I. Welcome/Introductions - Michou Jean (SBD) called the meeting to order at 1:09 PM. In absence of Chairman William Derrer, Dorothy Brown-Alfaro Chaired the meeting. She welcomed all Board members and staff, while proceeding to the agenda.

#### II. **Discussion**

#### a. CMC Notice of Intent to Violate Procedures

Alice Hidalgo-Gato- Section Chief from Small Business Development provided an update and overview on how prime and sub-contractors are provided a notice of intent to violate. She advised that the section is in the process of reviewing the procedures and in the meantime will attend the construction meetings. In addition, calling small business that would like to participate in County Construction Contracts, so they are aware of the requirement to obtain such contract.
