The Special Assessment Districts Division is responsible through Chapter 18 of the Code of Miami-Dade County for the creation, management, and operation of special taxing districts. With 1,061 active districts, the Division services approximately 264,912 households in unincorporated and municipal neighborhoods throughout Miami-Dade County.

What We Do!

➤ LIGHTING SERVICES TO **915** DISTRICTS COMPRISED OF 226,217 FOLIOS, AND OVER 40,697 LIGHTS ON 33,432 LIGHT POLES

➤ LANDSCAPE SERVICES TO **120** DISTRICTS COMPRISED OF 31,822 FOLIOS, 10 NATURAL AREAS, 90 LAKES AND OVER 10,000 TREES.

➤ PROVIDE MUNICIPAL SERVICES BY MEANS OF A LOCAL SPECIAL PURPOSE GOVERNMENT FOR **96** COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS

➤ SECURITY SERVICES TO **24** DISTRICTS COMPRISED OF 6,734 FOLIOS, 22 GUARDBOUSES AND 9 ROVING CREWS.

➤ CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT SERVICES TO 2 DISTRICTS COMPRISED OF 119 FOLIOS
