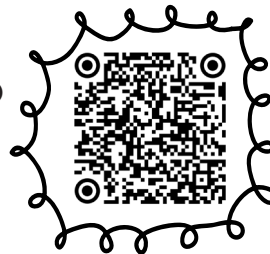


LINE 6: Fears the person has

There is no "right way" to write a bio poem, and poems can take many forms, but for those who prefer a more guided approach, here is **an example of a ten-line formula that includes key characteristics of the subject.** Each line of the bio poem is designed to capture key details about your subject's personality, relationships, and interests in a concise poetic form.
