



It has been a priority of my administration to accelerate infrastructure projects that support both a thriving economy and a healthy environment. Since 2022, Miami-Dade County has dedicated approximately \$230 million to WASD's Connect 2 Protect (C2P) initiative to expand our centralized sewer system, allowing residents to connect to it and eliminate their aging or vulnerable septic tanks.

Recognizing that this transition can be a financial burden, the County launched a financial assistance program to help ensure residents have equitable access to reliable wastewater services that protect the public's health and our environment.

Once completing the sewer conversion process, homeowners may also see an increase to their property value while providing flexibility for home additions and improvements.

UPGRADE FROM SEPTIC TO SEWER WITH FINANCIAL SUPPORT— APPLY TODAY!

The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department's Septic-to-Sewer Financial Assistance Program is now **accepting** applications. Eligible homeowners can receive up to \$15,000 through grants, **zero** or low-interest loans to convert their septic systems to County sewer **services**.

AVAILABLE FUNDING:

- Grants
- Income-Restricted Loan
- Non-Restricted Loans

ELIGIBILITY:

- Miami-Dade residential property with Homestead Exemption.
- Must maintain Homestead Exemption for five years after receiving funds.
- Property taxes must be current with no outstanding County debts.
- A sewer line must be available near your property.
