Request to Advertise for Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces (PROS) Professional

Services Agreement (PSA) for Crandon Park Basin Dredging Phase I, located within

Commission District 7. Project No: E21-PROS-02

The Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) is recommending a 14.22% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal. The cost for the Crandon Park Basin Dredging Phase I, Professional Services Agreement (PSA) is for a maximum compensation of one million two hundred twenty thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,220,800.00) for an effective term.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>

Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) operates over 278 parks and manages over 13,800 acres of land. PROS seeks a consultant committed to building a healthier, more vibrant and livable community through the implementation of the Parks and Open Space Master Plan.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

There are several areas in the Crandon Park Marina which are experiencing accumulation of sand and sediment creating issues to the boat users. Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) seeks the professional services of a prime consultant for all the areas that are in need for dredging and definite solution to the problem. It is desired to have a minimum depth of 6 feet at low tide throughout and additionally Slip No. 2 historically has been presenting accumulation of material within the slip and a solution to prevent the slip from filling with sand and sediment again is necessary.

The selected consultant will report directly to the PROS Project Manager.

EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

The Prime Consultant must hold technical certifications 5.08, 5.09 and 17.00 and hold active professional registration status as required by the State of Florida.

Prime Consultant, through full time-personnel, must demonstrate a preferred minimum of five (5) years of experience as the prime consultant on similar projects with project scopes that are comparable to the Project Scope of Services for this project. A preferred minimum of three (3) of these projects must have been completed within the last ten (10) years.
