Vendor Selection

At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the County Code, as well as the Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active license in the following disciplines:

- a. Underground Utility and Excavation
- b. Pipeline Engineering
- c. General Contractor.

In addition to the license requirements, The Prime Contractor and personnel shall have experience with installation of water or sewer pressurized pipe 36-inches or larger. The Contractor shall demonstrate their experience by providing details about three (3) projects on which the Contractor acted as the Prime Contractor and completed in the past ten (10) years that involved the installation of water or sewer pressurized pipe 36-inches or larger.

At least one (1) of the three (3) projects shall include a directional drill 24-inch or larger. At least one (1) of the three (3) projects shall include a microtunnel 24-inch or larger. The Contractor must also show that it has cumulatively installed a total of over 1,000 Linear Feet of pipe 36-inches or larger during various projects over the past ten (10) years.

The Directional Drilling Sub-Contractor shall have at least five (5) years of continuous experience performing directional drilling projects. The Directional Drilling Sub-Contractor shall provide three (3) projects including directional drilling pipe 24-inch or larger.

The Microtunneling Sub-Contractor shall have at least five (5) years of continuous experience performing microtunneling projects. The Microtunneling Sub-Contractor shall provide three (3) projects including microtunneling pipe 24-inch or larger.

Verifiable references are required with Project Name, Organization Name, Contact Person, Phone Number, Date of Work, and Description of Work Performed. Submit experience history with references on the two most recent contracts along with the bid. The work shall have been completed with the Contractor's own forces or key personnel with any applicable permits secured by the Contractor.

The experience of key senior personnel with other firms may be counted toward the experience requirement, if acceptable to the Engineer. Should such evidence not be satisfactory to the Engineer, whose decision shall be final, the bid will be considered non-responsive, and the second low bidder will be considered for award.

In the event a firm consists of executives, supervisors, and other senior field staff (key employees) that would have met these minimum experience requirements with a prior firm, WASD reserves the right to qualify the firm based on WASD's sole determination and evaluation of the knowledge and prior experience of these key employees employed by the new firm.

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The Bidder must demonstrate that the company has full-time personnel with the necessary experience to perform the project's scope of work. This experience shall include identifying successfully completed projects where personnel have performed the bulk of the work, and which best illustrate their ability to perform the requested services while meeting project schedules and budgets.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the County Code, as well as the Solicitation and Contract Documents, at the time of bid, the Bidder must hold one of the following valid, current, and active credentials:

- a) Certificate of Competency from the County's Construction Trades Qualifying Board as a General Engineering Contractor;
or
- b) Certification, as a General Contractor, provided by the State of Florida Construction Industry Licensing Board, pursuant to the provisions of Florida Statutes Chapter 489.115.

In addition to the license requirements, the Bidder must:

1. Provide as part of their references a minimum of two (2) similar projects completed and accepted by the project owner prior to the bid submittal date under its current business name within the last seven (7) years as the Prime. In addition to the general qualifications provided in SP 1.0 ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS, the Bidder shall also meet the requirements shown below and shall submit satisfactory proof and qualifications demonstrating compliance with the Bid.

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:

One of the following licenses is required: State General Contractor, General Engineering Contractor and/or other categories as applicable by Chapter 489 of the Florida Statutes or County Code Chapter 10.

EXPERIENCE:

A. The Bidder shall have successfully completed a minimum of one (1) project demonstrating experience with electrical distribution building and generation facility construction projects having a total construction value greater than \$50 million at a water or wastewater treatment facility or two (2) industrial buildings with medium voltage electrical distribution and generation each one with a value greater than \$40 million. These projects shall have been completed within the past fifteen (15) years from the date of the Invitation to Bid.

B. The Bidder's project manager shall have successfully completed a minimum of one (1) project demonstrating project management experience with large water or wastewater treatment plant upgrade projects having a total construction value greater than \$50 million. The Prime Consultant submitting a proposal should demonstrate substantial engineering experience in all phases of water treatment systems, including the design, permitting, construction, and operation and maintenance of large regional water treatment plants. The Prime Consultant should possess the technical expertise and operational understanding necessary to integrate practical, operations-based knowledge into the design of treatment plant facilities to ensure efficiency, reliability, and long-term maintainability.

The Prime Consultant should identify all members of the proposed design team, specifying the overall design manager(s) and team leaders for each major design discipline, including process treatment, civil, structural, mechanical, electrical, and instrumentation engineering. The submittal should clearly define the specific role and responsibilities of each team member within the project scope.

To demonstrate relevant experience, the Prime Consultant should provide detailed descriptions of two (2) successfully designed, constructed, and operational new or majorly retrofitted water treatment plants, each with a permitted capacity of fifty (50) MGD (million gallons per day), completed within the seven (7) years preceding the solicitation date. For each example project, the Prime Consultant shall indicate which members of the proposed design team participated and their specific roles. The narrative should highlight notable project achievements such as adherence to schedule and budget, innovative design solutions, implementation of new technologies, or cost-saving measures.

The Subconsultants should demonstrate experience on one (1) project relevant to the scope of work and aligned with their proposed responsibilities under this contract.
