REQUESTS TO CHANGE A STATE LAW

SUMMARY

This procedure explains how to make a request to change a state law.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Office of Intergovernmental Affairs circulates a memo to all departments requesting proposals for changes to state law.
- 2. Prepare requests for change as directed by memo including need for change, and attach draft of proposed changes to Florida Statutes.
- 3. Requests are reviewed by Office of Intergovernmental Affairs, the County Attorney's Office, Office of Management and Budget, and Deputy Mayors who make recommendations to the Mayor.
- 4. Office of Intergovernmental Affairs develops Legislative Package.
- 5. Mayor reviews Legislative Package and provides any additional input.
- 6. Office of Intergovernmental Affairs presents Legislative Package to the Board of County Commissioners for approval.
