Professional and technical services for DTPW will include, but not necessarily be limited to the following: Project Management activities and overseeing all phases of a project through implementation to achieve Location and Design Concept Acceptance (LDCA), cost and schedule goals. Project management activities include, but are not limited to: day to day coordination with stakeholders, federal, state and local agencies, project planners, designers and contractors; regular, timely and effective coordination and communications with DTPW Project Manager/staff, outside governmental agencies, agencies having jurisdiction, and the public. In addition, the consultant will be required to prepare and complete National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation for this project in coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration.


