SBE Utilization Overview Mar 1, 2021 – May 1, 2021

PAYMENTS TO SBE-G&S FIRMS

In this period, payments to all vendors on Goods & Services contracts totaled \$126,695,093.

• Under existing contracts and pre-qualification pools, SBE-G&S firms were paid a total of \$17,363,505 or 7.04% of total payments.

AWARDED CONTRACTS

There were 23 G&S contracts approved for award totaling \$48,315,270

- 10 contracts were not eligible for SBE measures due to being a no measure because of **other reasons**, **sole source/bid waiver/legacy/revenue-generating contract, method of award**, **confirmation purchase**, **accessing of a state contract**, **emergency**, **or funding source**.
- Of the 23 G&S contracts awarded this period, 10 contracts totaling \$26,201,613 were awarded to firms with a Miami-Dade address (or 54.23%)

CONTRACTS AVAILABLE FOR SMALL BUSINESS PARTICIPATION

There were 13 contracts available for SBE measures totaling \$41,878,791.

• 13 contracts were advertised as a SBE Bid Preference or Selection Factor. Of the contracts awarded during this period, SBE-G&S firms are participating as Prime and/or subcontractors (with or without measures) for a dollar value of \$402,695.

i. Michou Jean (SBD) brought the Goods and Services Advisory Board meeting to order. Darryl Holsendolph welcomed the board and gave brief remarks.

II. SBD Section Reports

a. Certification – Laurie Johnson (SBD – Section Chief)

Ms. Johnson presented the certification report for the period of December 1, 2020 – March 1, 2021 with a total of 1,417 certified SBE-GS firms. Mr. Holsendolph asked Ms. Johnson about the effects that COVID – 19 has had on the Certification process, Ms. Johnson noted that during this reporting quarter, there has been an increase in new application submissions. Many firms, that are in good standing with their certification, if under a County contact, have been extended grace periods to submit any required documentation, which may be pending due to limited, physical staff, and firms working remotely.

b. Utilization Report – Patrick Hines (SBD Sr. Professional Service Specialist)

Mr. Hines presented the SBE Utilization report for the period of December 1st, 2020 – March 1, 2021. Payments to SBE – G&S firms in contractual dollars totaled \$246,111,192. Under existing contracts and pre-qualification pools, SBE-G&S firms were paid a total of \$17, 636,505 or 7.04% of total payments. Goods & Services contracts were approved and awarded totaling \$289,566,263. 43 Contracts were not eligible for SBE measures. 24 of the 59 Contracts were awarded to Miami-Dade firms, totaling \$19,081,089. Board members and staff discussed the details provided in the report and Ms. Johnson clarified various interpretations made by the Board members.

c. Business Outreach & Education – Lawanda Wright-Robinson (SBD Section Chief, Business Outreach & Education)

Ms. Wright-Robinson presented the SBE Business Outreach & Education report for the period of December 1, 2020 – March 1, 2021. She presented the totals for the assistance provided to SBE – G&S program, Training Education and Activities, and Technical Training & Development Workshops. Ms. Wright-Robinson mentioned that
