#### **Proposed New Rapid Transit Lines**

The North Corridor: A Metrorail extension running from the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Metrorail station along NW 27th Avenue to the Broward County line.

Palmetto Expressway (SR 826), through Miami International Airport to downtown Miami, and to the Port of Miami.

Earlington Heights/Airport Connector: An extension linking Earlington Heights Metrorail station to the Miami Intermodal Center east of Miami International Airport.

 Baylink: A corridor between downtown Miami and Miami Beach.

Kendail Comidor: A corridor with east/west and north/south segments.

Northeast Corridor: A corridor from downtown Miami to northeast Miami-Dade.

Metrorail station to Cutler Ridge and then to Florida City.

Douglas Road Extension: Corridor linking Douglas Road Metrorall station to the Miami Intermodal Center.


