On March 9, 1978, Miss Diane Rohbeck and her friend Ken Castleberry went on a boating trip. It is believed they launched their boat from Port Everglades, in Fort Lauderdale, and were on their way to the Bahamas. Miss Rohbeck and Mr. Castleberry left on a 24-foot long, purple & white, NOVA inboard/outboard boat. Neither Miss Rohbeck, Mr. Castleberry, nor the boat has been seen again. The missing persons were 22 and 24 years-old, respectively, at the time of their disappearance.

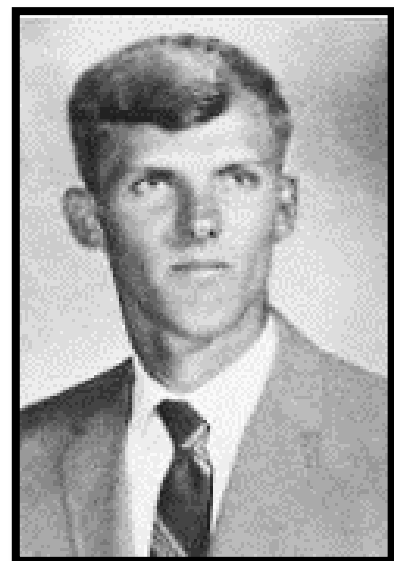
