INCLUDING CANCELLATION, TERMINATION. AND AMENDMENT PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE N.W. 7TH AVENUE CORRIDOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The matter contained in the foregoing recital is incorporated in this resolution by reference.

Section 2. This Board approves the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Area Improvement & Redevelopment Program grant funding recommendations in an amount not to exceed \$356,250.00.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Board further authorizes the Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee to negotiate and execute grant agreements on behalf of the Agency with the grantees as more fully described in the accompanying memorandum, in generally the forms approved by this Board in accordance with Resolution No. 02-2025. This Board also authorizes the Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee to exercise all provisions contained therein, including cancellation, termination, and amendment provisions.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Board conditions the grant awards on each grantee submitting to the Agency informal conceptual plan or architectural drawings, whichever is applicable, to be approved by the Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee, in their sole discretion.
