

I. Welcome/Introductions – Michou Jean (SBD) called the meeting to order at 1:11 PM. Vice-Chair Elsie K. Hamler welcomed all Board members and staff and proceeded to the agenda.

II. Old Business (15 min)

a. Approval of September 19, 2023, Meeting Minutes

i. Shellie Ransom-Jackson motioned to approve the meeting minutes and board member Alejandro Munilla seconded the motion. (Approved 6-0).

b. Approval of November 21, 2022, Meeting Minutes

i. Shellie Ransom-Jackson motioned to approve the meeting minutes and board member Alejandro Munilla seconded the motion. (Approved 6-0).

c. Approval of 2023 Meeting Dates

i. Alejandro Munilla motioned to approve the 2023 meeting dates and board member Dorothy Brown-Alfaro seconded the motion. (Approved 6-0).

III. Discussions

a. Task Log

- i. The board discussed the next steps of their recommendations. It was mentioned that all of recommendations can be submitted as a report but there isn't a guarantee the action will take place right away. Any recommendations that require a Legislative change requires a sponsor.
- ii. The Board discussed the status of the Collective Advisory Board. Mr. Hartfield advised that all of the SBE Advisory Boards have a number of issues in common and creating this group would be a beneficial way to address concerns across all boards. All the recommendations the boards have in common will be discussed and anything that is specific to industry will be isolated. This is the most concrete and forward way to gain a consensus amongst all boards. Staff as well as representative from the Mayors Office, Procurement and the County Attorneys Office will be present in the advisory board meetings to answer questions and to provide advice.
- iii. Board member Jessie Houston stated that this is a good opportunity for items that are on the task log to be added to the Collective Committee recommendations, this way everyone can come to a consensus to move forward as one voice on the issues that affect everyone.
- iv. Ms. Dorothy Brown Alfaro advised that she opposes the recommendations going to the collective advisory board, she would like the recommendations to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).
- v. Ms. Shellie Ramson Jackson asked about timeline of the Collective meeting. Hartfield stated that we will try to get it done by the end of the quarter.
- vi. Mr. Jessie Houston motioned to move the recommendations to the Collective Advisory Boards to attempt to come together as a united voice. Ms. Shellie Ransom-Jackson seconded the motion. Ms. Dorothy Brown Alfaro opposed. The motion was approved (5-1).
- vii. Mr. Jeovanni R. Tarafa requested feedback on recommendations prior to the next Advisory Board meeting.

IV. SBD Section Reports

a. SBE - Construction Business Outreach and Education (Lawanda Wright-Robinson)

- i. The report was presented by Lawanda Wright-Robinson.
- ii. The report collected data from November 1, 2022, to November 30, 2022.
- iii. Michou Jean updated the board members with the new reporting periods. This will provide firms with more time to get the information needed for their report. This meeting only reported one month (November 2022). After this meeting, the reporting period will become two months (December 2022 and January 2023). This will allow staff to gather reports and sent the

agendas out to the boards in timely manner. Final agenda's will now be sent at least 2 weeks in advance.

- iv. Mr. Houston asked question about the technical assistance issue listed in the report. Ms. Wright-Robinson stated that outside of contract or payment issues, it could be general questions.
- v. Ms. Wright-Robinson advised the board of the Black history events that will be occurring in February.

- i. The report was presented by Ginny Mirabal on behalf of MCM Corporation.
- ii. Ms. Mirabel stated that MCC-9-18 closed
- iii. Ms. Mirabel mentioned to Staff that eleven jobs were awarded, and three jobs didn't close out.
- iv. Dorothy asked what's the goal based on key management staff. Mr. Mirabal stated that having more Staff would help meet the goal.

c. Project A- Jackson North Medical Center (OHL Arellano Construction Co.)

- i. The report was presented by Lino Gonzalez on behalf of OHL Arellano Construction. He added that the project was completed on December 21, 2022.

- iv. Mr. Kenneth Robinson advised that the trade that Turner had issues with in the SBE Participation was roofing which was about 6% of the scheduled values. They advertised and received (2) two SBEc roofing bids. Both contractors pulled out which resulted in in the goal not being met.
- v. Dayron Perez (SBD Section Manager) stated that a notice of intent to violate was issued to Turner. Following the notice, SBD was advised of their ongoing issues regarding roofing. Shortly after, a notice of violation was issued, and it is currently being appealed by Turner.
