


MISSING PERSON

COLD CASE

WILLIAM HENRY FORSHEE, JR.

On April 16, 1973, Mr. William H. Forshee, Jr. went fishing on an 18-foot, flat-bottomed boat with his father, Mr. William H. Forshee, Sr. Two other black males accompanied them, Mr. Dewitt Lewis and Mr. Benny Gaskins. They launched the boat at the Captain's Landing Marina, located at 1069 Bald Eagle Drive, Marco Island, Florida (now known as the Pier 81 Condominiums). The boat trailer was located at the marina, along with the truck, a green 1969 Ford pick-up F-100, with an unknown Florida tag. Neither of the men nor the boat has been located since. Mr. William H. Forshee, Jr. was 17 years-old at the time of his disappearance and had skin graft scars on both of his thighs.
