UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION

SUMMARY

This procedure explains where to direct employees with questions about unemployment compensation, and the supervisor's responsibilities for handling unemployment compensation claims.

PROCEDURE

Eligibility

- 1. The State of Florida administers the Unemployment Compensation Program. Employees with questions about unemployment compensation should be referred to the State's Division of Unemployment Compensation, Department of Labor.
- 2. The Unemployment Compensation law provides for payments of benefits to former employees who have lost their jobs through no fault of their own.

Supervisor's Responsibilities

- 1. Unemployment compensation claims involving former Miami-Dade County employees are handled by the Labor Management and Compensation, Human Resources Department.
- 2. If a department receives any inquiries or paperwork related to an unemployment compensation claim, send them to the Labor Management and Compensation Division, Human Resources Department through the Departmental Personnel Representative.
- 3. Supervisors may be requested to appear at unemployment compensation hearings which are coordinated by the Labor Management and Compensation Division.
- 4. Personnel files should contain sufficient documentation concerning the reason for termination.
