MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S GOVERNMENT ACCESS CHANNEL

SUMMARY

Digital Media Services, a unit of the Communications Department (COM), operates Miami-Dade TV, which is Miami-Dade County's government cable-access television station, broadcast on all cable TV systems in Miami-Dade County. Miami-Dade TV provides live gavel-to-gavel television coverage of meetings of the Board of County Commission (BCC) and other County boards and committees, as well as replays of these meetings. Live and archived webcasts of BCC meetings are available on the County's web portal.

Digital Media Services produces informational and public education videos that air on the Miami-Dade TV channel and are available for viewing through the County's YouTube channel – http://www.youtube.com/user/MiamiDadeTV.

As a cable-access TV channel, Miami-Dade TV is not available over the airwaves and is not carried by satellite TV services.

PROCEDURE

To watch Miami-Dade TV, check your cable TV provider's channel lineup for the correct channel in your area. In the Stephen P Clark Center at 111 NW 1st Street, channels 11 or 76 broadcasts MDTV programming.

To request Digital Media Services coverage of a County meeting or event, contact the Miami-Dade TV Station Manager for scheduling, availability, and cost information.

To request Digital Media Services' assistance in producing a video program, contact the Miami-Dade TV Station Manager for an appointment to discuss the request. Pending approval by COM, a TV Producer will be assigned to develop the budget, script, and production plan in conjunction with the requesting department's liaison. Availability of production services will depend on current workload.
