


Vision Statement A

MLK Plaza Station is a community-first project that protects affordability, supports local businesses, and ensures long-time residents can stay and thrive. Rooted in community voices, it celebrates public space and culture, while preserving the identity and story of the people who call this place home.

Vision Statement B

MLK Plaza Station honors the neighborhood's African American history while embracing its multi-generational future. The plan celebrates local pride and connects people of all ages across time and place, transforming the Metrorail into more than transit - into a cultural stage for memory and movement. This place will carry forward the spirit of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. honoring the past, strengthening community in the present, and inspiring generations to come.



A colorful seat wall mural celebrates the footsteps of community members, symbolizing stories and legacies that continue to shape the MLK area.




As people walk, they trace the steps of those who shaped this place... a living path of history and progress.

Option 1: The Hub - Landscape Plan








