

# PINE ROCKLAND



- 1 Characterized by dominant slash pines that tower above an understory of shrubs such as saw palmettos and lush herbaceous plants
- 2 Only 1.5% of this globally endangered, fire dependent habitat is left
- 3 Supports an incredibly high biodiversity of plant and wildlife species, some which are found nowhere else in the world
- 4 You can find pine rockland at Seminole Wayside Park, Ron Ehmann Park, Tropical Park, A.D. Barnes Park, Larry and Penny Thompson Memorial Park, and the Charles Deering Estate
