Some Highlights from the March 3 & 17, 2026 Commission Meetings



Among the Legislation Items Passed:

- **Resolution** declaring a certain geographic area in South Miami to be a slum or blighted area in need of a community redevelopment agency. - *Passed*
- **Ordinance** amending the minimum qualifications for the Office of the Inspector General. - *Passed*
- **Resolution** opposing Florida House Bill 399, which would preempt local governments' voting requirements to amend local comprehensive plans and require the state to conduct a study related to the County's Urban Development Boundary. - *Passed*
- **Resolution** urging the United States Congress to adopt H.R. 7221, limiting the number of residential homes owned by corporations and private equity firms. - *Passed*
- **Resolution** urging President Donald J. Trump, the Secretary of State, and the United States Congress to engage with the Cuban exile community regarding the future of Cuba. - *Passed*
- **Discussion item** regarding the 2026 Florida State Legislative Session. - *Passed*
- **Resolution** urging the United States Congress to reauthorize the Second Chance Act. - *Passed*
