Some Highlights from the September 3, 2025 Commission Meeting



## **Among the Legislation Items Passed:**

- <u>Resolution</u> approving the extension of the 2025 real and personal property tax rolls prior to the completion of Value Adjustment Board hearings. – <u>Passed</u>
- Resolution urging the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding to maintain Tri-Rail's level of service. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> directing the County Mayor to evaluate the feasibility of implementing incentive-based programs for waste diversion and recycling. – <u>Passed</u>
- Resolution directing the County Mayor to provide a report on Community Redevelopment Agencies in the county. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> to explore the inclusion of a voluntary contribution to community-based organizations on the annual tax notice to taxpayers. <u>Passed</u>
- Resolution directing the County Mayor to explore creation of mini dumps for collection and disposal of yard waste. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> urging the Florida legislature and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to appropriate funding for the Stormwater System Cistern Project. - <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Resolution</u> approving the expansion of the Integrated Command & Communications Center at the Lightspeed Facility in District 12. –
