### RONALD LAMONT BOYKIN

Ronald L. Boykin was 6 weeks-old when he was taken from his family residence on June 6, 1967. The child was taken by a young black female posing as a nurse. She informed the baby's mother that she would return after taking the baby for his immunizations shots at the hospital; the woman never returned with the child. She was last seen entering a vehicle, driven by a black male. No ransom demand was ever made and the family never saw or heard from the child or the subjects again.
