I, _____ understand that I am required to charge my electronic monitoring device for **TWO HOURS CONTINUOUSLY**, at approximately the same time everyday.

_____ I know I am not to sleep or use an extension cord while charging the device.

_____ I have read the charging instructions, and understand how to connect and disconnect my device from the charging cord. I understand the charging cord is a two part cord with an orange solid light to indicate proper voltage. **Make sure all cord sections are plugged in snugly.*

_____ I understand that I am being actively monitored and that I will be contacted by telephone if I fail to fully charge the device assigned to me.

_____ I understand I need to plug into a regular outlet, not one controlled by a wall switch.

_____ I understand that the GPS bracelet is not to be cut at any time.

_____ I must notify the Juvenile Services Department at **(305) 755-6100**, if the GPS equipment malfunctions or if any of my equipment becomes damaged.

_____ I understand that I must have a working phone number in order to be contacted.
