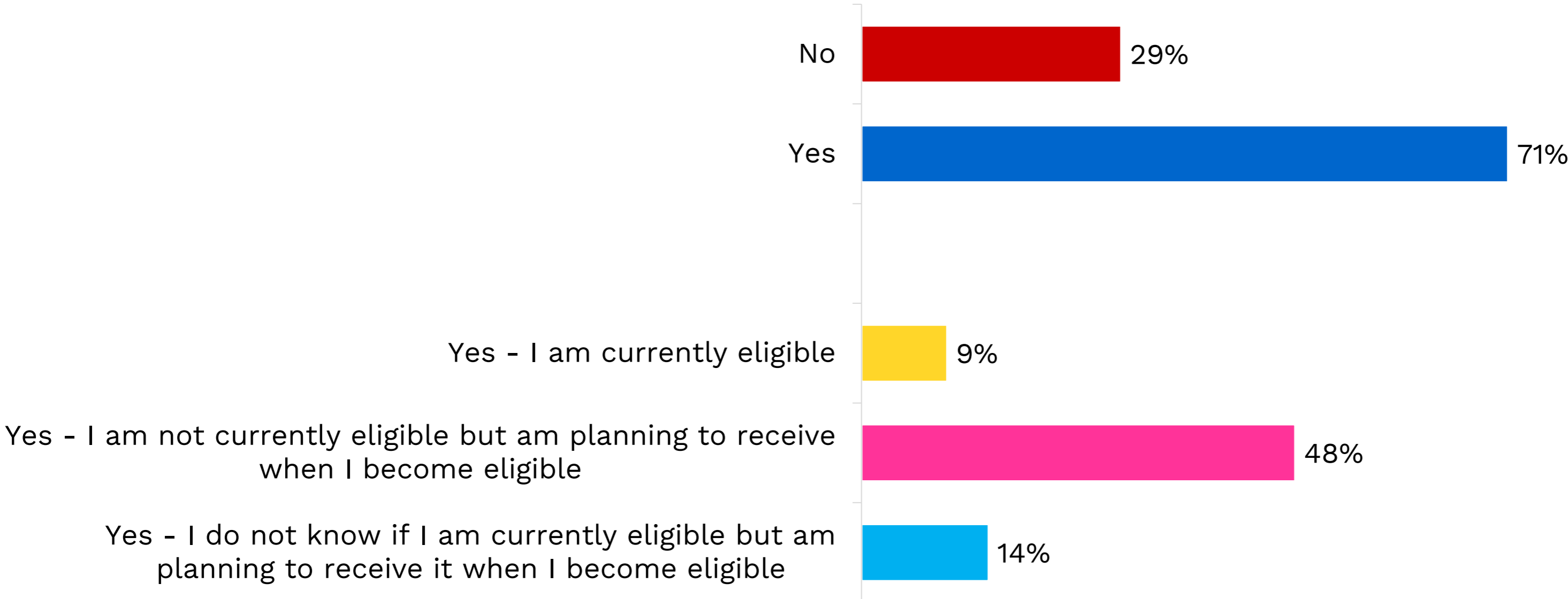

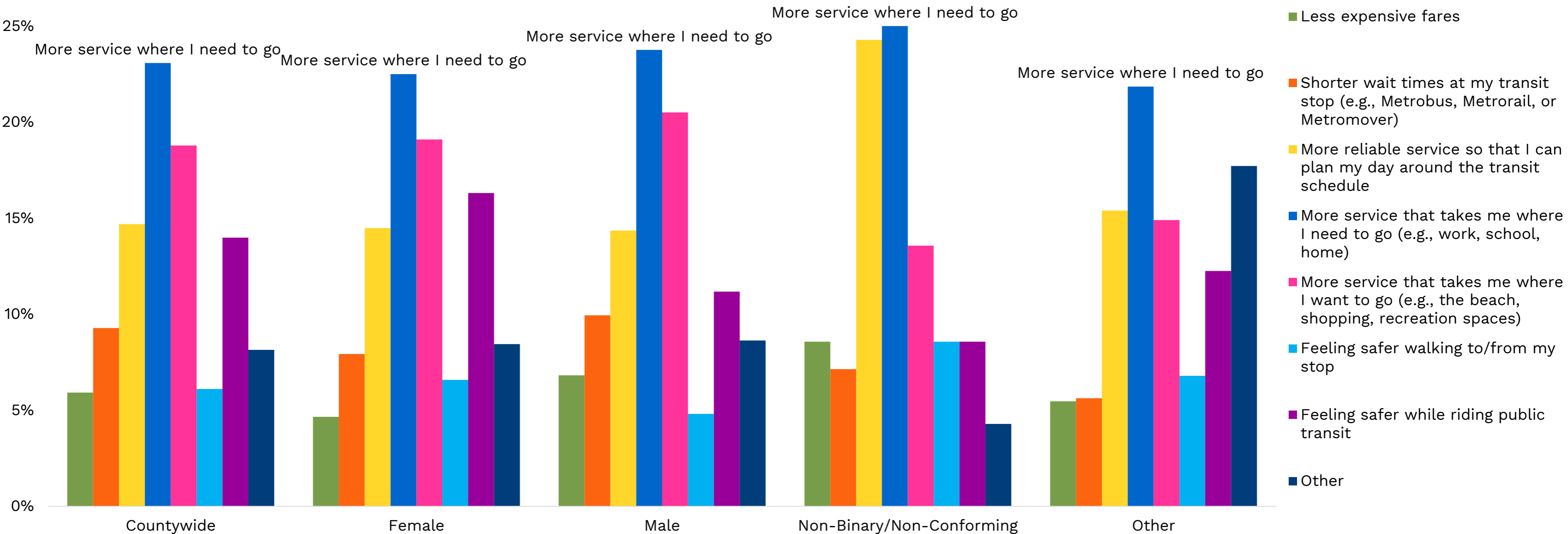
# Future Transit Investments: Under 18 and 18-24 by Race/Ethnicity

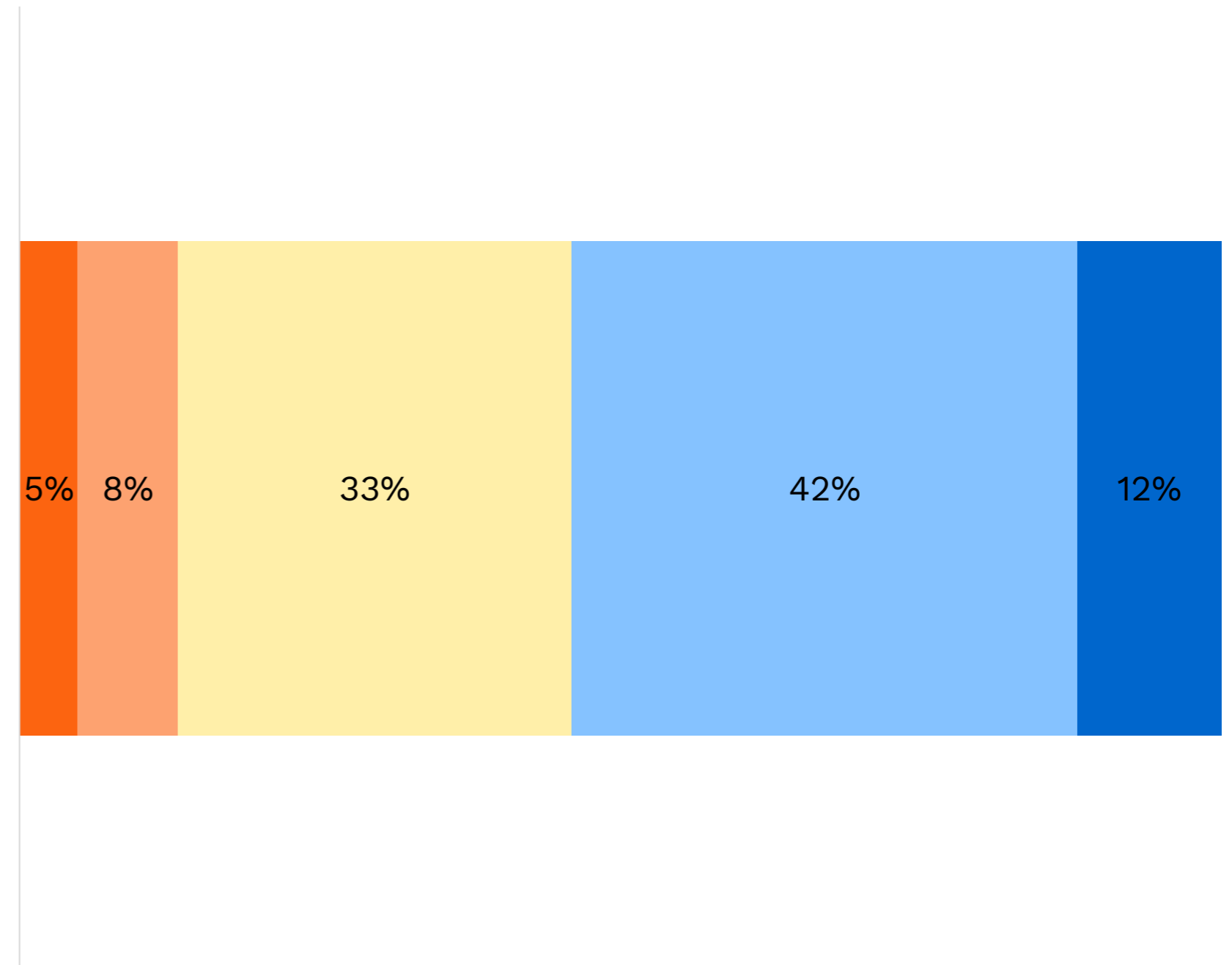

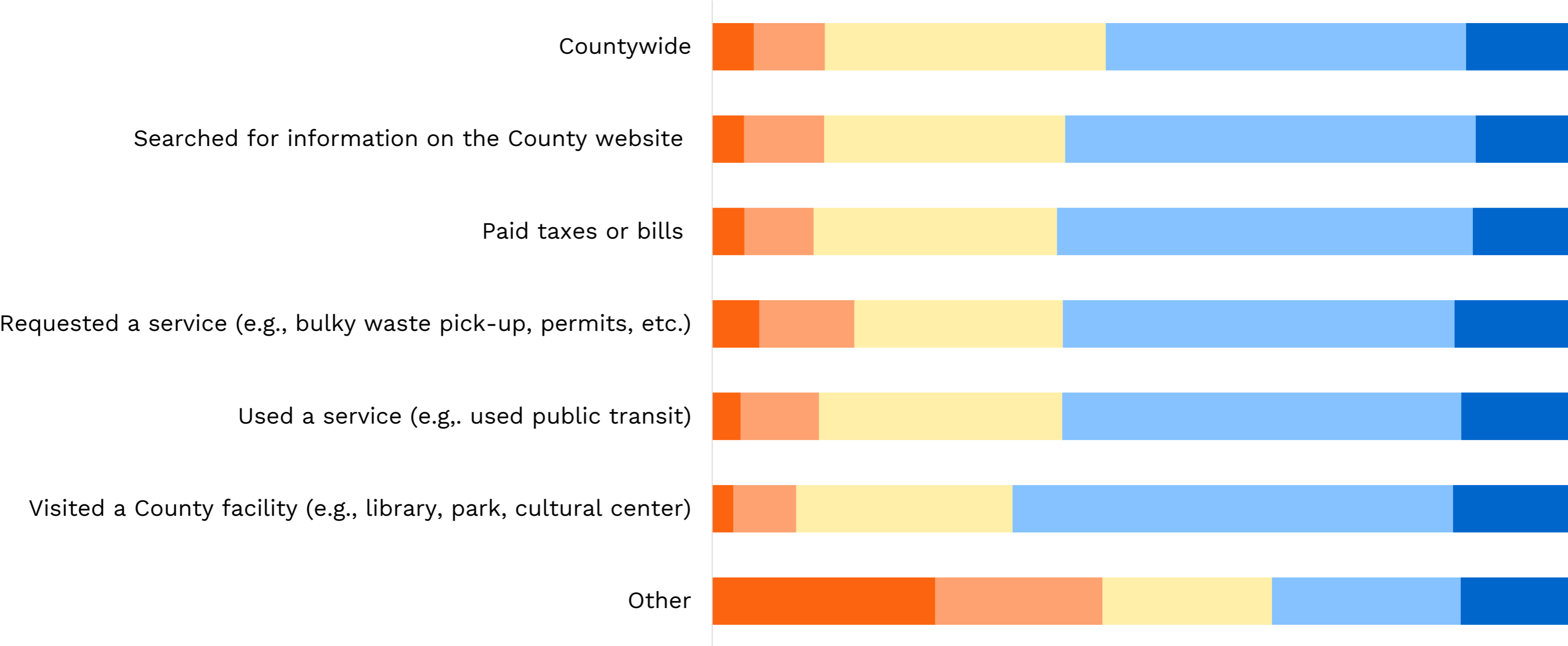

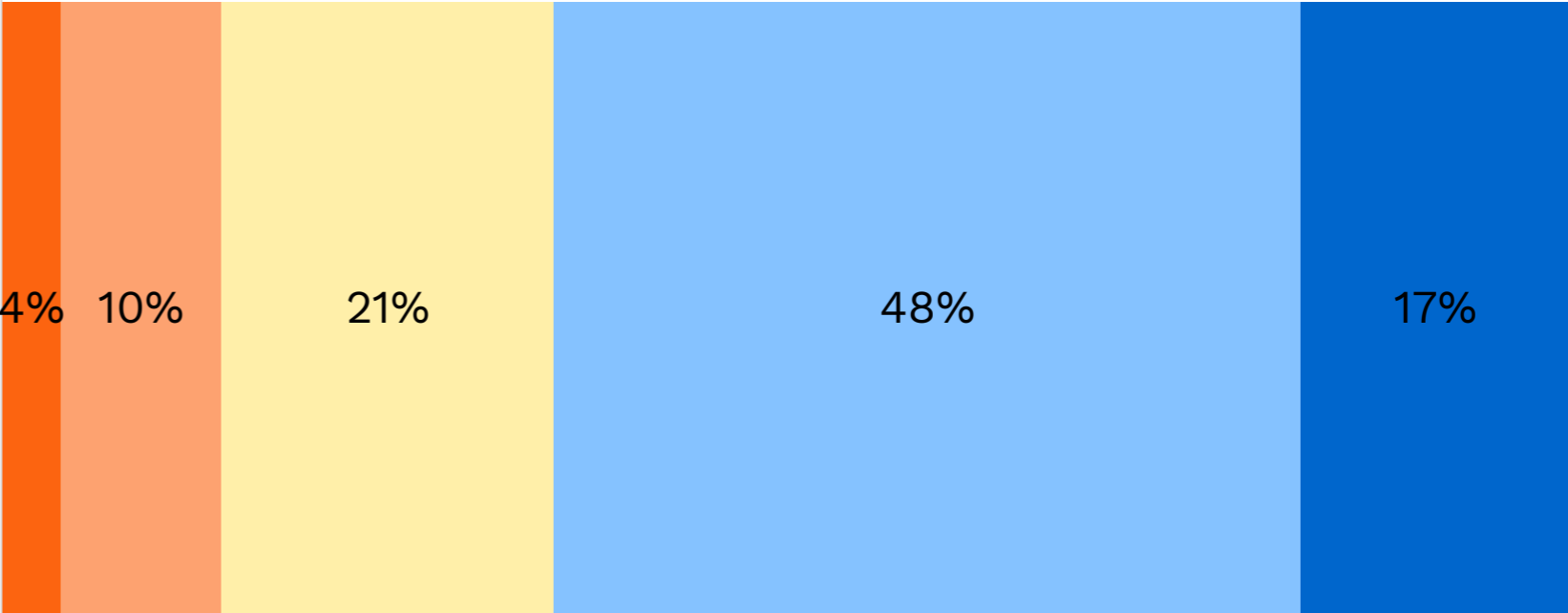

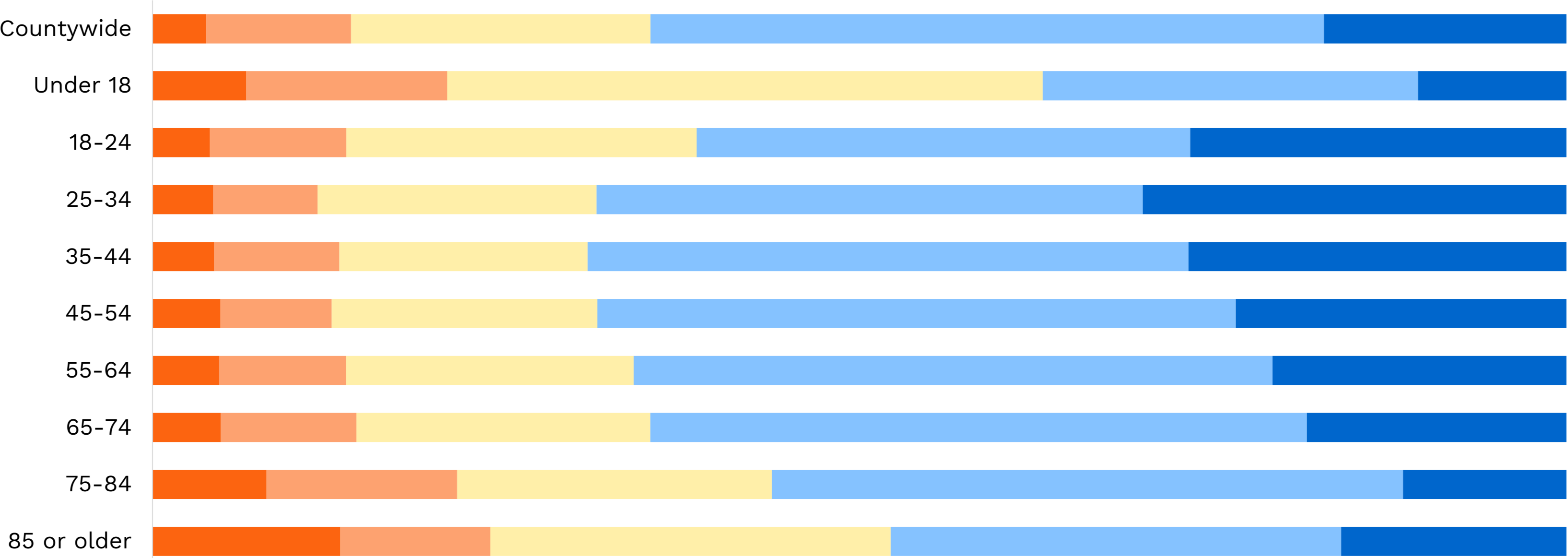

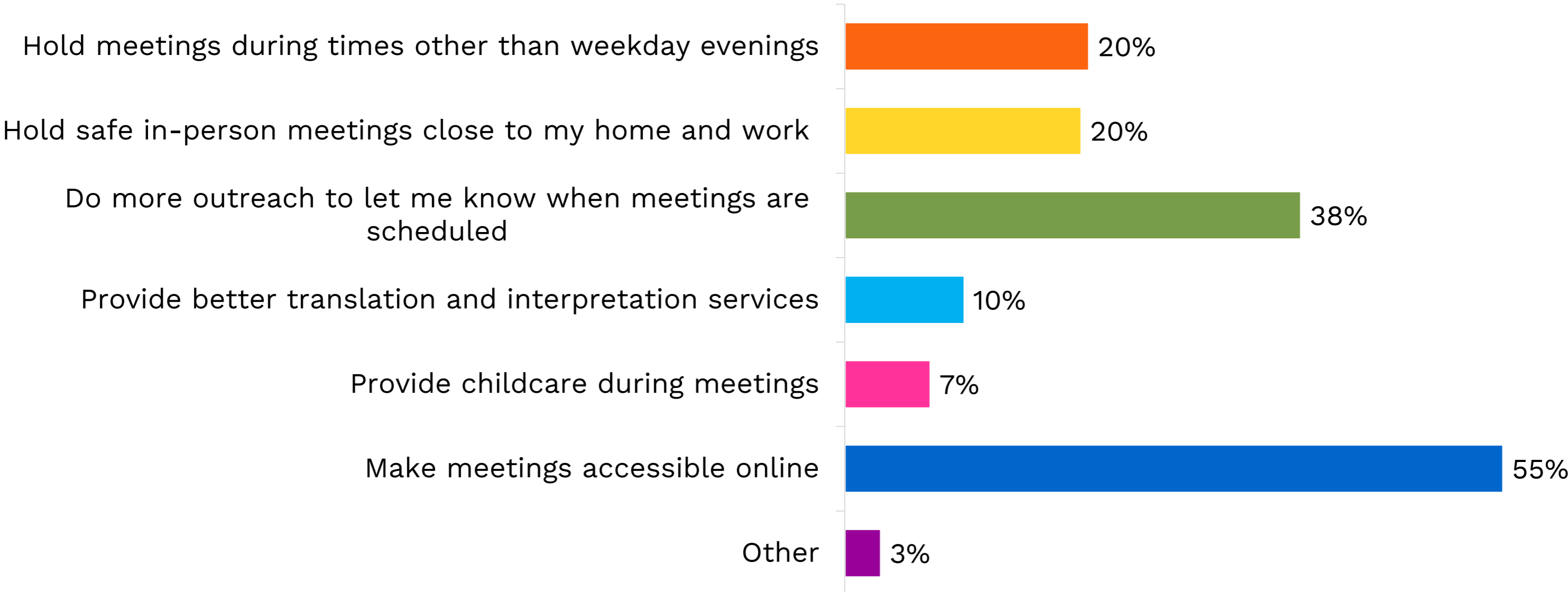

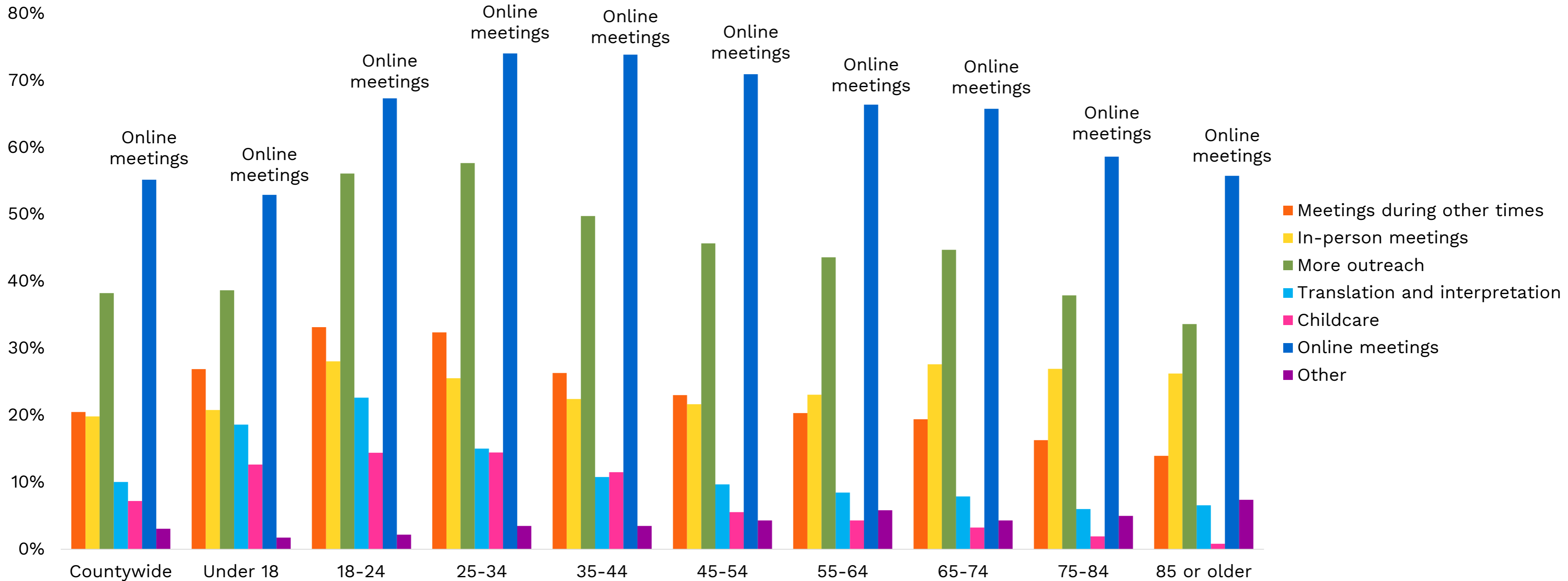

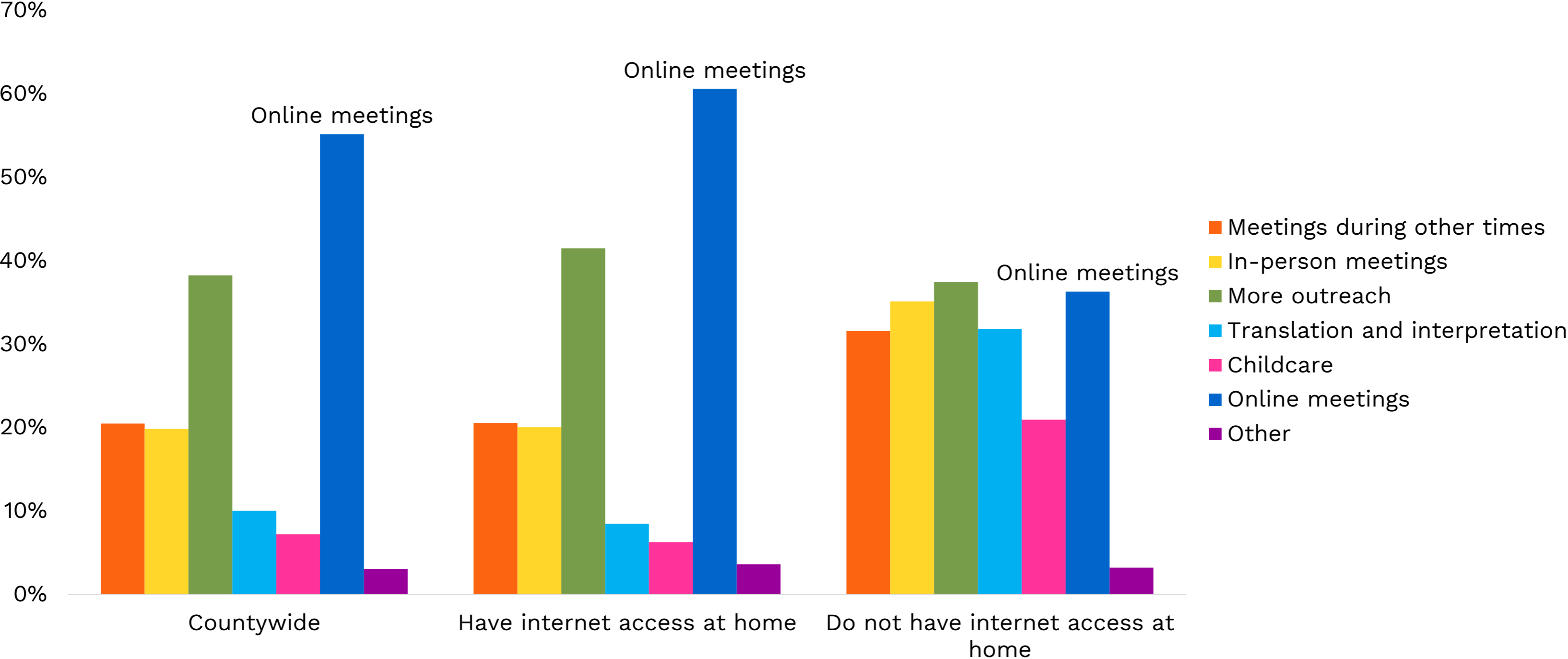

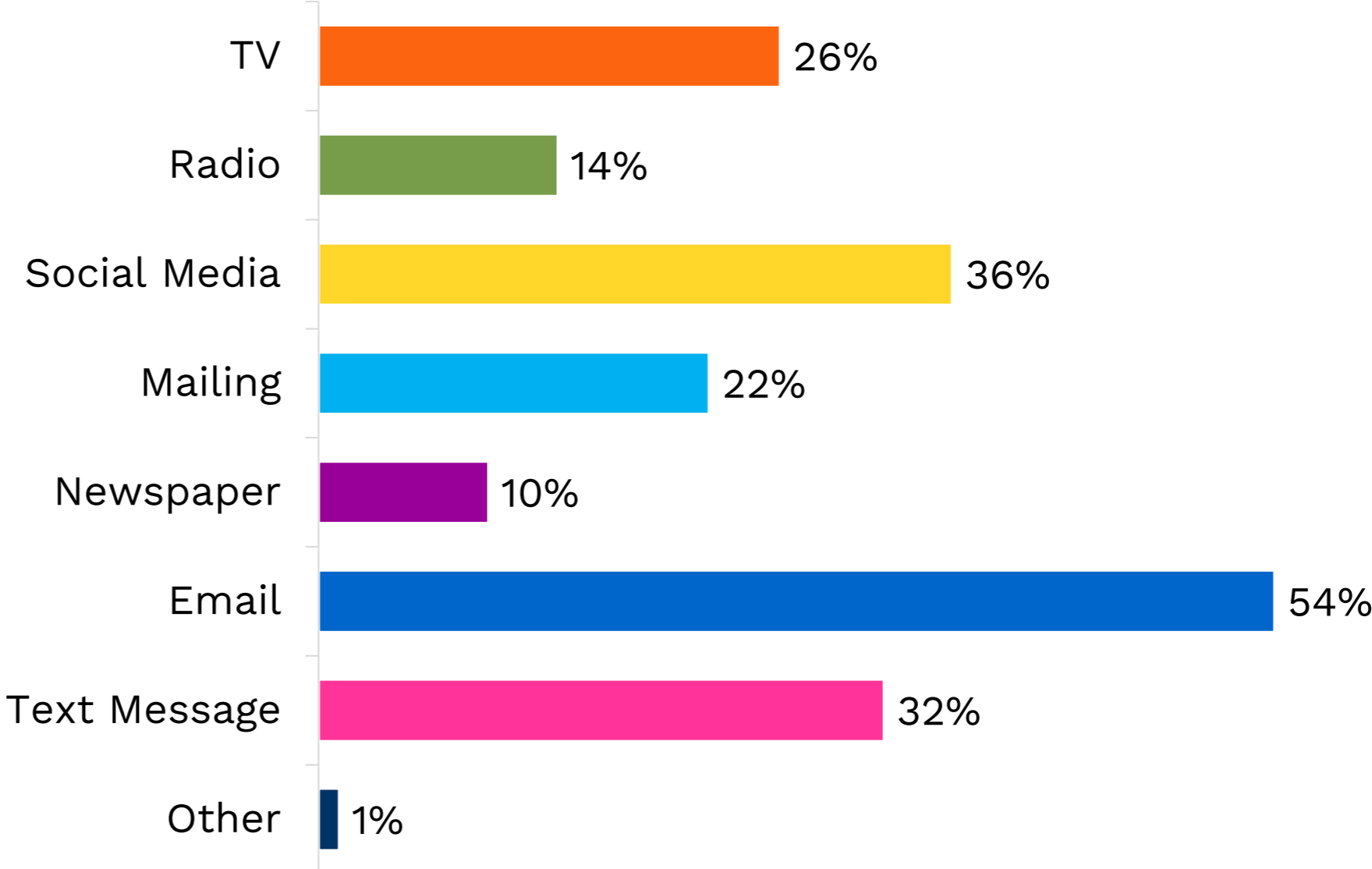

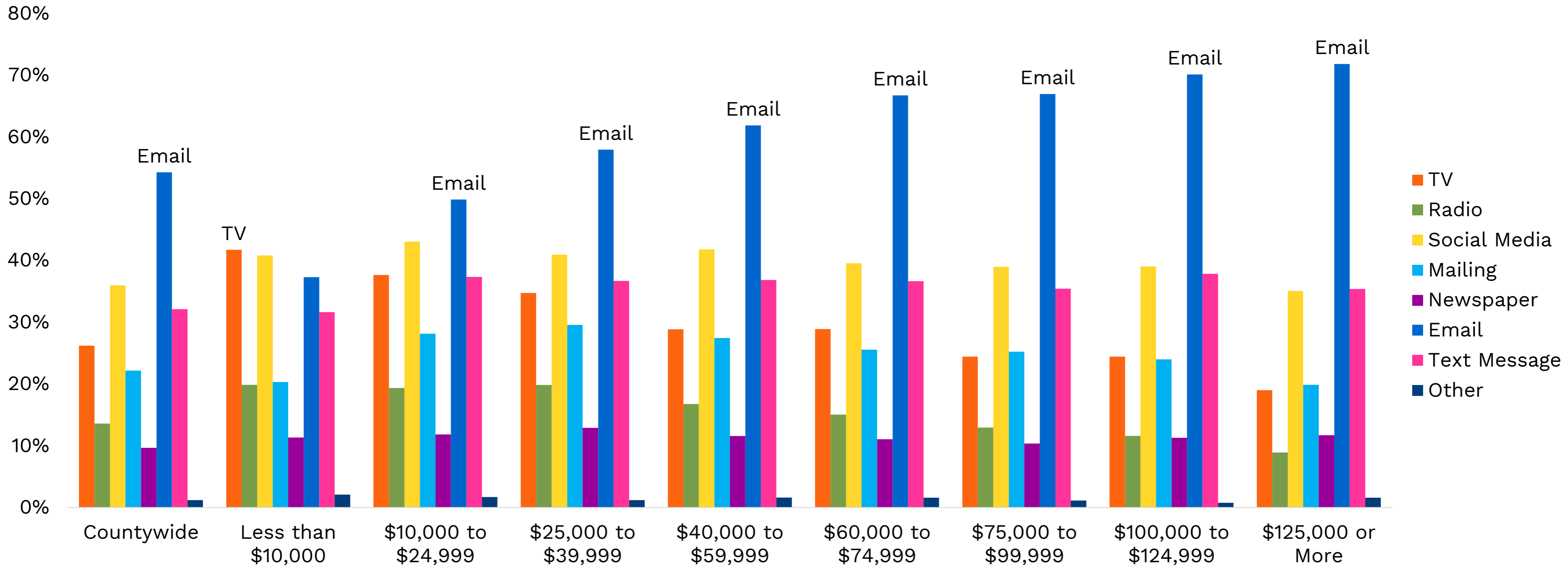

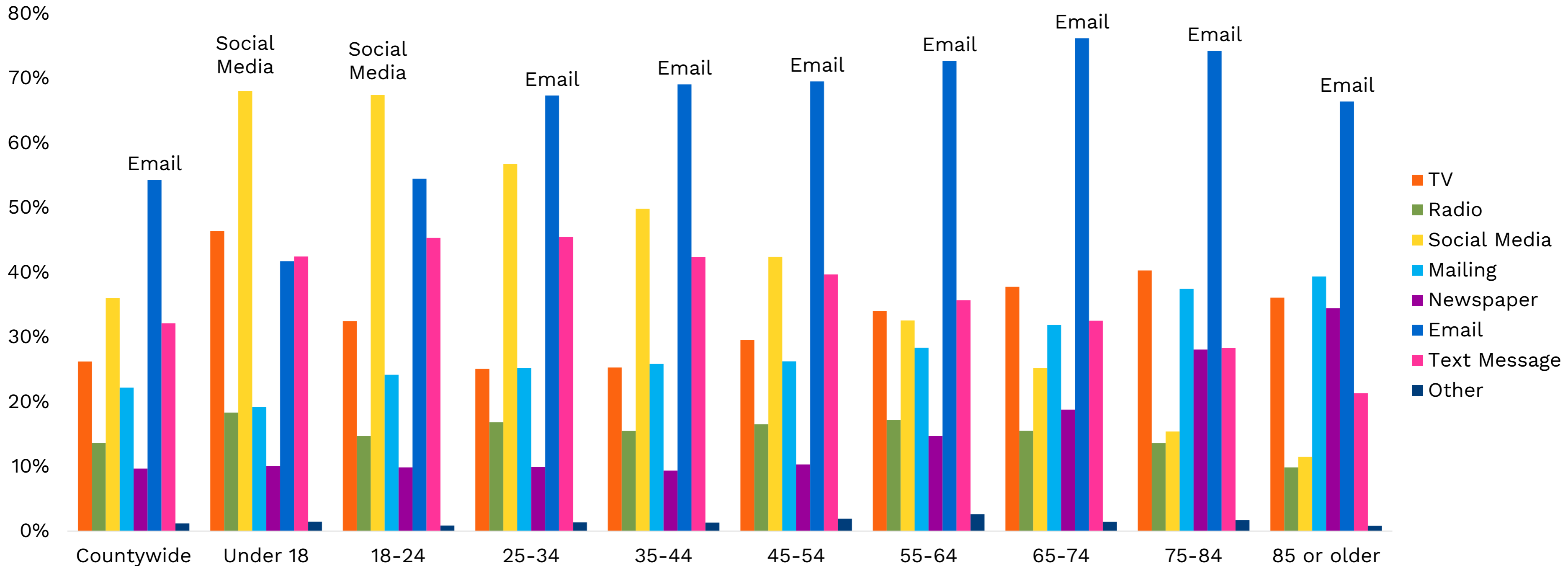

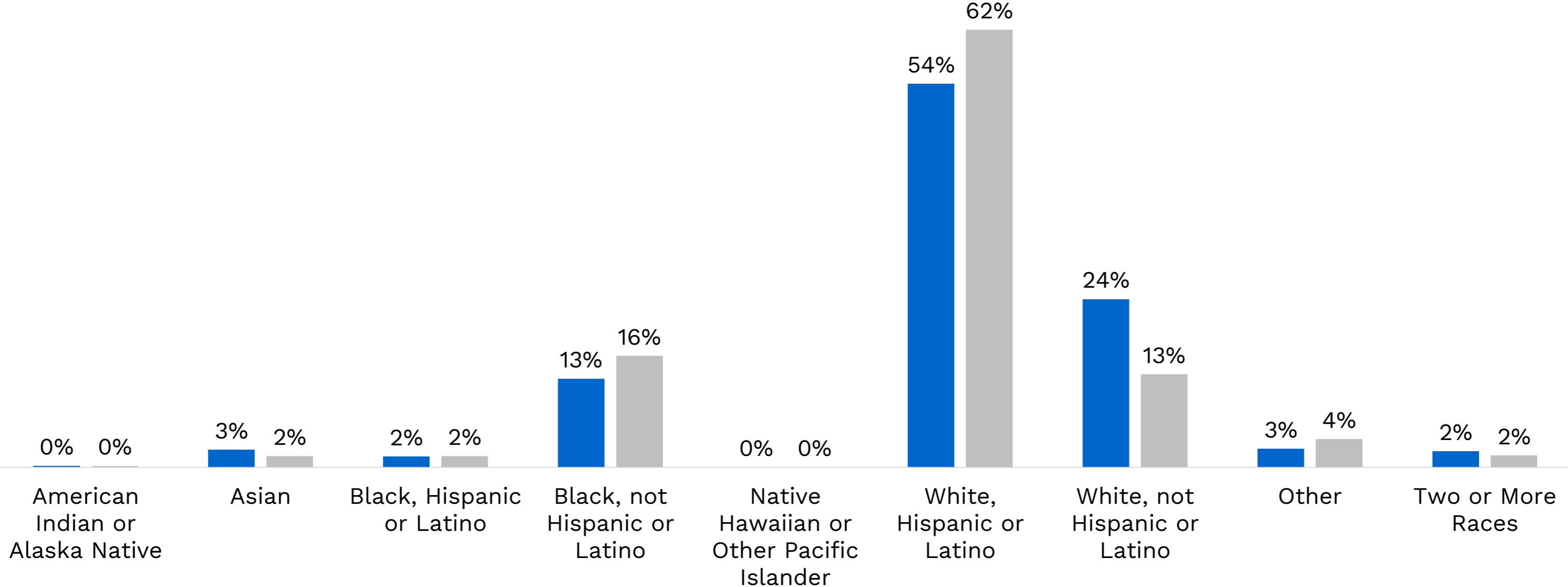

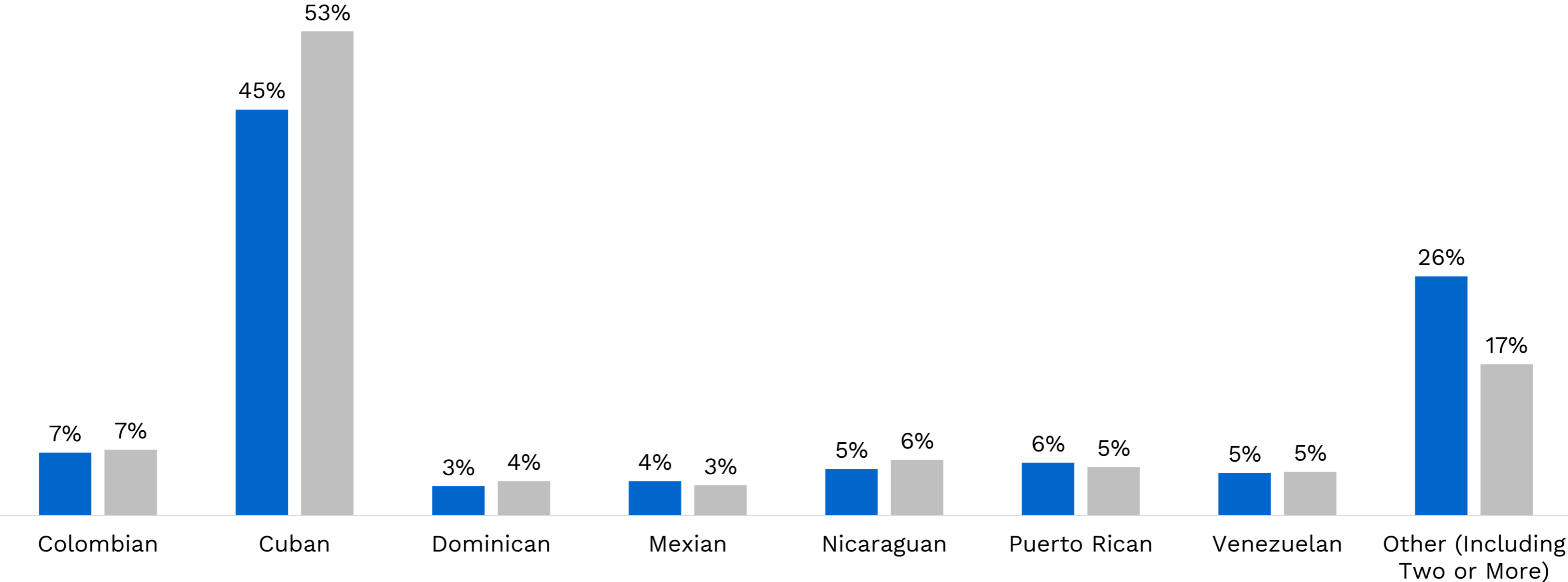

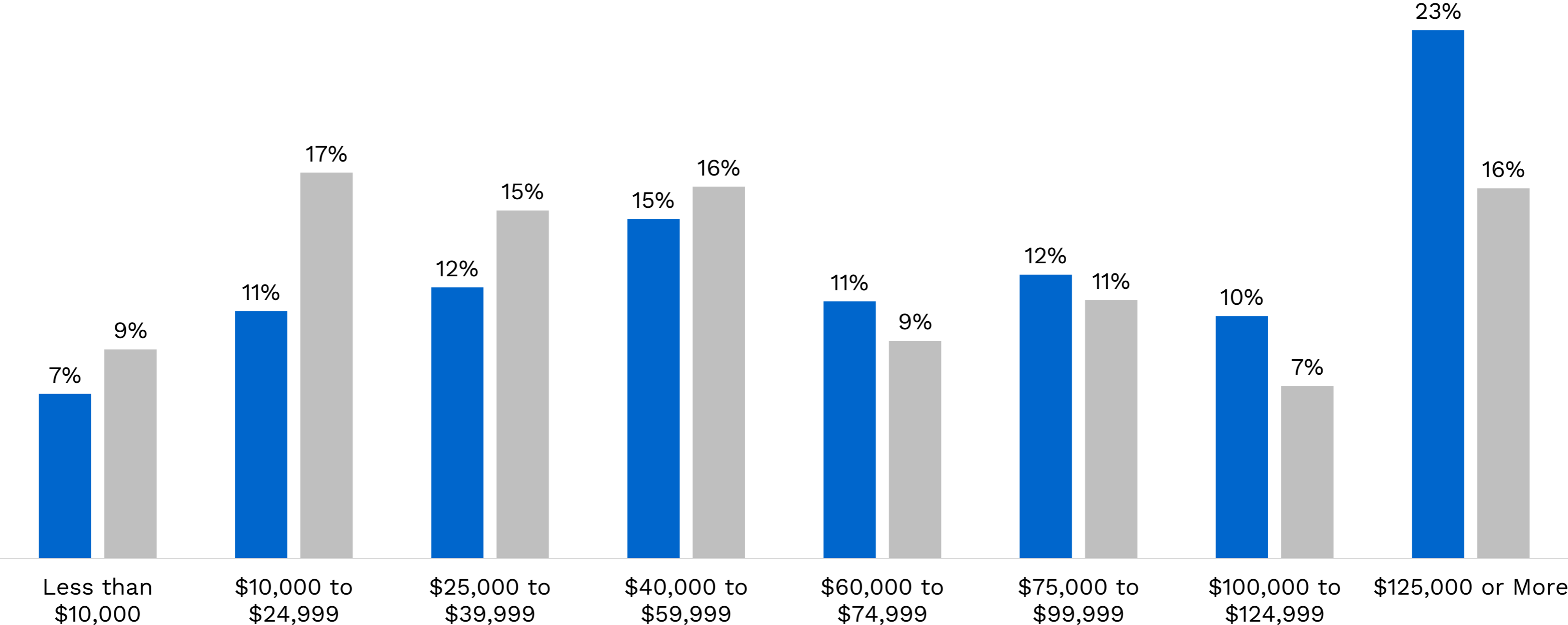

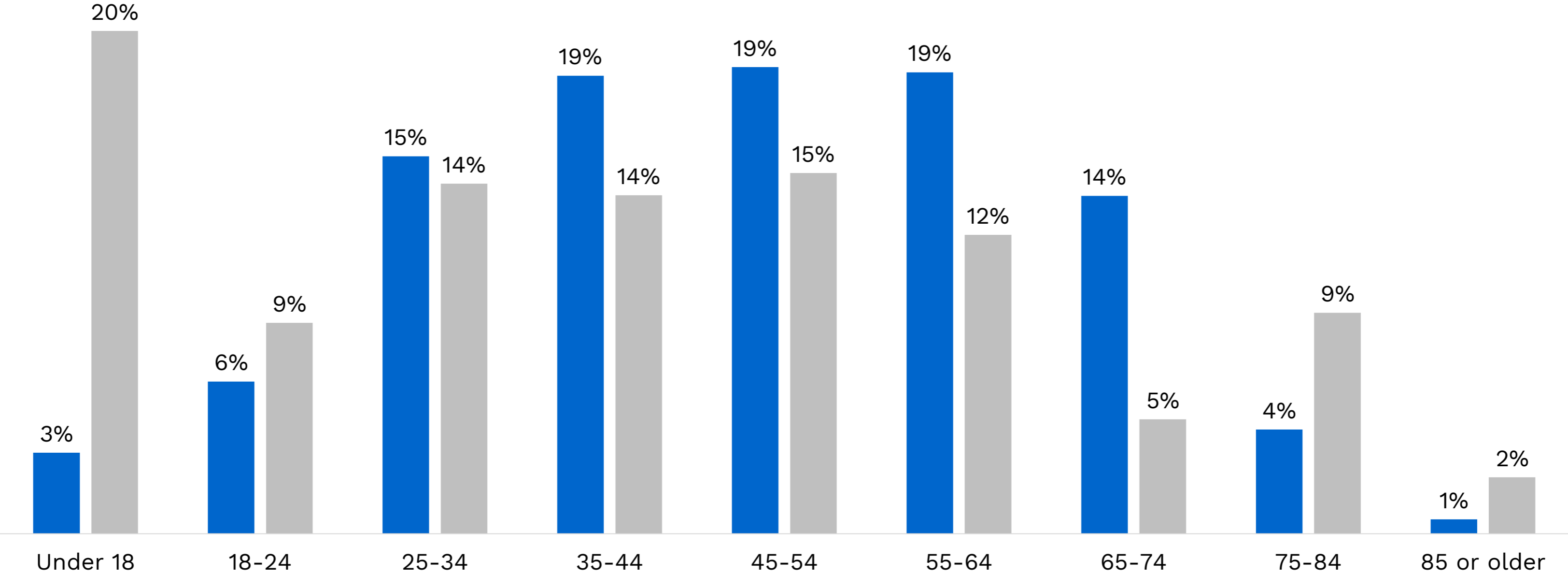

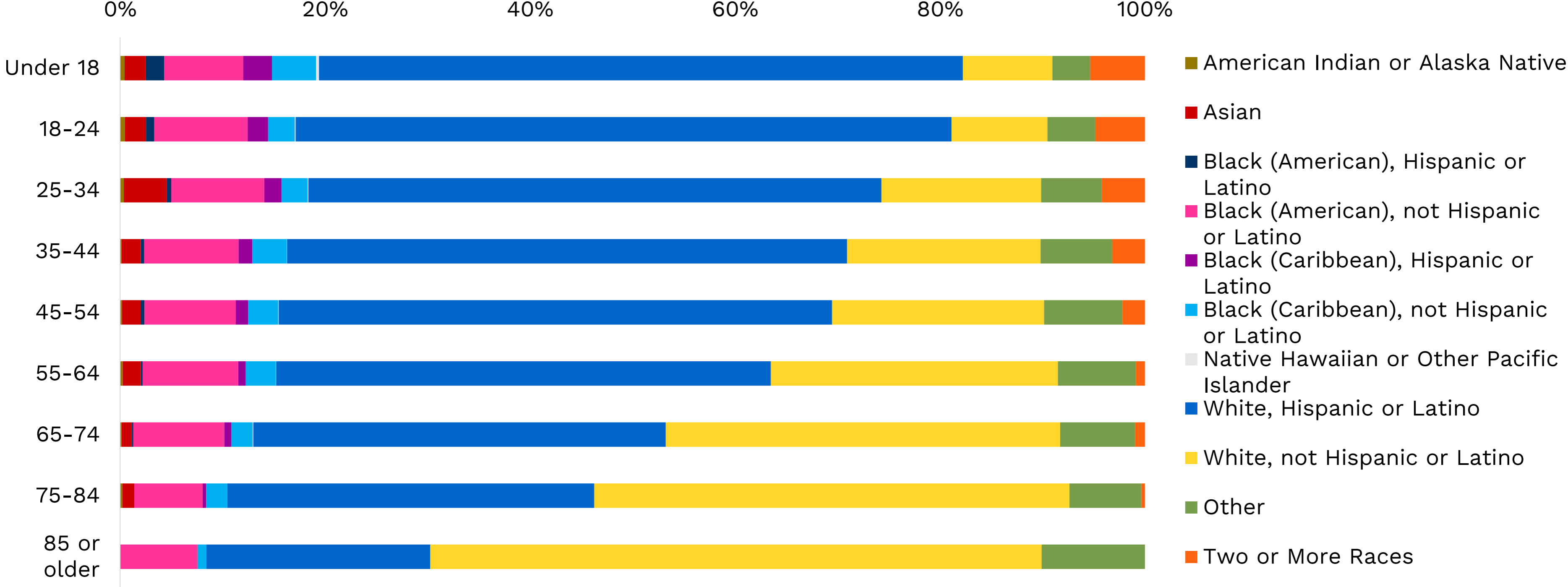

# Age: Race/Ethnicity

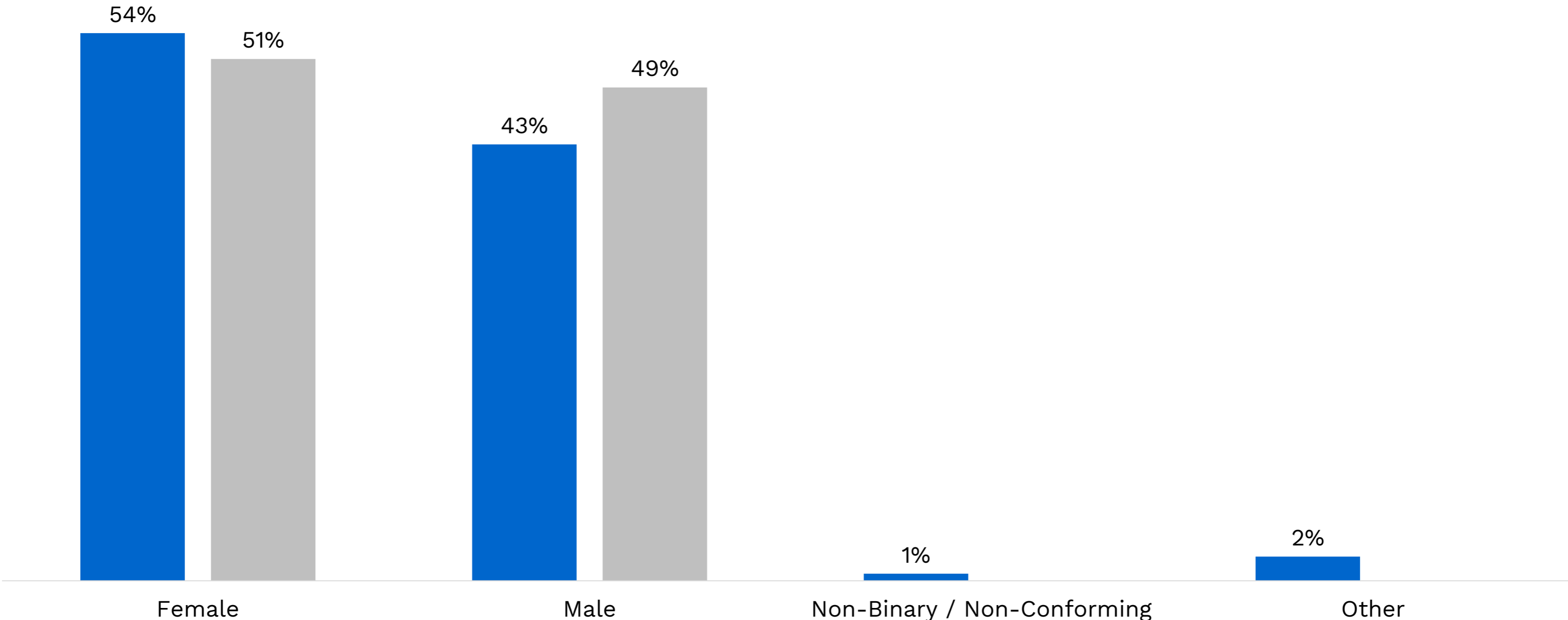

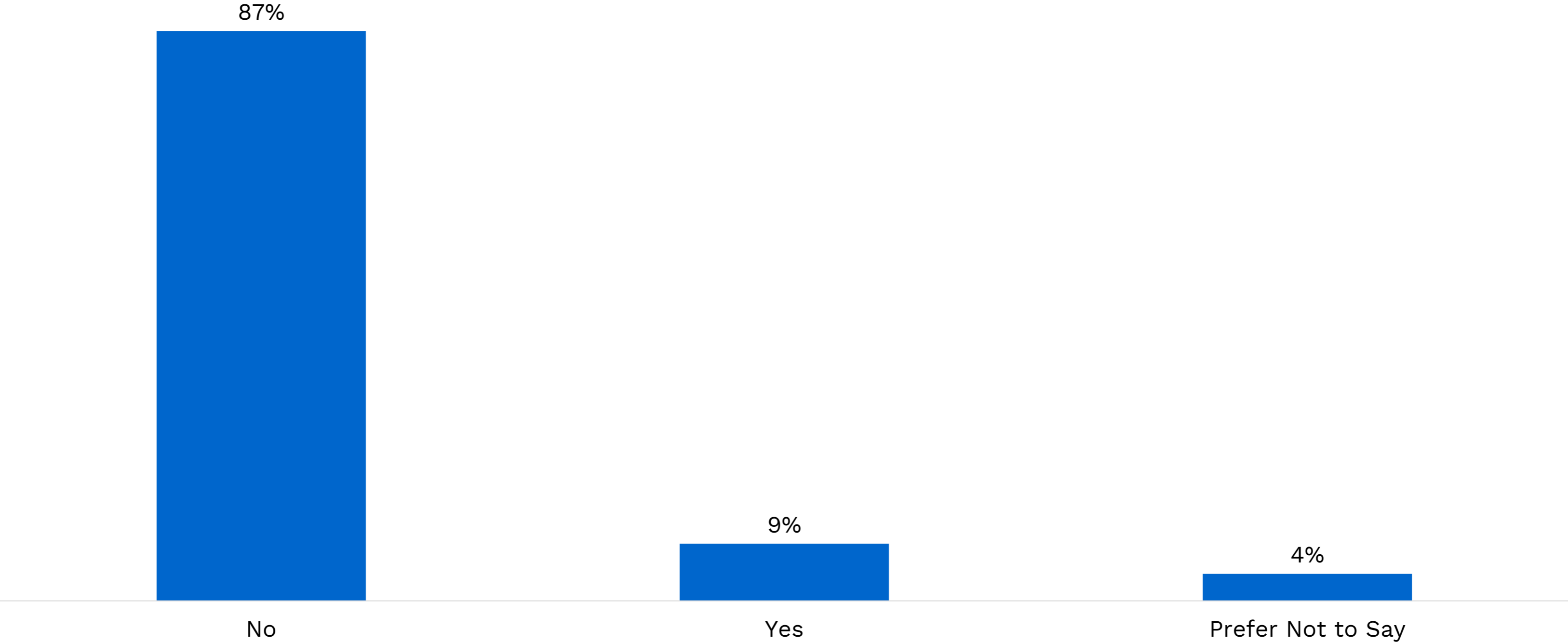
