



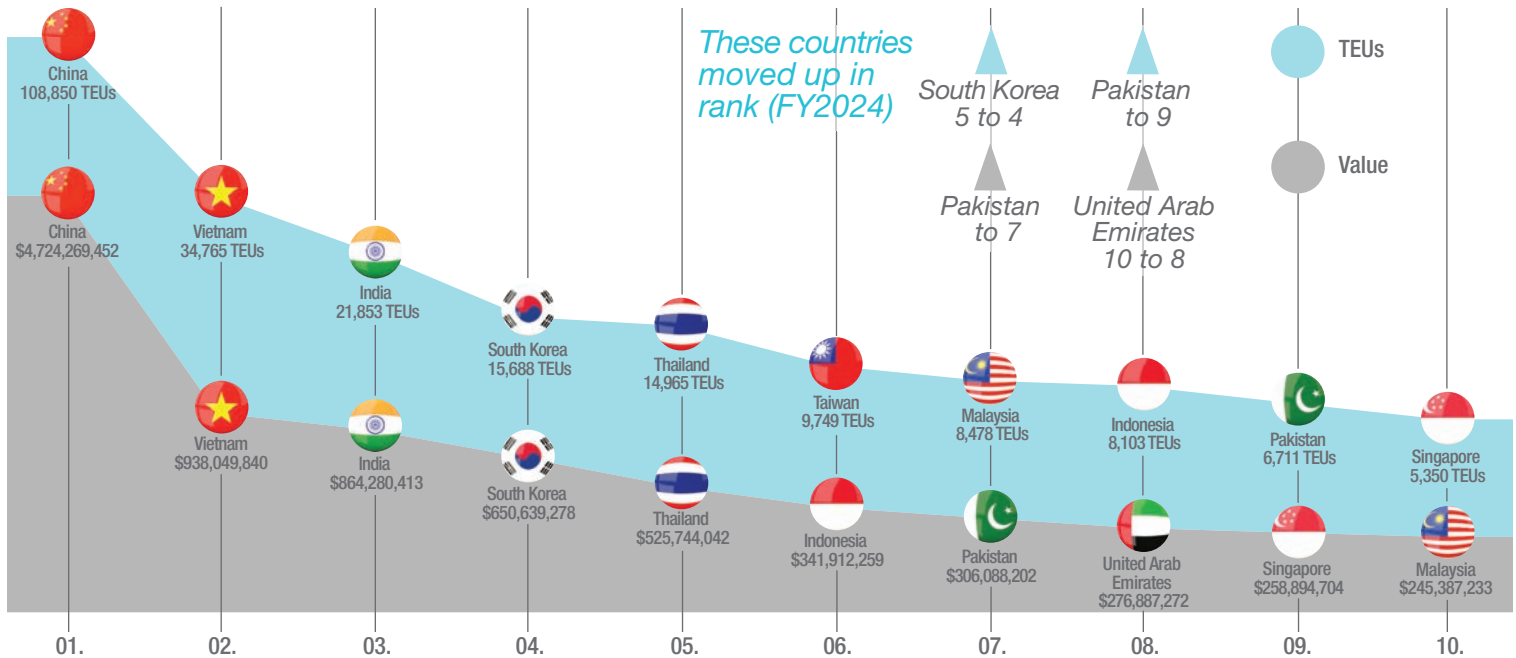

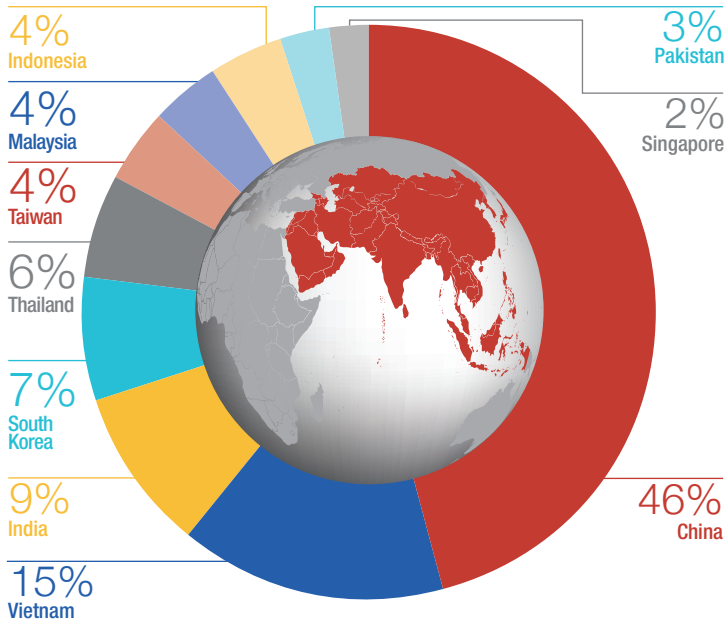

These four commodities represent 135,376 TEUs and a value of \$5.1 Billion for PortMiami.

01. Furniture

PortMiami serves as a critical gateway for import of furniture from countries like Vietnam, Malaysia, Indonesia and China. The Port is positioned to serve as an entry point to U.S. distribution centers.



02. Iron, Steel and Aluminum

PortMiami plays a strategic role in trade of iron, steel, and aluminum between Asia and the U.S. These metals are essential for industries such as construction, automotive, aerospace, manufacturing, and infrastructure development.



03. Machinery

Machinery is a key commodity for PortMiami. A wide range of equipment and machinery are moved through the Port supporting the construction, manufacturing and agriculture industries across the U.S., Latin America and the Caribbean.



04. Plastics and Rubber

Plastics and rubber are an important commodity for PortMiami. The demand for plastics and rubber spans across industries such as automotive, construction, packaging, medical and consumer goods manufacturing.
