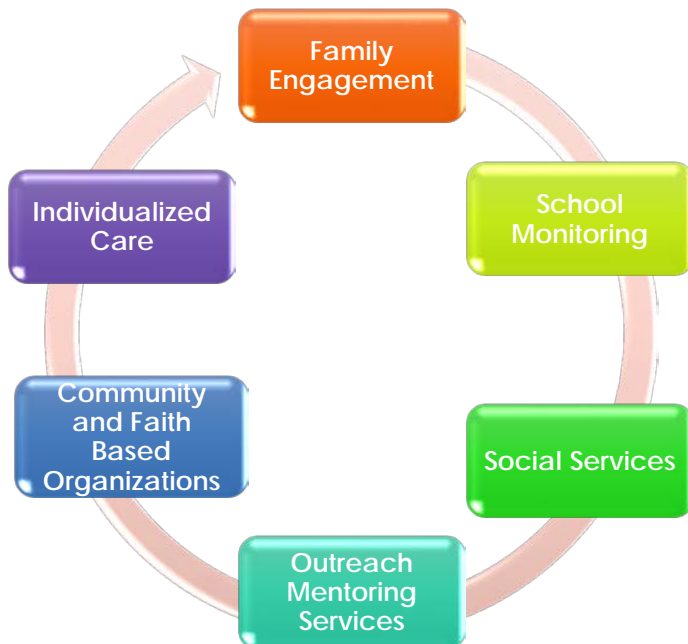


MIAMI-DADE COUNTY JUVENILE SERVICES DEPARTMENT

2017 YEAR END PREVENTION REPORT

- Since inception, over **1,600** youth served
 - In 2017, **160** cases were referred
 - 79% successful completion rate
- Top **3** referral sources:
 - Parent/Guardian
 - Miami-Dade County Public Schools
 - Miami-Dade Schools Police Department
- **Ages-** 26% of the youth served were ages 12 and under; 51% were between 13-15 years of age; 23% were between ages 16-17
- **Moderate-High Risk Level-** Substance Abuse (18%); Mental Health (50%); Family (60%)

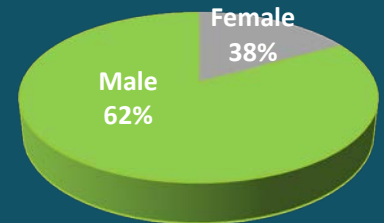

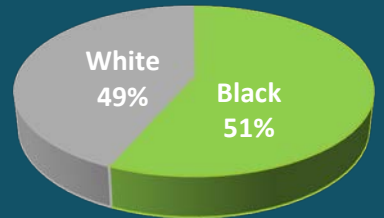


2017 Prevention* Demographics

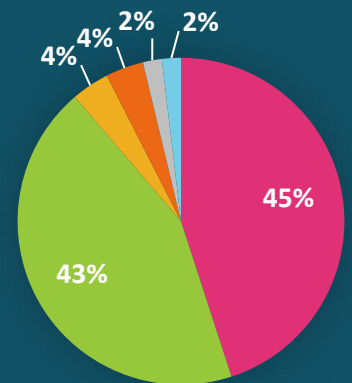
Gender
