Some Highlights from the May 5 & 19, 2026 Commission Meetings



Among the Legislation Items Passed:

- **Ordinance** amending the noise regulation code, reducing the standard distance from 100 feet to 25 feet. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** co-designating the portion of NW 25th Street between NW 117th Avenue and NW 112th Avenue as "Monsignor Tomás Marín Street." - **Passed**
- **Resolution** congratulating The Republic of Costa Rica and The Republic of Ecuador for severing diplomatic ties with Cuba. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** urging hospitals throughout the county to join the farm-to-hospital initiative to improve patient food quality. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** urging the United States Senate to pass legislation extending Temporary Protected Status for Haitians for the next three years. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** declaring the acquisition of a parcel to be a public necessity for the road widening, beautification, and right-of-way improvements to SW 117th Avenue from SW 184th Street to US-1. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** acknowledging May 20th as Cuban Independence Day and condemning the Cuban government's many human rights abuses. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** directing the County Mayor to coordinate with the Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Miami Beach for potential inclusion of pedestrian lanes on Ocean Drive between 5th Street and 14th Place. - **Passed**
