GUIDELINES FOR THE DISCUSSION

4. This meeting is a safe space to speak openly and honestly without interruption or fear of being put down.
5. Do not speak too often or too long.
6. All communications will be responsible and respectful. Confrontational language, insulting remarks and aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.

CRB Policy on Decorum

Any person making impertinent remarks or who becomes boisterous while addressing the CRB, shall be barred from further audience before the CRB by the presiding officer, unless permission to continue or again address the CRB be granted by the majority vote of the CRB members present. No heckling or verbal outbursts in opposition to a speaker or his or her remarks shall be permitted. No signs or placards shall be allowed in the CRB meeting. Persons exiting the CRB meeting shall do so quietly.
