

BEACHRULES Operating Hours 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

X NOT ALLOWED ✓ ALLOWED **Gatherings Social Distancing** No gathering of people from different households. Allow 6 feet of social distancing between people of different households. **Social Areas** No gathering in changing rooms, picnic pavilions (Closed). **Facial Coverings** Must be worn when social distancing of 6 feet cannot be achieved, except for same-household members. **Special Events** No parties or group picnics. Walking and Jogging **Organized Athletics/Activities** Walkers should maintain social distancing of 6 feet while wearing facial coverings. Joggers to maintain minimum of 12 feet from others No volleyball, football, soccer, frisbee, paddle ball, etc. and may lower facial covering. **Canopies or Tents** These structures are not allowed on the beach. Swimming/Surfing /Paddle-Boarding/Kayaking Facial coverings are not required while in the ocean. **Sharing Equipment** No sharing of beach chairs, umbrellas, coolers, etc. among people from different households. **Exercise Equipment** Sunbathing No use of outdoor exercise equipment. Limited to family members from the same household. **Outdoor Showering** Pets While waiting, and walking to and from showers, maintain No dogs or other pets on the beach. social distancing and wear facial coverings. **Fishing Concessions** No surf fishing on the beach. Except at: Haulover Park south seawall and west Intracoastal Water-All individuals waiting in line at concession stands must practice way; Rickenbacker Pier; South Pointe Pier and Government Cut; Bal social distancing and wear facial coverings. Harbour Jetty and Sunny Isles Fishing Pier.

BEACH USE: CDC GUIDELINES AND OTHER REMINDERS

Facial Coverings

- Facial coverings are not required for:
 - Children under 2 years old.
 - Persons who have trouble breathing due to a chronic pre-existing condition; persons who are not able to remove face coverings without assistance.
 - Persons involved in strenuous activity; however, the person involved in strenuous activity should have a face covering in their possession and must be able to show their mask upon request by local authority.
 - While in the ocean.

NOTE: Facial coverings that are wet are ineffective. Beachgoers should bring an additional clean and dry face covering to replace a face covering that becomes wet or dirty.

Gatherings

- No gatherings of people from different households
- Individuals from different households must maintain 6 feet of social distancing per CDC guidelines
- Group size shall not exceed 10 persons at any time.

Public Safety and Enforcement

Enforcement of Beach procedures and protocols is a priority and beachgoers can be required to leave the beach if they are violating the safety requirements.
