



#### **Staff Present:**

**I.** Welcome/Introductions – Ms. Sandra Petithomme convened the SBE Construction Advisory Board meeting at 1:24 pm. Ms. Petithomme welcomed the members and conducted the roll call, followed by staff introduction. Chairman William Derrer extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Board along with staff and proceeded to discuss the agenda.

#### **II. Old Business**

#### a. Approval of July 15, 2024, Construction Advisory Board Meeting Minutes

It was moved by Mr. Jessie Bernard Houston to approve July 15, 2024, Construction Advisory Board Meeting minutes. This motion was seconded by Ms. Shellie Ransom-Jackson, and upon being put to a vote, the motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

#### **III. Discussion**

#### a. Task Log

Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro briefed the board on the task log, covering sections 1 through 13.

During the discussion, the following updates were provided:

#### **IV. SBD Section Reports**

#### a. SBE-Construction Business Outreach & Education

Ms. Lawanda Wright (SBD Section Chief) updated the board members on the Business Outreach & Education report for periods June 1, 2024, to July 31, 2024. She informed the board members that there were six (6) prompt payment issues, equating to \$1,314,507 to payment related dollars, with year-to-date (YTD) total of \$3,477, 503. Additionally, she noted there were no contract issues, and the year to date was 5,197. Ms. Wright also updated the board members with the Bond report.

In response to Ms. Shellie Ransom-Jackson inquiry as to whether Ms. Wright conducted a year-over-year analysis of the bonding and financial assistance report to compare the current numbers with those from previous years. Ms. Wright indicated an analysis had been once, when it was requested.

Ms. Ransom-Jackson confirmed that she would like to see the progress of the Bonding and Financial Assistance Report for the last three years, noting whether there has been an increase or decrease.

It was moved by Ms. Ransom-Jackson that Ms. Wright provide the Construction Board with a year- over- year bonding and financial assistance, report for the last 3 years. This motion was seconded by Mr. Jessie Bernard Houston and upon being put to a vote, the motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

#### b. SBE-Construction Certification Report (Jeanise Cummings-Labossiere)

Ms. Jeanise Cummings-Labossiere (Section Chief) briefed the board members on the Construction Certification Report for periods June 1, 2024, to July 31, 2024. She reported a total of twelve (12) applications were received, eleven (11) firms and one (1) recertified. Ms. Cummings-Labossiere also noted no firm graduated, and no firms were denied, and the total certified firms was 740 during the reporting period.

Chairman William Derrer inquired whether House Bill 705 would impact the firm's membership, currently at 740 members.

Mr. Gary Hartfield, Director of the Office of Small Businesses, responded that he did not anticipate House Bill 705 having the significant impact some expected, as they were actively creating opportunities for small businesses. He explained that Florida Statute 255.2 covers various areas, detailing what can and cannot be done in open solicitations. He emphasized that their 7360-program remained open, with small businesses actively participating and successfully competing by submitting and winning bids. Mr. Hartfield also mentioned that Miami-Dade County would be able to utilize the 7040 programs but noted upcoming changes to their miscellaneous construction contract program, particularly the removal of responsible wages for future construction projects.

#### c. SBE-Construction Project Review and Analysis (Laurie Johnson)

Regarding the SBE-Construction Project Review and Analysis, Mr. Hartfield explained that staff was still monitoring the impact of HB 705 on existing projects. He added that Ms. Laurie Johnson would provide the board with that information at the upcoming Construction board meeting.

#### d. SBE-Construction Utilization Report (Patrick Hines)

Mr. Patrick Hines (SBD Special Projects Administrator 1) presented an update on the Construction Utilization report for the period of June 1, 2024, to July 31, 2024, noting contracts awarded to SBE equated to \$26.9 million. He also updated the board members on contracts awarded annually from 2022 through 2024 by gender and ethnicity.

Discussion ensued between Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro, Mr. Hines, and Mr. Hartfield regarding the contracts paid demographic annually reporting 2024 section of the report, that states negative 19 million.

#### V. Construction Management Reporting

#### a. Miscellaneous Construction Contract MCC-9-18

Ms. Ginny Mirabal presented the MCC-9-18 report for the periods June 1, 2024, to July 31, 2024. She reported out of the \$19,917,063, \$16,487,654 was for construction related values of construction project information, with \$15,233,585.43 in payments towards small businesses.

Ms. Elsie Hamler requested that Ms. Mirabal include the percentage of cash flow to minorities in the report.

#### c. Design, Build, Finance, Operate, Maintain Civil and Probate Courthouse

Mr. Armando Perez presented the Design, Build, Finance, Operate, Maintain Civil and Probate Courthouse report for the period June 1, 2024, to July 31, 2024, noting the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal was 13.11%. He noted the firm contracted \$36, 986,810.89 and paid out \$33,254,197.49 to SBE subcontractors.

Discussion ensued amongst Ms. Elsie Hamler, Mr. Gary Hartfield (SBD Director), and Chairman Derer regarding the demographic percentage.

Ms. Hamler Ms. Hamler emphasized that she has been requesting that all firms provide the percentage of dollars distributed, rather than simply stating that there is one African American etc.

Chairman William Derrer requested that Mr. Perez provide the accurate percentage of cash flow dollars based on the demographic data.

#### d. MSC Cruise Terminal (Fincantieri Infrastructure Florida)

Ms. Deborah Ductant briefed the board members on MSC Cruise Terminal report for periods June 1, 2024, to July 31, 2024. She noted the project, under the specified contract, the focus was on achieving the following goals: of allocating 14% for design, 10.01% for construction, and 2.2% for goods and services. She noted the total dollar value contracted to Small Business Enterprise (SBE's) was \$47,720,473.22.

#### e. DTC East Tower Vertical Expansion (SHELL)

Mr. Vincent Collins provided an overview of the DTC East Tower Vertical Expansion report, indicating the mentorship goal for the project was 6.31% for Small Business Enterprise (SBE), with a goal of 32.77% and 0.25% of the \$149,414,268 million percentage paid out to contracted Small Business Enterprises (SBE) were 21% that paid out SBE'S a total of \$28,545,064 million.

Ms. Michou Jean asked that Ms. Elsie Hamler provide clarity on how she would like the firm demographics to be displayed.

Ms. Hamler explained that she wants to see the total dollar amounts paid and have it broken down by percentage based on ethnicity.

**f. Poole and Kent Company of Florida** submitted a report, but no representative was available to present or discuss the report.

#### VI. New Business

Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro mentioned that there were some Small Business Enterprise Construction (SBE-C) representatives interested in joining the board. However, she noted many current board members either have new representatives or are less active, with some only attending meetings occasionally. Ms. Brown-Alfaro asked whether more slots could be created to accommodate new members.

Mr. Gary Hartfield (SBD Director) indicated that staff would provide Ms. Brown-Alfaro with information on the current vacancies and who were responsible for filling the vacancies on the

board. He stated once that information is provided, Ms. Brown-Alfaro could reach out to the individuals interested in filling the seat, and then the interested individual would request a letter to confirm the vacancy.
