HOUSING

- Building tens of thousands more units to expand workforce and affordable housing
- Growing the Office of Housing Advocacy by hiring social and case management workers
- Continuing to implement the historic HOMES plan for housing affordability, providing relief for residents and accelerating construction



TRANSIT & MOBILITY

- Fully implementing the Better Bus Network to increase route frequency
- Completing the South Corridor to connect the South Dade community
- MetroRail and MetroMover station enhancements that upgrade elevators and escalators, and bus shelters for riders



PUBLIC SAFETY

- Funding the Peace and Prosperity plan to create pathways to opportunity for high-risk youth
- Investing in crime prevention to increase safety by recovering firearms and stolen vehicles
- Elevating the MDPD Crisis Intervention Team to support a mental health-focused police unit


ENVIRONMENT

- Combating the impacts of extreme heat with tree canopy enhancements and worker protections
- Preventing flooding by investing in stormwater infrastructure and improving building standards



SMALL BUSINESS & ENTREPRENEURS

- Strengthening the Strive305 program to accelerate business growth countywide
- Supporting local entrepreneurs with minority-owned small business grants
- Completing the procurement disparity study to strengthen our small business ecosystem



INVESTING IN OUR FAMILIES

- Investing in Miami Dade College to make obtaining an Associates degree free for more eligible families
- Expanding child daycare to create options and prosperity for families
- Launching internship opportunities for young people across Miami-Dade
