RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE N.W. 79TH STREET CORRIDOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ADOPTING MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS AS SET FORTH IN SECTIONS 2-8.1, 2-8.2 AND 2-11.1 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY IMPLEMENTING ORDER NO. 3-38, AND ALL OTHER APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, AND AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY SAME

**WHEREAS**, the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. R-499-16, which urges each community redevelopment agency to adopt, in part, the procurement requirements that are established by the State of Florida, Miami-Dade County or the municipality in which the community redevelopment agency operates; and

**WHEREAS**, the Miami-Dade County procurement requirements are presently codified in Sections 2-8.1, 2-8.2 and 2-11.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County ("Procurement Ordinance"), as amended; and

Miami-Dade County has also adopted Implementing Order No. 3-38, a copy of which is attached is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, Implementing Order No. 3-38 serves as the master procurement guidelines for the County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to adopt the Procurement Ordinances and Implementing Order No. 3-38 and to be bound by same; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board believes that it is in the best interest of the Agency and the residents and businesses within the Redevelopment Area to adopt the Procurement Ordinance and Implementing Order No. 3-38,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE N.W. 79TH STREET CORRIDOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, that:

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**Section 1**. The matters contained in the foregoing recitals are incorporated in this

Resolution by reference.

**Section 2**. This Board adopts Miami-Dade County Procurement Requirements as set

forth in Sections 2-8.1, 2-8.2 and 2-11.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, as amended,

Miami-Dade County Implementing Order No. 3-38, and all other applicable Procurement

requirements established by Miami-Dade County, and agrees to be bound by same.
