Miami-Dade County COVID-19 Testing Synopsis

- The total number of PCR confirmed cases has increased to 3,328 in week 49 from 2,131 in the previous week
- On the average, there was an increase of approximately 171 reported cases every day. Additionally, there were 433 probable cases with a positive antigen test.
- From the PCR confirmed cases, median age was 34 years old, the previous week the median age was 38 years old. The age among the reported cases ranged from 0 to 103 years old.

Breakdown of the reported cases showed that 10.3% were children aged 5-17 (15.7% in the previous week), 37.8% were young adults aged 18-34 years (22.6% in the previous week).

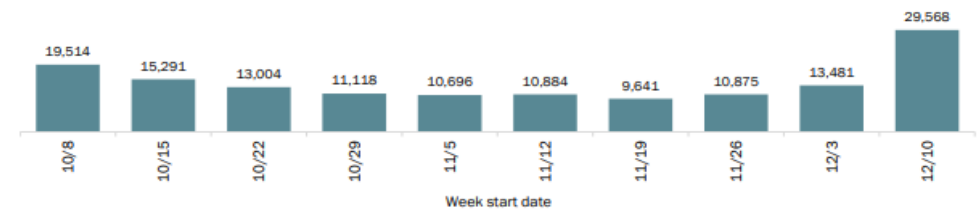

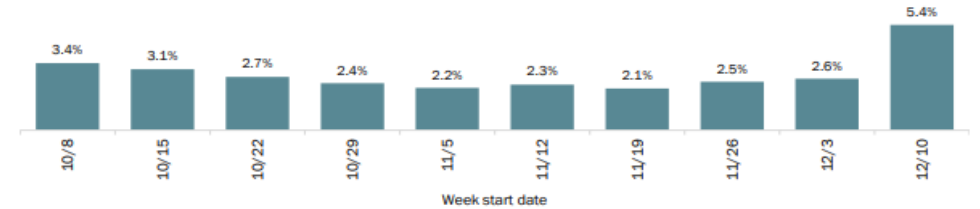

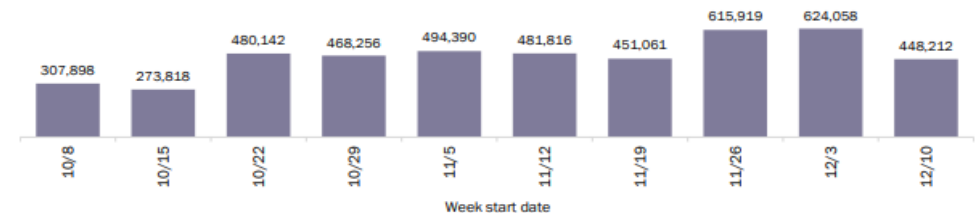

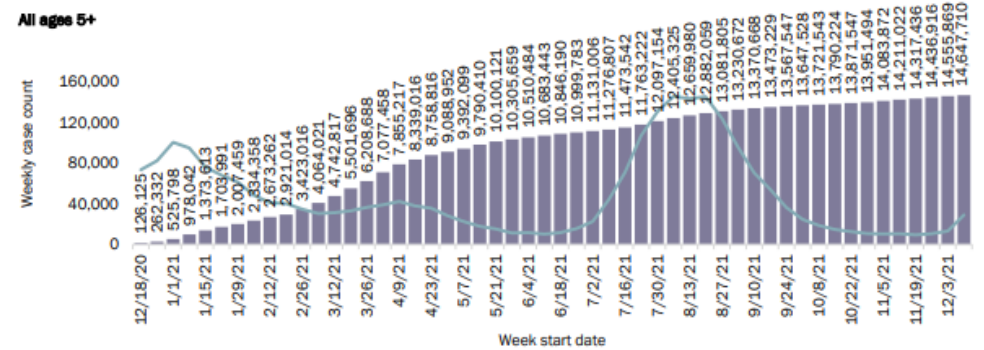

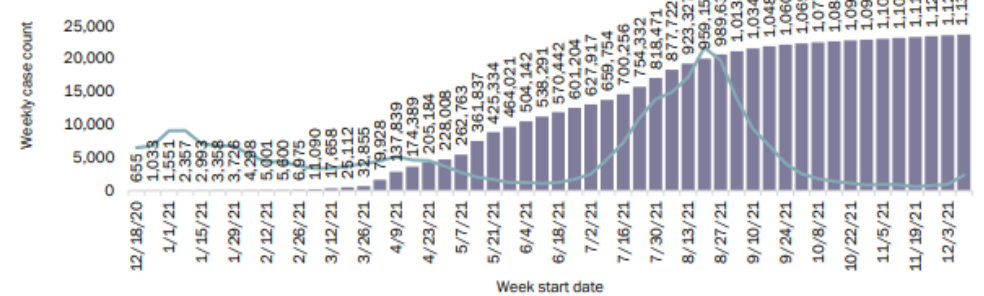

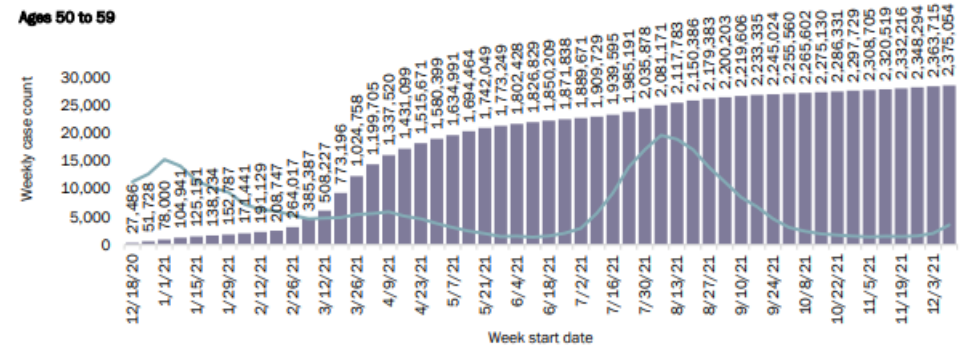

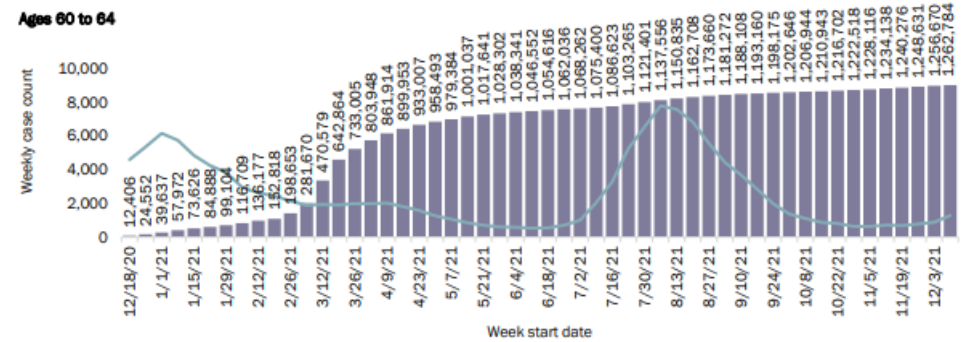

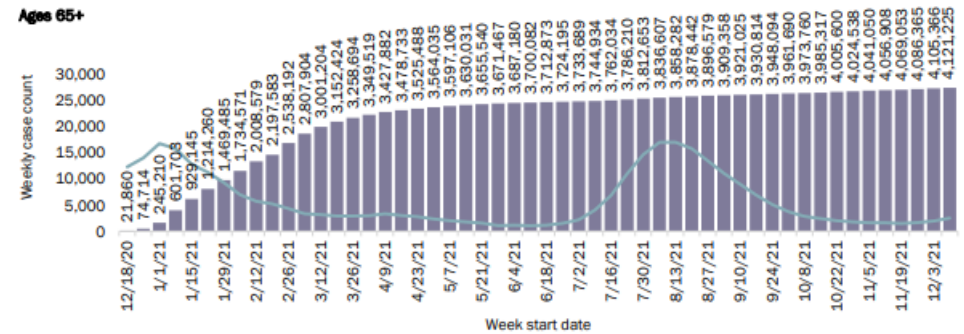

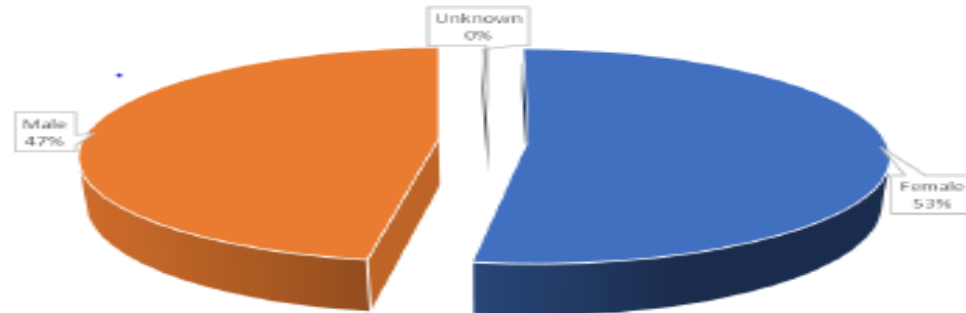

COVID-19 Vaccination Status by Gender



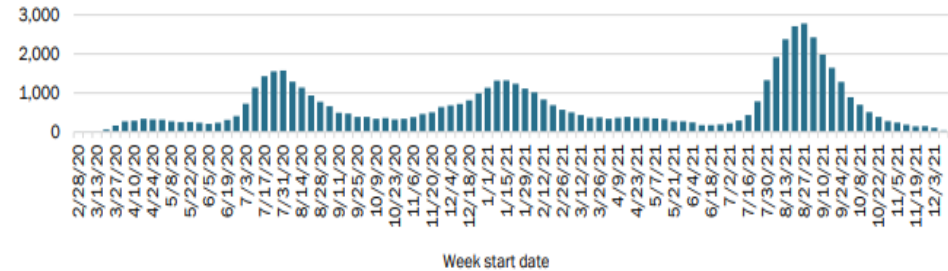

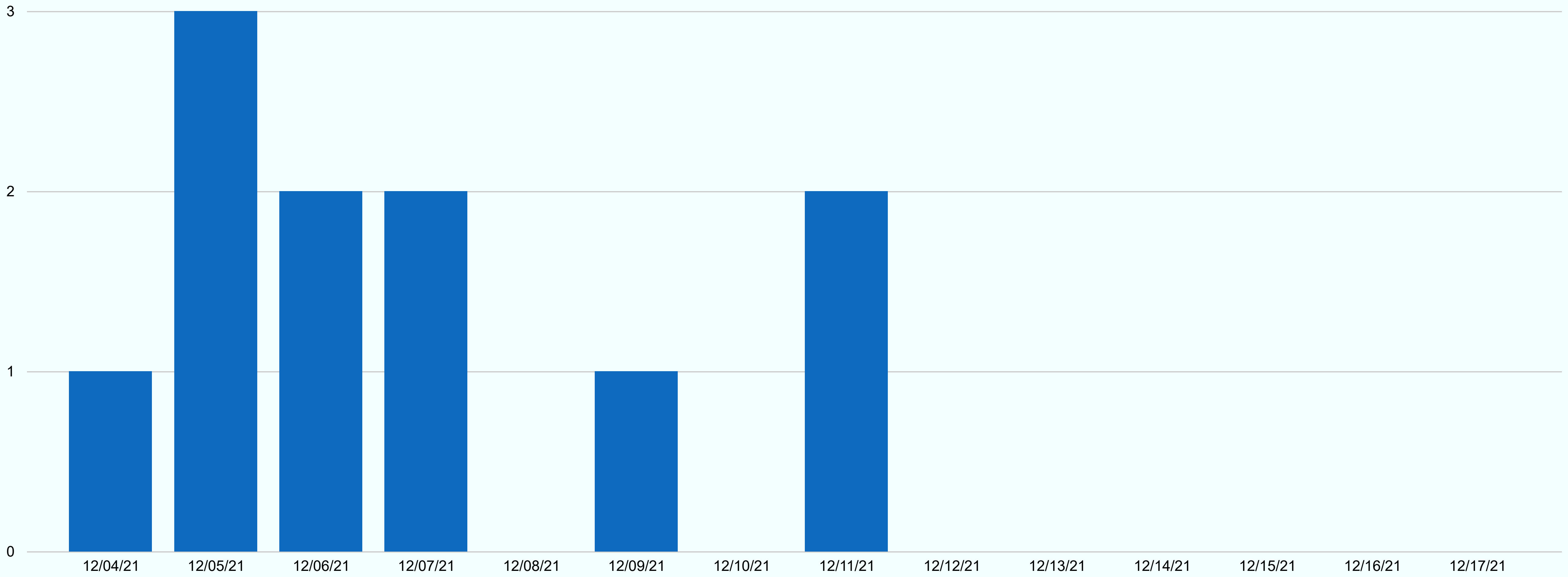

Miami-Dade County Daily Deaths (Last 14 Days)



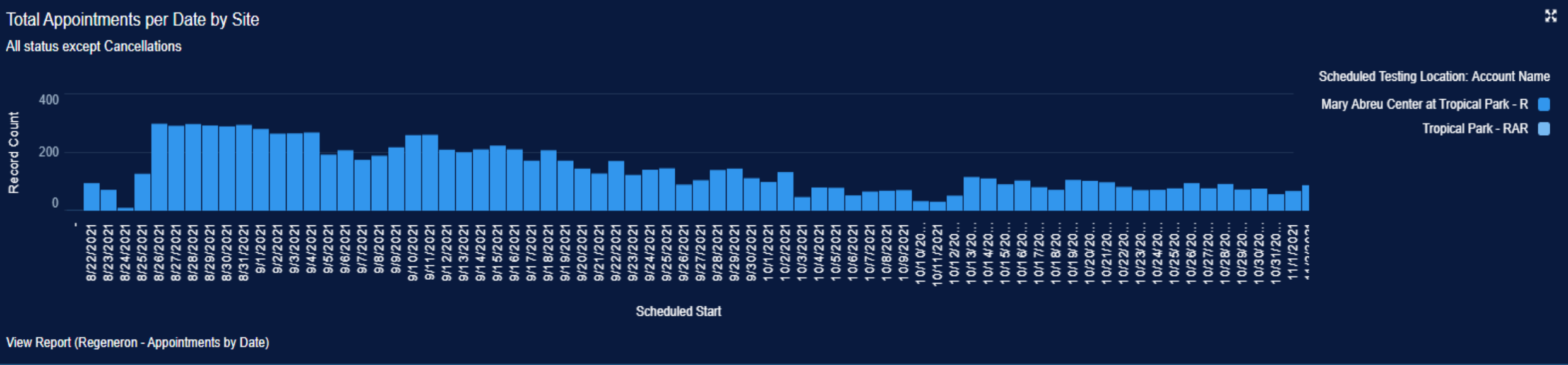
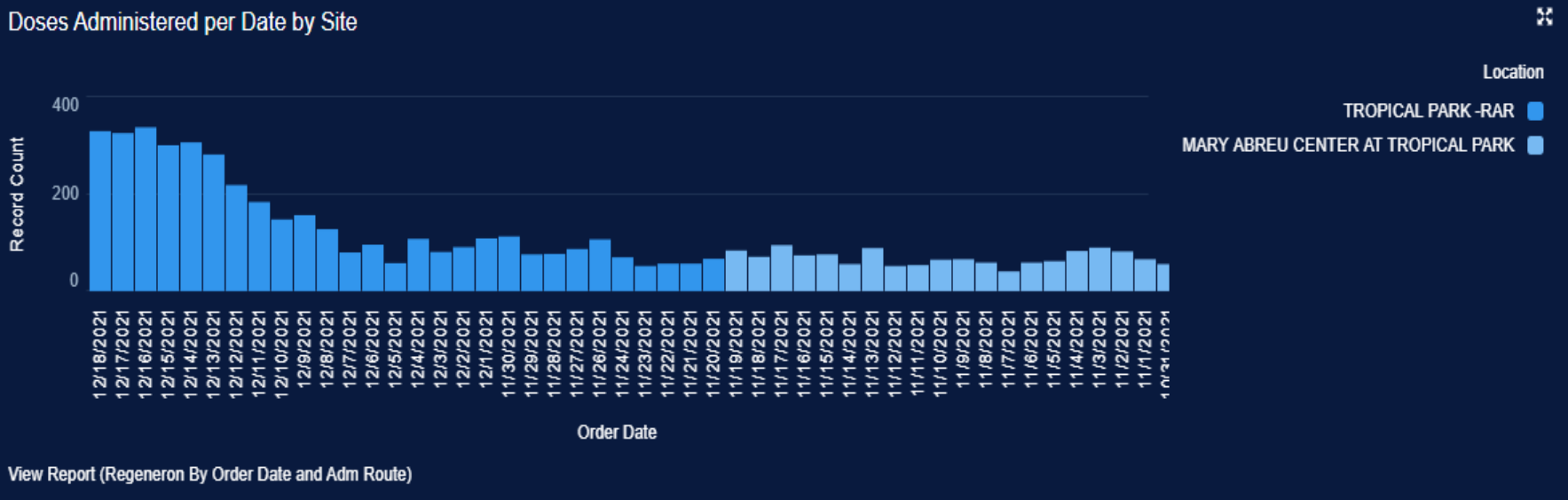

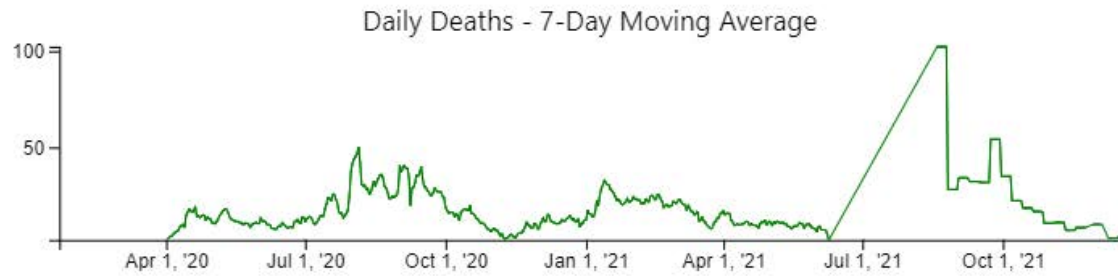

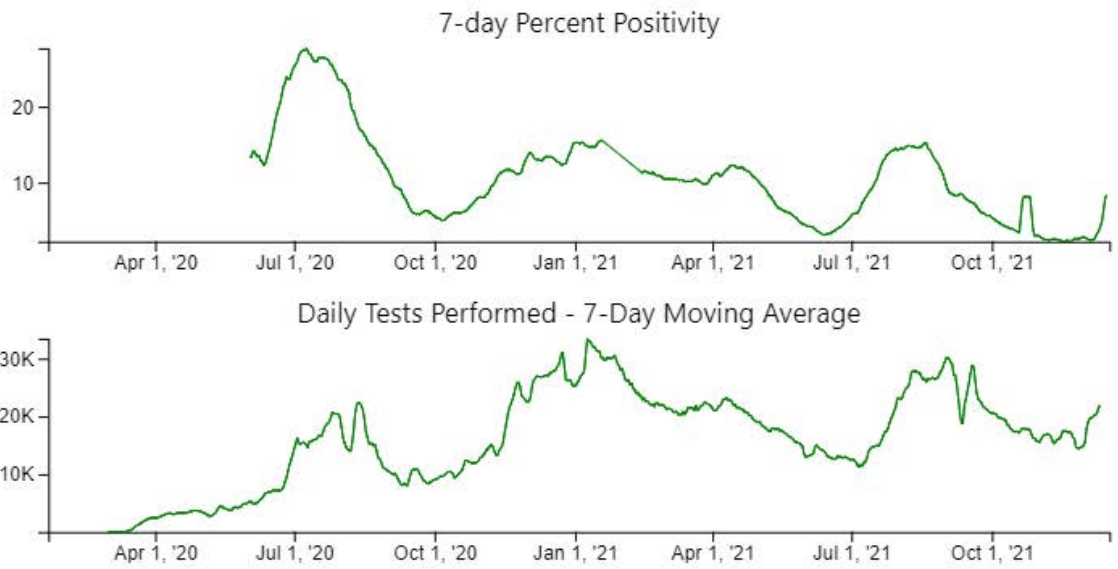

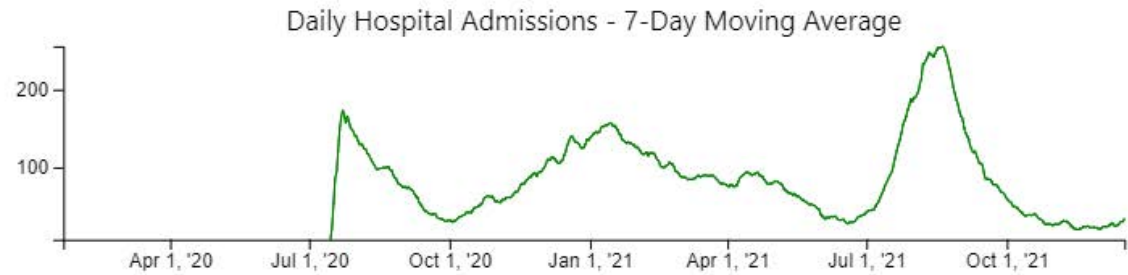

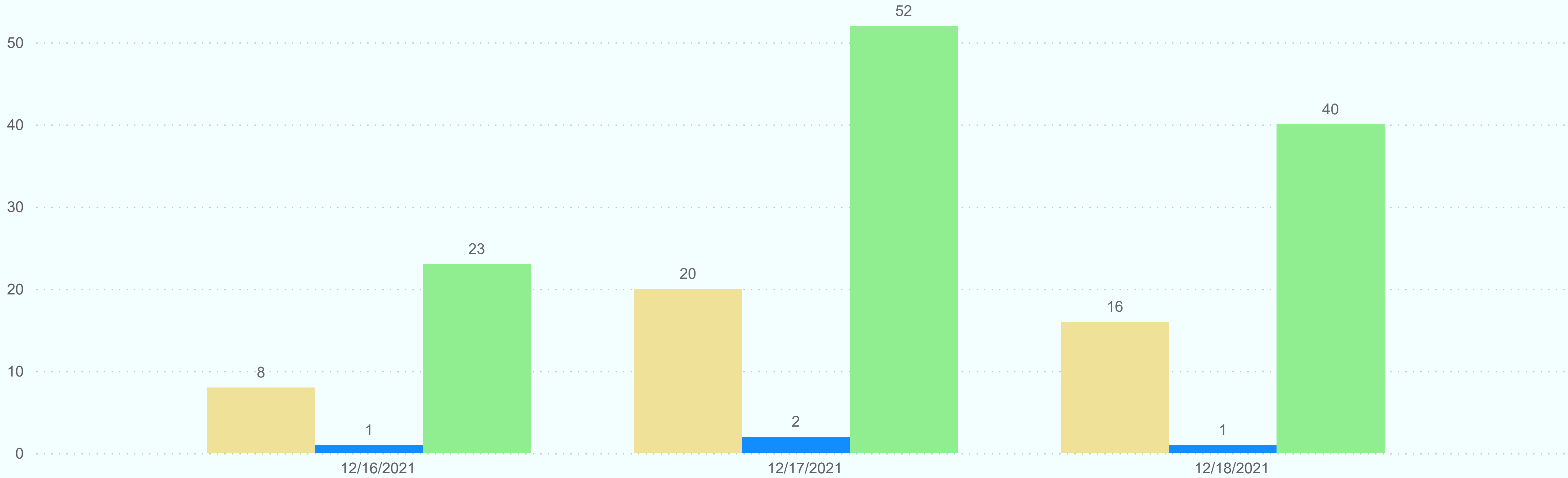

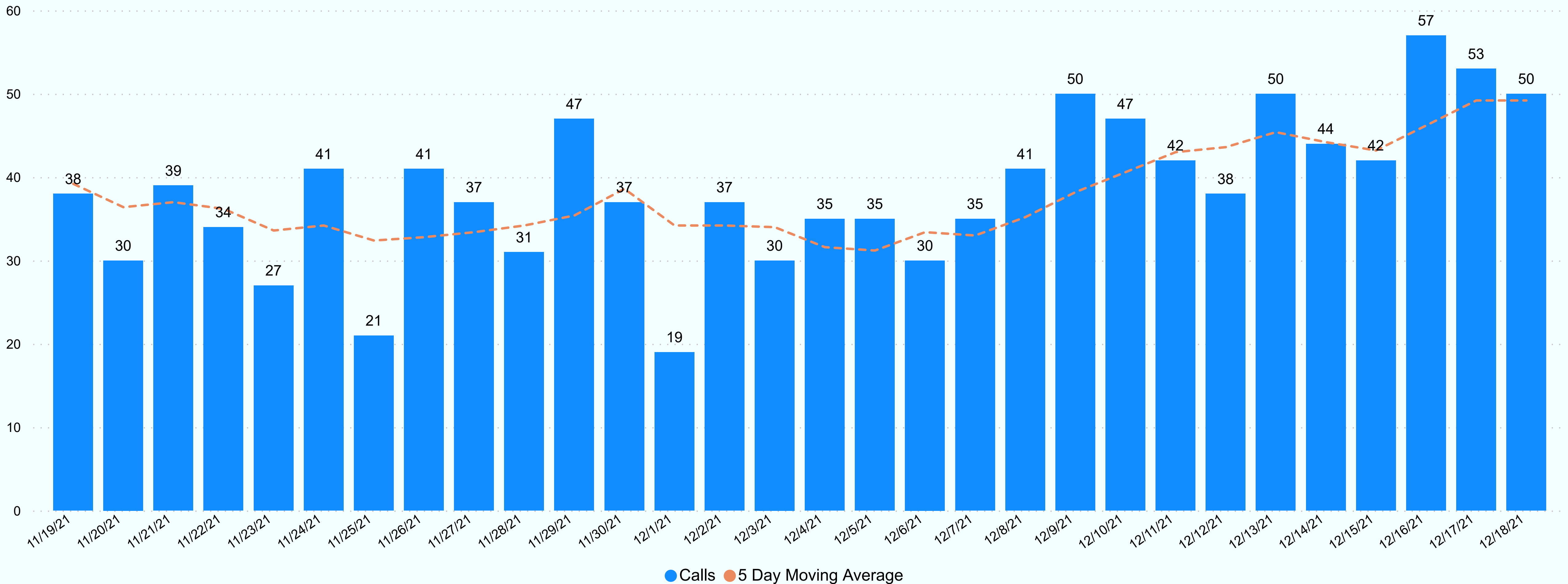

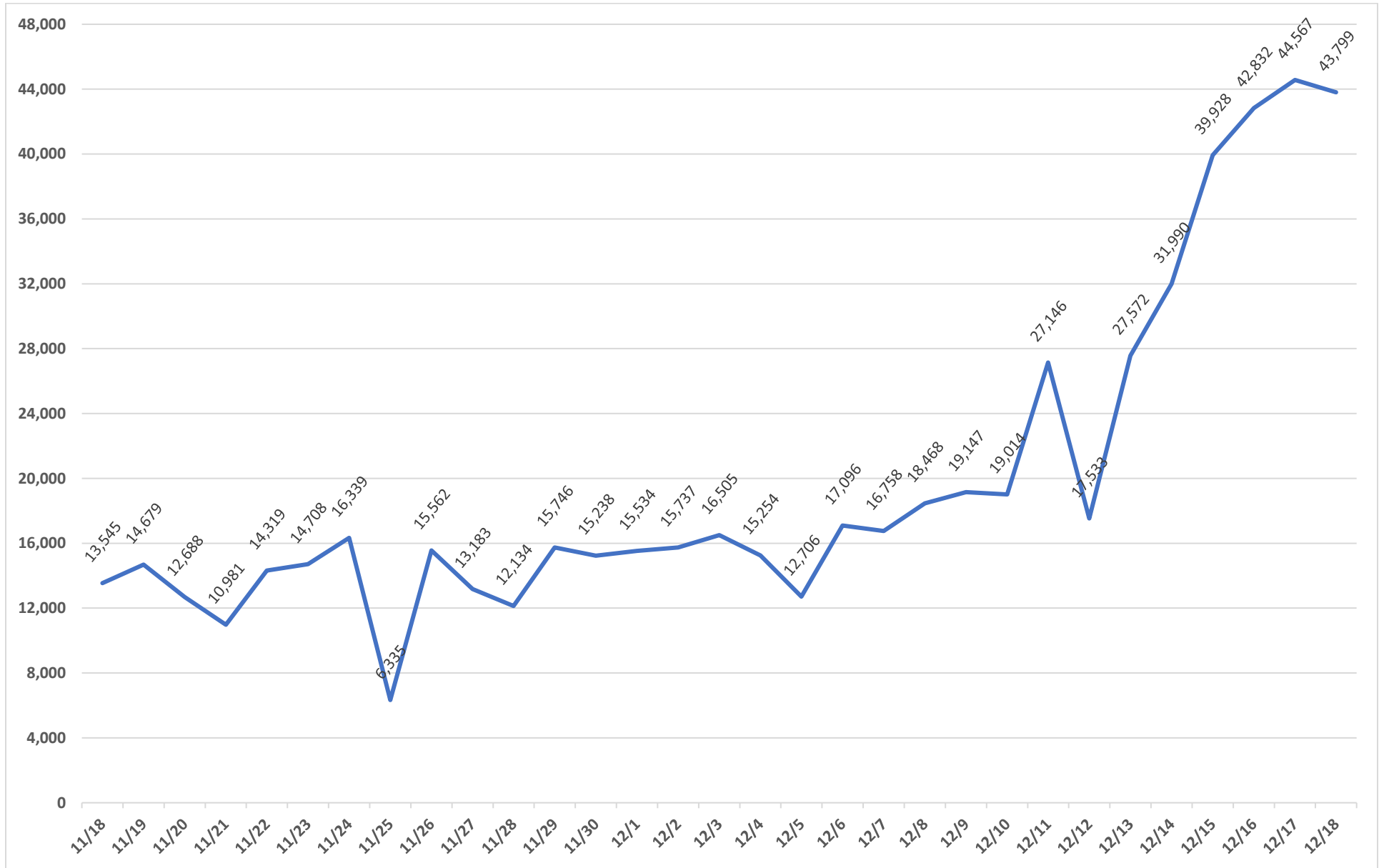

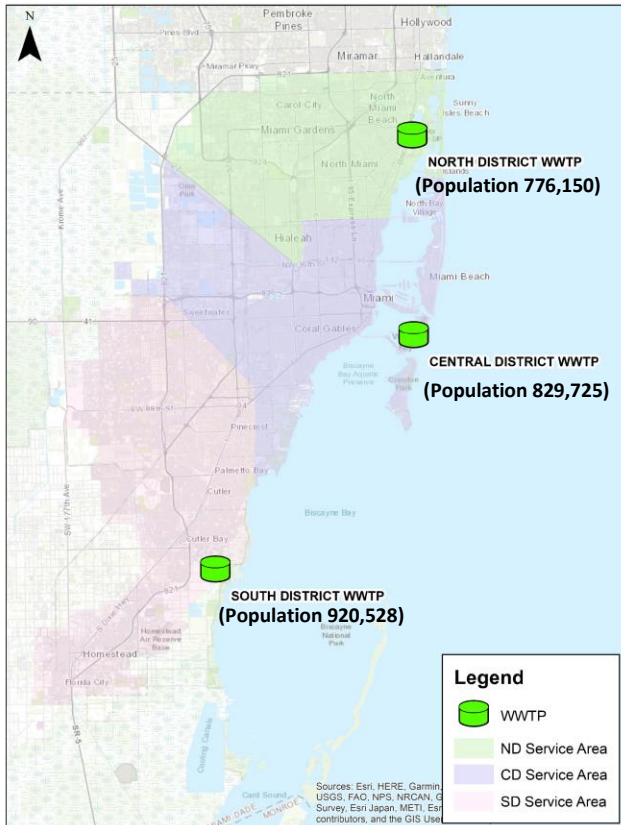

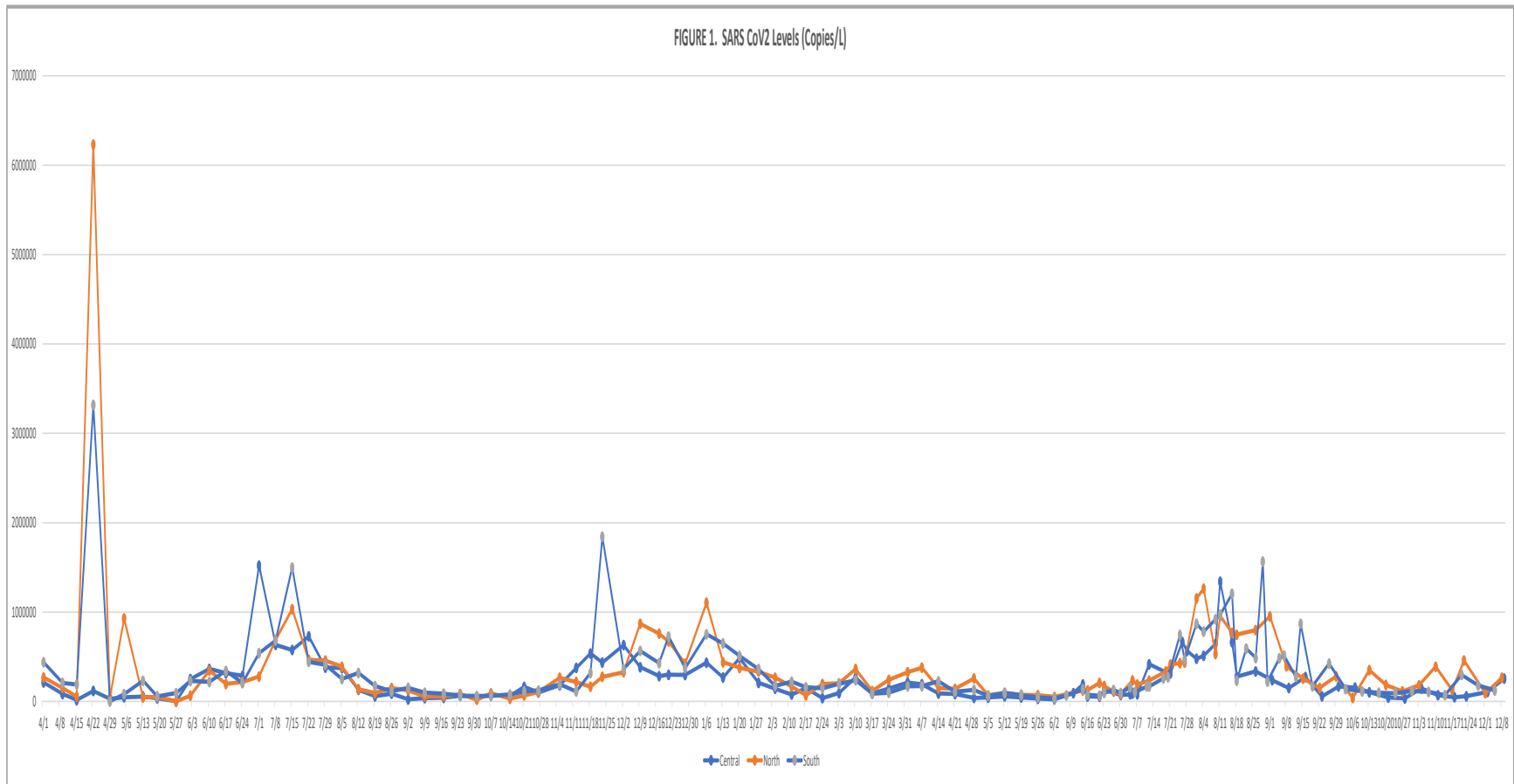
