# Neat Streets Miami | Street Tree Matching Grant

- Million Trees Miami goal of 1 million trees planted by 2020 and a 30% tree canopy
- Inaugural cycle: April 29, 2016 to August 30, 2016
- Received 26 applications (20 municipalities, 4 non-profits) requesting over \$450,000 in grant funding
- Grant funds were spread among the top 10 projects
- Over 400 trees were planted!

# Tree City USA

## **City of Sweetwater**

"Because of the 2016 Street Tree Grant program, we have met budget requirements to become a Tree City USA. This will greatly increase our chances to be awarded other forestry grants and make evident our commitment to creating a more green and sustainable environment."

## **City of West Miami**

"We have reignited our tree placement program and are contemplating the commencement of a tree program which surveys existing trees and their environment and the placement of new trees in a prospering location. We are now budgeting the amount of \$10K per year as a match to any grants which will benefit the City and its residents and have also begun the process of becoming a Tree City USA."

## Feedback from Grantees

City of Sweetwater: "FIU student commute to and from school is now more pleasant due increased greenways, more shade, and lower street temperatures."

**City of North Miami:** "The Neat Street Tree Planting Project has contributed to the funding of planting trees to increase tree canopy, **improve air quality**, **increase stormwater drainage** and **enhance aesthetic beauty** as identified in the adopted North Miami Street Tree Management Plan."

**City of Hialeah:** "It not only improved the **aesthetic** look of the two corridors, it also **promoted walkability** in the area."

City of Miami Beach: "The trees planted ...served as a test bed for some new tree establishment products, including the use of Gator Tree Bags, which will helpfully lower the costs for establishing trees enabling us to purchase more reforestation trees."

## Lessons Learned

- Increase non-profit / CBOs participation
- Close-out report should be online with required attachments
- Anticipate Landscape Ordinance specifying diversity requirements
- iTree report will be conducted by staff
- Selection committee should be provided visual of where the trees will be installed

# Now accepting matching grant applications between \$5,000 & \$25,000 for native or Florida-friendly canopy trees on County or local streets

Eligible Candidates include municipalities, non-profits, & community organizations.

**Grant Applications will be evaluated** on existing tree canopy, income level, match, education/outreach component, impact, ability to implement, & maintenance plan.

**Preference** will be given to areas with **low-to-moderate income populations** and/or with **20% or less of tree canopy.**
