

Description of Project/Bid: The Project is to be developed entirely within the existing public right-of-way generally defined by the existing South-Dade Transitway corridor between the Dadeland South Metrorail Station and SW 344th Street in Florida City (approximately 20 miles), including adjoining stations. The Project will include 14 new Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) stations at existing station locations, demolition of existing stations and ancillary structures, rehabilitation of approximately 16 existing Transitway stations that will remain in place, and accommodation of at-grade BRT vehicles. The Project is targeting Envision Silver Certification by incorporating sustainability into the design and construction of the Transitway infrastructure. In addition, the Project will include the SW 168th Street Park-n-Ride Station and include roadway improvements from SW 264th Street from US-1 to SW 147th Ave.
