WAP enables low-income families to reduce their energy bills by making their homes more energy efficient. Funds are used to improve the energy performance of dwellings families in need, using the most advanced technologies and testing procedures available in the housing industry. Measures to make homes more energy efficient include: replacement or installation of key components, installation of energy recovery ventilation systems including bathroom and kitchen exhaust fans and installation of whole mechanical exhaust systems to provide better indoor air quality, install attic insulation, install window solar films, repair or replace inefficient cooling units, repair or replace water heaters and address air infiltration with weather stripping, caulking thresholds, minor wall repairs, ceiling and floors, windows and doors.

The Contractor shall furnish all materials, labor, services, supervision, tools, equipment, and all other items necessary for the construction necessary for the relocations, renovations, and upgrades of two existing locations in PortMiami's Cruise Terminal D (CTD) and 1500 Building at the Miami-Dade County Seaport Department.

The project consists of, but is not limited to, various interior tenant improvements including new finishes; furnish and install new non-load bearing partition walls; furnish and install new lighting fixtures and distribution layouts; furnish and install new fire-protection distribution layouts; furnish and install new low voltage and security systems; furnish and install new HVAC layouts; furnish and install one (1) new roof-mounted HVAC unit (CTD); furnish and install new restroom facilities (CTD); furnish and install new fixed windows (CTD); reduce size of existing overhead door openings with CMU (CTD); site improvements to create a new surface parking area (CTD); furnish and install two (2) HVAC units in two (2) existing IT Server (LAN) rooms (1500 Building); and any supportive ancillary tasks to successfully complete all phases of the project.
