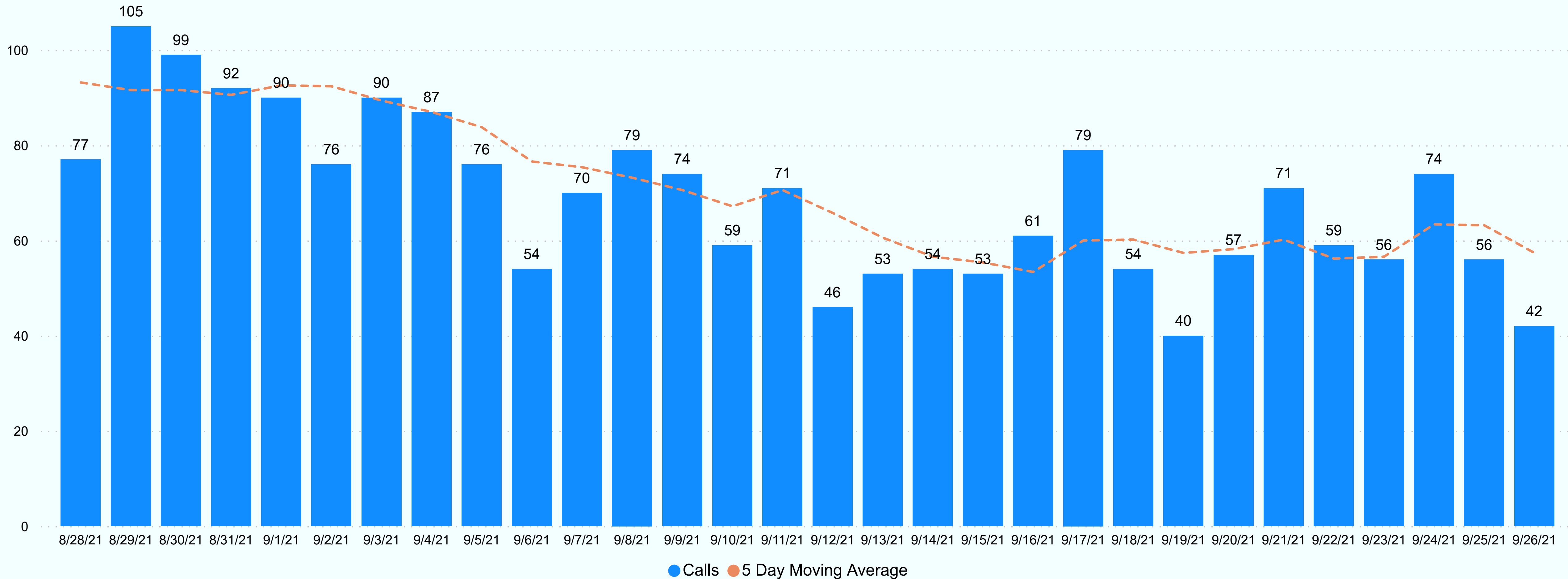

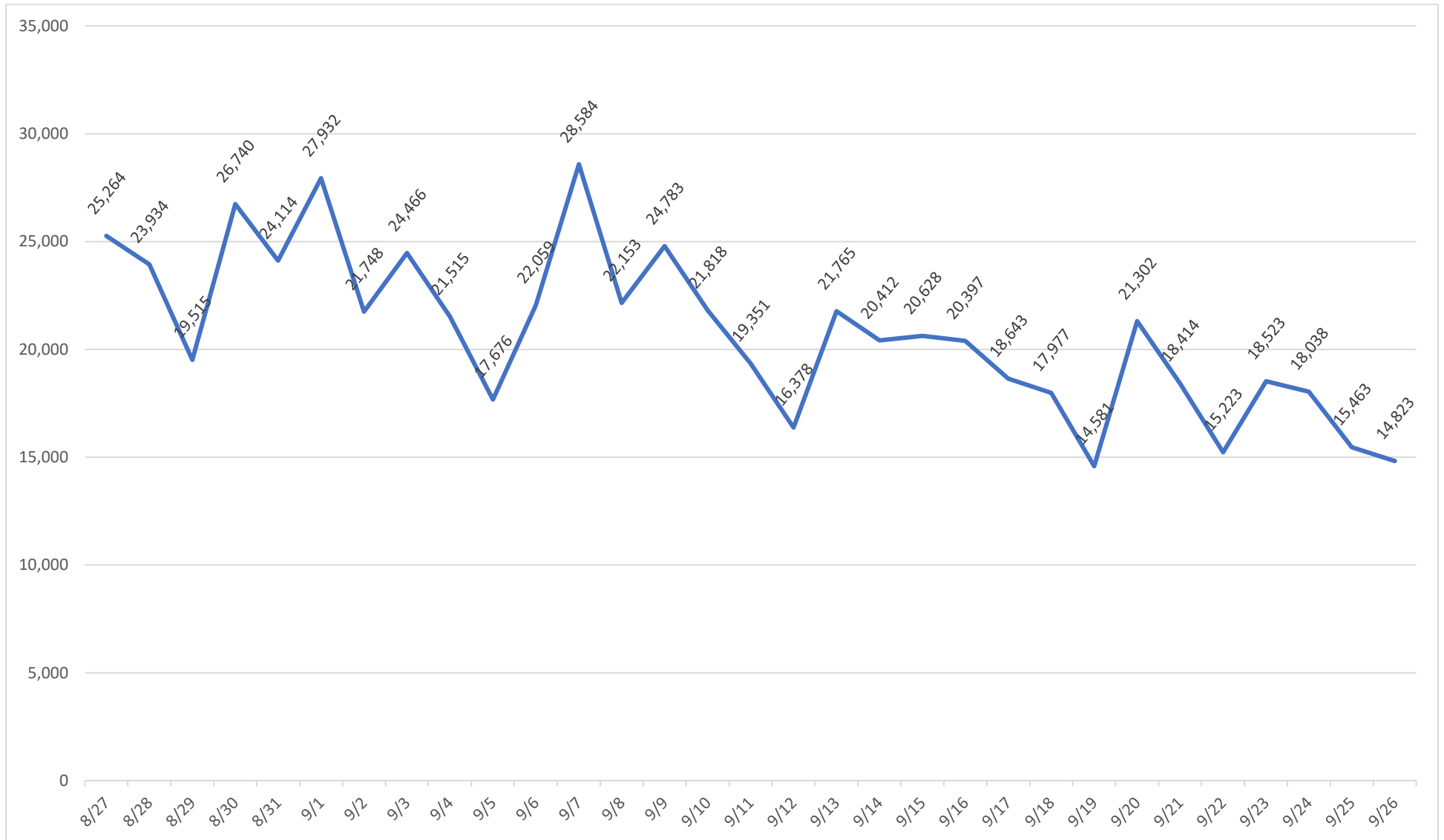
