*Some Highlights from the September 1, 2026 Commission Meeting*



## Among the Legislation Items Passed:

- **Resolution** co-designating the portion of SW 132nd Avenue between 104th Street and South Calusa Club Drive as "Deputy Sheriff Devin Matthew Jaramillo Way." – **Passed**
- **Resolution** co-designating the portion of S.R. 932/NW 103rd Street/49th Street within the City of Hialeah as "Celia Cruz Way." – **Passed**
- **Resolution** directing the County Mayor to develop an illegal dumping and encampment plan for District 2. – **Passed**
- **Resolution** co-designating the portion of SW 84th Street between SW 97th Road and SW 103rd Avenue as "Sergeant David Cajuso Way." – **Passed**
- **Resolution** directing the County Mayor to identify vacant or underutilized county-owned land, buildings, and facilities for use by the Miami-Dade Sheriff's Office. – **Passed**
- **Resolution** approving the extension of the 2026 Real and Personal Property Tax Rolls and issuance of tax bills prior to completion of the Value Adjustment Board hearings. – **Passed**
- **Resolution** revising the co-designation of the portion of Venetian Way between East San Marino Island and West Rivo Alto Island from "Judge Irving Cypen Way" to "Judge Irving and Hazel Cypen Way." – **Passed**
- **Ordinances** implementing multiple recommendations from the Final Report of the Special Task Force to Reduce Inefficiencies in Procurement through four separate procurement reform measures, including changes to procurement processes.
