

## What is Generation FINN?

Generation FINN is a <u>free</u> summer Dual Enrollment program offering in-person courses. Students select two courses and an activity track (STEM, Business, or Liberal Arts), engage in hands-on activities, and can earn up to 6 college credits. The program also includes 'Field Trip Fridays'. Enrollment is first come, first served. **Deadline to apply: May 16, 2025.** 

<u>Eligibility</u>: Dual enrollment students with a minimum 2.5 unweighted GPA and test scores for all three areas (reading, writing, and math). Middle School students must meet the 3.0 GPA requirement and pass all 3 sections of the college placement examination.
