The pre-engineered metal building components are already owned by Miami-Dade County; as a result, the Design-Builder is solely responsible to design and construct the building's structure according to the Florida Building Code. 1.For the <u>"design component"</u>, GSA recommended a 15% CBE-A/E goal; After review and analysis, SBD is making the

recommendation of a <u>28% CBE-A/E goal</u> (utilizing the following technical categories) which has **no** associated minimum requirements:

- i. 12.00 (General Mechanical Engineering) @ 10%
- ii. 13.00 (General Electrical Engineering) @ 15%
- iii. 22.00 (ADA Title II Consultant) @ 3%

(Additionally, there is sufficient (1st and 2nd Tier) CBE firms certified in the same).

SBD conducted a "Verification of Availability" exploring any opportunities for a "Set-aside". Due to insufficient availability of CBE firms
