








A Year in the Making

Safer People, Safer Streets

Vision: A more livable Miami-Dade through the realization of healthier, safer streets accommodating all modes of transportation.

Outcomes:

1. Measurable reduction in bicycle and pedestrian crashes countywide
2. Overall increase in bicycling, pedestrian and transit activity

Safer People, Safer Streets Action Plan

- Complete Streets Approach
- **Empower staff; make traffic study requirements inclusive of pedestrian and bicyclist safety when considering capacity**
 - Fix Barriers
- **Create a “safety innovation” program to implement new techniques; partner with local universities**

Safer People, Safer Streets Action Plan

- Gather Data
 - **Enhance frequency of MPO's program**
 - **Expand use of before-and-after counts**
- Design Right
 - **Develop Complete Streets Guidelines/**
 - **Update Public Works Manual**
- Create Networks with Maintenance
 - **Review existing roadway typical sections for opportunities to implement buffered bike lanes**

Early Adoption Plan

Agency	Action Item
PROS	Doubling funds for bicycle education building upon Bike 305, WalkSafe/BikeSafe and Age Friendly Initiatives
	Completing equity access study and last-mile connections between transit and parks
	Secured \$5 Million for bike facilities
	Exploring options of land near transit for transit amenities and connections
	Identify 3 bike safety town regional park locations
MDPD	Target education around high crash or "hot spot" areas
	Making education more dynamic with video and social media
	Leveraging technology
	2700 officers = potential educators
	Bike Patrol engaging bicyclists at key events.
	Coordinate with FDOT's WalkWise program
	Initiate a Bike Patrol Program
