Some Highlights from the October 9 & 21, 2025 Commission Meeting



## **Among the Legislation Items Passed:**

- Resolution to rename the North Dade Justice Center as the "Harvey Ruvin Justice Center" Passed
- Ordinance establishing and enforcing standards for municipalities operating public utilities outside their municipal boundaries Passed
- Ordinance to facilitate the zoning approval process for composting operations in agricultural zoning districts. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> urging the Florida Legislature to expand paid leave time for public employees who need to complete United States Military, Naval Reserve, or Florida National Guard training periods. – <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Resolution</u> directing the County Mayor to conduct neighborhood planning exercises related to the unique architectural and aesthetic character of Schenley Park. – <u>Passed</u>
- Resolution authorizing the County Mayor to submit an application to convey a vacant public housing site to SG Poinciana Ventures for development of a logistics center. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> urging the United States Army Corps of Engineers and the South Florida Water Management District to expedite the Central and Southern Florida Flood Resiliency Study. – <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Resolution</u> directing the County Mayor to suspend disconnection of water service for federal employees and active military personnel during the government shutdown and for 60 days after the shutdown ends. <u>Passed</u>
