MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD SCHEDULE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION (Subject to Change)

The Miami-Dade County Canvassing Board will convene at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections, 2700 NW 87th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33172. The Canvassing Board is convening on these dates for the November 3, 2020 General Election. These meetings will be held both physically at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections and virtually utilizing communications media technology made permissible pursuant to the Governor's Executive Orders. Interested parties may: (1) attend the Canvassing Board meeting in person at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections and be permitted to view and address the Canvassing Board through communications media technology; or (2) join a Zoom meeting to view the meeting by registering in advance of the meeting to avoid delays (Zoom registration will be available beginning 8:00 a.m. on the day of the meeting at: <https://miamidade.live/CanvassingBoardMeeting>). Only those individuals who attend the Canvassing Board meeting in person at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections will be permitted to address the Canvassing Board through the use of communications media technology.
